Since Troop 203 is sponsored by the Latter Day Saints Church, a Dr. Bill Tanner, member of our Board of Directors, Vice Chairman of the Council, and President of the L.A. Stake has also been notified.

as the last paragraph ^{of} ^{his} letter indicates?

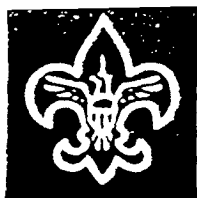
Mr VanDyke said: "This is totally not true and it can be proven. Mr Bobiak said, "we are not saying yah or nah simply delivering this notice".

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a council review committee, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a Boy Scouts of America member should be granted.
