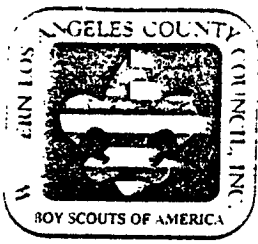

We do note that you indicate he is thirty-five (35) on the Confidential Record Sheet, and yet the letter which was sent indicates that he is forty-three (43). We would like to know his correct age since this will be most helpful to us in identifying him at a later time.

We would also like to know if any legal charges are being submitted against Mr. Miller. This will help to determine whether we can keep him on the file permanently and refuse registration based on only the one incident which has been reported to us.

Let us know if you have any other information which will strengthen our file to protect the youth of America.

We would like more information concerning Ken Miller. Are there any charges to be pressed in this matter? Are the [REDACTED] going to seek legal action against Mr. Miller? We would also like to know if any other youth has been involved in any way with this individual. All of this information will be most helpful to us as we set up a file and have the necessary information for refusing registration attempts should they occur.

We would also like more information concerning Ken Marquis. The information that is given here is certainly one person's word against another. It does not seem that there is much information that is very solid on the action which supposedly took place.

We would like all of this information, if possible, so that we may have enough information for refusal of registration should an attempt occur in some other council.

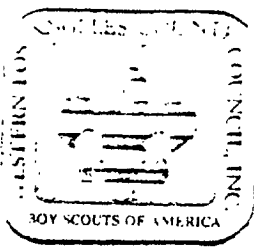

Statement made by [REDACTED]

On the first night at Camp Air Horn everyone slept outside except for [REDACTED] and me. Ken, [REDACTED] and I slept inside the van. Ken slept on the first bench, I was on the middle bench and [REDACTED] was in the back. I was asleep. Ken woke me up because he wanted to talk, and told me to come over to where he was. He put his hand on my penis and squeezed it. At first I didn't know what he was doing. He did it again. Then he sent me back to my bench. I slept there the rest of the night.

The second night at Camp Air Horn the sleeping arrangement was the same. He woke me up again and told me to come over. I didn't want to go. He told me that we were friends and that friends can show they like each other. I went over. He took my hand and put it on his penis. I pulled my hand away and as fast as lightening he put my hand back on his penis. Then he sent me back to my bunk. He didn't want me to wake [REDACTED] up.

The next day we went to the Boy Scout camp. The first day at camp I went to the hospital. I wasn't feeling well. What Ken did was on my mind and made me sick. Ken didn't want to take me to the hospital, but [REDACTED] could see I wasn't feeling well and made Ken take me. Ken stayed with me the whole time at the hospital. I didn't say anything to the people at the hospital. Ken never left me alone.

We went back to the Boy Scout camp and set up the tents and did all that stuff. Ken asked me to bring my stuff into his tent. I brought it all in there. We went to bed. I was alone in his tent with him. He asked me to come over here. I said no I didn't feel well. He asked me to tell him why I didn't want to and told me I could sleep in another tent the next night. If I didn't come over to him he told me that our friendship was all over. It was my fault that our friendship was broken up. He blamed me for the friendship breaking up. He told me that he was just showing affection like friends are supposed to do. If I didn't want to show him that I was a friend, it was all over. I spent the rest of the night in his tent, but I had a hard time sleeping.

Most of the next day he didn't talk to me at all. Later he started talking about that friendship stuff again. He wanted to know what was wrong with friends showing that they liked each other.

I moved into a tent by myself the next day. [REDACTED] moved in with me. Everything was ok for a while. Ken was pretty hard on me most of the time. He made the trip hell for me. I had to do all the work. Even [REDACTED] noticed how hard Ken was on me. [REDACTED] helped me a lot. I told him what happened. A few nights later, Ken told me to come into his tent when everyone else was asleep. I didn't go. I was tired. He told me that I always say that. I said fine and walked away.

On Wednesday, (7/22) I told Chris Noeland, [REDACTED] I told [REDACTED] he asked me back into his tent. On Thursday I told Danny Rodriguez-- [REDACTED] had already told him. I told Danny exactly what happened. He knew Miller had put his hand on my penis. He told me if anything else happened to come to Zulu. After I talked to my mom on Friday I told my instructor, Watermelon-- a staff--and he told me that if anything else happened I could go to him. Watermelon was the instructor of the Fish and Wildlife merit badge. After the class I went back to Zulu for some carving. I watched Doug chop wood.

(Mom: How did you feel about all of this?) I felt sick. It made me miss a lot in class. I couldn't concentrate. I thought about it all the time. It made it hard for me to get my merit badges. It made me feel like [REDACTED]. It felt like I was doing something wrong. It made me feel scared. He yelled a lot at me. He always made me wash the tables and clean the cooking cans. He really made me feel awful. I really thought I had done something wrong. The boys, and Danny and Watermelon told me I didn't do anything wrong.

Danny asked me if I had told the truth. (On the last night after I had called and asked that [REDACTED] be separated from Ken Miller.) I told him that I was definitely telling the truth. I told him that Ken had not let me use the phone by myself and whenever I tried to call my mom Ken would go with me and he did most of the talking. He really had me scared.

This is the end of [REDACTED] statement.

I received a collect phone call from [REDACTED] the evening he was in the emergency room. I accepted the call from [REDACTED] and Ken Miller got on the line and told me about the ER visit. I talked to [REDACTED] for just a minute. He quietly told me he didn't want to go to Catalina with Miller.

I received two other calls that week. Each time when I accepted the call from [REDACTED] Ken would be on the line. [REDACTED] always repeated that he didn't want to go on more trips with Ken. On 7/26 I received a call from [REDACTED] telling me there was something wrong--he would tell me when he got home. "But Miller is nothing but a fagot."

I didn't connect with that statement until the next morning. I couldn't believe that the boy was trying to tell me that. When I called back on Friday I [REDACTED] he told me the truth and all of it. He related the incidents described above.

Something that [REDACTED] told me a couple of days later also bothers me. Ken Miller gave [REDACTED] several California Wine Coolers while at camp Air Horn. He gave [REDACTED] 2 wine coolers each day while at that camp.

Dear Mr. Barton

I would like to thank the people involved with the Boy Scouts of America for their support during a very difficult situation. Mr. Jim Keeland, Mr. Geoff Moyer and Mr. Jack Kelly were extremely helpful and supportive.

I have however, another request for the Boy Scouts. The Scoutmaster, Ken Miller, should be removed as scoutmaster and not ever be allowed to participate with the Boy Scouts of America again. Mr. Miller has been scoutmaster for the past 2 years of Troop 400 in Pacific Palisades. During the past year he has become a close friend to my son, [REDACTED]. During the Hawaii trip Mr. Miller sexually molested my son. Needless to say my son was shocked and this has been a very difficult situation for him. He feels betrayed by a friend as well as confused that such a thing could happen to him while on a Boy Scout outing.

I am enclosing a statement made by my son the evening he came back from Hawaii. This statement was witnessed by [REDACTED]. If you need a statement from [REDACTED] please let me know and I will furnish you with his address and phone number.

I hope that you can prevent Mr. Miller from ever being associated with the Boy Scouts of America. This man's motives are not compatible with the mission of the Boy Scouts.
