Hall scoutmaster pleads guilty to child molestation

A 40-year-old former Boy Scouts troop leader pleaded guilty yesterday to seven counts of child molestation.

Larry Calabro, a former Hall

County resident, will not be sentenced for several more months, said his attorney, Stan Robbins. He could receive up to 140 years in prison in addition to fines, said Hall County Superior



Court Judge John Calabro Girardeau, who presided over yesterday's proceedings.

Calabro, who led a Scouts troop for about three years, pleaded guilty to touching, fondling and stroking the penises of seven Boy Scouts ages 8 to 10, said Bill Brownell, an assistant district attorney. The incidents occurred from January 1987 to February of this year, indictments handed down by a Hall County grand jury this past spring showed.

Calabro also was indicted on two counts of aggravated child molestation, which he did not plead guilty to and for which he will not be prosecuted, Brownell said.

"There are several reasons we agreed to this." Brownell said. "There is only 10 years' difference in the sentence for aggravated child molestation and child molestation. The parole board would do little with it. It would affect his actual time in prison very little.

"And we looked at the anguish it would cause the children and their

parents to have to testify. We also looked at the cost to the county," Brownell said.

Brownell said Calabro may face additional charges of child molestation in Rabun County. The alleged incidents occurred during a camping trip he took with scouts to Rabun County. Those cases, however, have not yet been discussed with Mountain Circuit District Attorney Mike Crawford, Brownell said.

Calabro, who has been held in the Hall County Detention Center since his arrest in March, appeared in court yesterday in a navy jacket, gray pants and burgundy striped tie. He wore a patch over his left eye and glasses when he signed the guilty plea.

He answered Girardeau's questions with a stern voice; it appeared to quiver only one time, and at that point, he hung his head as Girardeau read the indictments. Calabro's wife sat in the courtroom fighting to hold back tears; some flowed anyway.

Also in the courtroom were some Boy Scouts and their parents. They were accompanied by Judy Smith of the Hall County Department of Family and Children Services. She took them all into a separate room after the proceedings ended.

After the proceedings, Robbins said of Calabro's decision, "I assume he decided to plead guilty because he was guilty." Calabro also waived his right to withdraw his plea.

Robbins said he plans an aggressive sentencing hearing.

Calabro, who worked as a mechanic for the Hall County Fire Department for about three years, was arrested March 4 of this year in Roselle Park, N.J., where he had just moved with his family.

Scouting leader faces molestation charges in Hall

A 39-year-old man active in local Scouting has been charged with four counts of child molestation, Hall County Sheriff Dick Mecum said this morning.

The man, Larry Calabro, of 3120 Pierce Road, was a Boy Scouts troop leader for about three years and he led the county's law enforcement Explorers group, Mecum said.

The sheriff declined to say whether the alleged victims may have been scouts.

"I can't go into where he did it or when he did it,"
Mecum said. "But, we checked with the Explorers and
we haven't found anything there."

Calabro, who worked as a mechanic for the Hall County Fire Department, was arrested Friday in Roselle Park, N.J. The sheriff said Calabro had moved to New Jersey recently with his wife and children, and

"he was living there under a different name."

When Hall County authorities learned Calabro had left Georgia, Mecum said, the department's investigation intensified and warrants were taken out for Calabro's arrest. New Jersey police arrested him on the warrants, Mecum said.

Calabro was returned to Hall County yesterday and is being held in the county jail,

Mecum said. Calabro is expected to appear before the Hall County Magistrate Court today to determine if bond will be set for him, Mecum said.

The investigation into the case continues and Mecum said it is difficult at this point to say how many children may have been molested.

"It's hard to speculate at this point," Mecum said. "You have different types of seriousness of molestation."

A bond hearing was scheduled this morning in Hall County Magistrate Court for Larry Calabro. 39, of 3120 Pierce Road. Magistrate Raymond Shuder informed Calabro



that Superior Court Judge Calabro John Girardeau yesterday signed a "no bond" order in Calabro's case, and therefore, the magistrate court would take no further action. (Superior court is a higher court than magistrate court.)

Hall Boy Scout leader faces sex charges

A Hall County Boy Scout troop leader has been indicted on charges of molesting tive scouts, authorities said Wednesday.

Larry Calabro, 39, of Gainesville was indicted late Tuesday on five counts of child molestation and two counts of aggravated child molestation involving boys between the ages of 8 and 12, all members of troops he had led during the last 19 months.

Calabro, a mechanic with the Hall County Fire Department since 1984, has been the leader of several Boy Scout troops and a Sheriff's Department Explorers group, in which he worked with teenage boys interested in police work.

Calabro was arrested March 4 at his sister's house in Rosselle Park. N.J. Shertif Dick Mecum said the Sheriff's Department has provided psychiatric counseling for the families of all the children involved.

allege that Mr. Calabro picked up their son as he was walking along the side of the road and offered him a ride. While in the car Mr. Calabro asked to pull down his pants and then he fondled him. Mr. Calabro took to Mr. Calabro's home and did the same thing again.

All this was brought to my attention by one of our District Executive's, Richard Aiken. Rick met with Sheriff Mecum on the 29th at the sheriff's request.

According to Mr. Calabro and his family have temporarily moved in with friends in New Jersey. We do not know his current address or telephone number. Also, alleges that Mr. Calabro sexually molested his also.

Mr. Calabro is registered in four capacities in our council: Scoutmaster, Troop 208, Explorer Advisor, Post 213, Committee Member, Pack 208, and Committee Member, Pact 220. All of these units were due to recharter in January 1988, and Mr. Calabro will not be on the charters if and when they recharter.

It should be noted that Explorer Post 213 is sponsored by the Hall County Sheriff's Department, and the Institutional Head is Sheriff Dick Mecum. Mr. Calabro is employed by the Hall County Fire Department.

came by our Gainesville Service Center to visit with Rick Aiken on the morning of March 1st. Rick was not in at the time. told our center manager that others have encouraged him to sue the Boy Scouts of America, but he does not wish to do so.

I spoke with Rick on the afternoon of March 1st and we agreed he would visit with the and explain that Mr. Calabro will be removed from all volunteer positions in our council and put in the confidential file thus banning him from registering anywhere else in the country. Rick is to express our concerns and offer our help whenever possible.

No letter has been prepared to deliver to Mr. Calabro since he cannot be located. Sheriff Mecum did tell Rick that he plans to arrest Mr. Calabro when he returns to Gainesville.

I have notified our Council President, George Vest, the Regional Personnel Director, Jim Johnson, and our Attorney, Upshaw Bentley. I will keep you apprised of any happenings as they occur. We will forward the confidential file form as soon as we are able to gather the information requested.


