I will answer your questions in the sequence they were asked.

- 1. Mr. Blaskovic pleaded quilty. (See newspaper clipping). The formal sentencing will be on November 16th. At that time, I will furnish you the necessary papers you requested.
- 2. The charges against Larry James Payne, 18 year-old were dismissed. He was registered as a Boy Scout in Troop 355, Weatherford, during the period covered by the charges. My understanding from the police about Larry is that they had solid charges against him, but due to mitigating circumstances, the charges were dismissed. It seems that his first father physically abused him and sexually abused him. Larry complained about sexual abuse to child welfare while being in Del City, but no action was taken. I will try to get the information you requested from the Weatherford Police Department on Larry this Thursday. If this report is not needed, please let me know.
