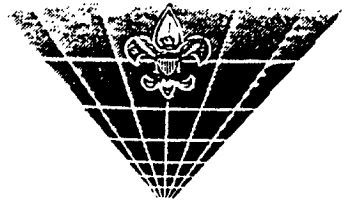

We have heard nothing, nor has there been any indication in the newspaper regarding the case.


A conversation with the Scoutmaster indicates that Mr. Alpren's case is still pending, yet he has moved with the permission of the Court.

Summary of conversation with Larry Alpren

After considerable time spent on notifying the Chartered Partner, St. Lawrence Church of West Haven and arranging for an appointment the below statement is a summary of a conversation between Larry Alpren of West Haven, Ct. and Dennis Prefontaine, Field Director - Quinnipiac Council, J. Edward Malatesta - Assistant Council Commissioner - Quinnipiac Council and Anthony Marro - Scoutmaster Troop 8, St. Lawrence Church.

An appointment was made by Tony Marro with Larry Alpren at 4:30 P.M. on April 13. Mr. Alpren stated he could see us at his home between 5:15 and 5:30 P.M. that day.

Mr. Marro notified Dennis Prefontaine who in turn notified Mr. Malatesta. We met in front of [REDACTED] West Haven at 5:35 P.M.

Mr. Alpren asked that we go into the kitchen. Mr. Marro made the introductions.

Dennis Prefontaine offered his business card and presented to Mr. Alpren a sealed envelope containing a letter from Council President, David Hungerford.

Mr. Prefontaine stated that we were aware of his situation and asked that he "disassociate himself from the program."

Mr. Alpren agreed. He was extremely pleasant, and cooperative. He stated, "He assumed this would be coming and didn't blame us for what we had to do." He also stated, "I guess I'd be the first to ask it, if it were someone else".

He went on to say that he and his family had been through a lot, and that he had secured a lawyer, and hoped he could be involved in the program again when this was all cleaned up.

Mr. Prefontaine stated that that process was addressed in the letter.

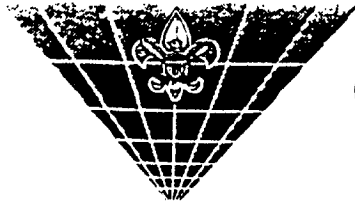
We stated that his sons were welcome to and encouraged to stay in the Troop, and he agreed.



After a brief chat regarding the recent Fishing Derby, Mr. Alpren asked of Mr. Prefontaine's accent. He too offered that he was born and brought up in Maine, was an Eagle Scout in Wells Beach, and knew of Camp Hinds and Madochawanda Lodge of the O.A.

The entire conversation was over by 5:45 P.M.

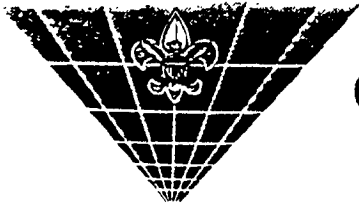

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be granted or reinstated.

The undersigned, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. That the undersigned has been a regular member of the West Haven Police Department for 1 year and 9 months and during that period acted in my official capacity as a member of said department. The facts and circumstances contained herein were obtained through the undersigned own investigative efforts. I hereby submit this arrest warrant for your consideration.
2. That on 2-26-87 at 1536 hours I was dispatched to 95 North Union Ave on a sexual misconduct complaint. Upon arrival, the undersigned spoke with [redacted] who stated her 10 year old daughter, [redacted] informed her that [redacted] Larry Aloren touched her between her legs while she slept over the [redacted] house. [redacted] stated [redacted] slept over the [redacted] on February 20, 1987.
3. That on 2-26-87 at approximately 1515 hours [redacted] confided in her 11 year old [redacted] as they were getting ready to enter the [redacted] home. [REDACTED] stated she was extremely frightened - each time she tried to get up from the couch, Mr. Alpren would push her back to the couch. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] finally woke up to go to the bathroom and that is when she got up and said she had to go to the bathroom and both girls went to sleep in [REDACTED] room.
