Dear Randy:

It is my understanding that the Council and National offices are in need of information concerning Ken Pearson in order to guide Boy Scouts of America in future relations between said individual and Scouting. It is my understanding that such information will be kept in strictest confidence.

As a parent of three boys in Scouting, I am particularly interested in prevention of future embarrassment to BoyScouts of America or any episode that might lead to criticism of any of the boys in the program or of the Scouting program either.

Ken has certainly given wholeheartedly of his time and self to Scouting in the past and has done a tremendous job at organizing and directing the Oglewanagi Indian Dance Team. There has been one confirmed incident concerning a degree of sexual deviation in his relations with a boy. This is considered to be a medical problem, and it is certainly hoped by all concerned that it can be solved and that Ken can undergo rehabilitation in such a way as to be an asset to society after an undetermined period of medical care. We hope too that your organization might see fit to assist in such rehabilitation should occasion arise in the future that you might could be of help in getting him placed in a suitable environment and vocation somewhere in the world, such placement being under the supervision and after the advice of preper medical authorities.

Mr. Pearson has been employed in this area in scouting as Scout Executive and with the local Explorer Scout Post and has also worked untiringly for about 7 or 8 years with the Oglewanagi Indian Dance Group, including the Giris! Auxilary to this group known as the Zias. He has done an out-standing job in working with scouting and working with the Explorer Post and also in his direction of the Indian Dance Group, and more recently he has taught school at Point Enterprise during the current school year. It is my anderstanding that he had done a commendable job with his school teaching.

Recently he had been guilty of sex deviation with one of the male members of our Indian Dance Group, and this youth has admitted it to his parents and to Mr. Rufus Oliver and to Mr. J. W. Rogers. Mr. Person was confronted with this accusation by the above two men and by Dr. Cox of Teague, Texas, and myself, and he admitted this fact to us. He has resigned from his Teadership of the Oglewanagi Indian Dance Group organizations he has else resigned his job as teacher in the Limestone County Elementary School at Point Enterprise.

His wife was not aware of this illness until it was brought to light with this present episode. She does know about it now, and both she and kenneth have talked to me about it. He is at present under treatment of Dr. John E. Talley in Wacon this condition. You might contact Dr. Talley for further confirmation of this fact.

It is desirous that this information be kept as confidential as is humanly possible.


It has been recommended to him that he should try to find employment other than youth work and teaching in a community away from Mexia.

All of the parents who have had children under his direction have had a high regard for him up until this episode. We still wish him well in his pursuits in the future, but it was felt that it would be impossible for him to continue with this type of common knowledge known by so many.
