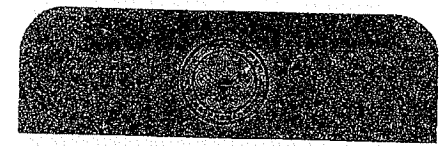

Thank you for your letter of March 30. I would love to sit at the window and look at the old Heidelberg castle. I do remember the beautiful view from that castle as you look down over the city, the river, and the university below.

I may have left you under the wrong impression in my letter of December 22. We do place men on the Confidential File for many reasons. As the years pass, we sometimes register men on probation if their behavior is such that the local council wishes to recommend it. However, when we get a statement so positive as on Atkins, we refuse to ever register them at any time. You might explain this to your staff member.

We will continue to keep Mr. Hibbert on the Confidential File and have placed Atkins there as you recommend.

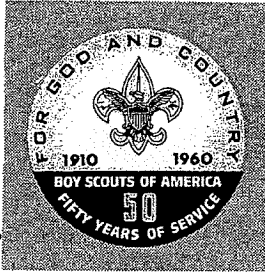

Dear Basil:

Joe D'Anna is up from Italy for our quarterly staff meeting and he has just given me a report on your letter of 22 December 1959. It is a shock to realize that these confidential reports take so long in this council!

Major Moore (former Staff Explorer Officer in the USA) and Joe D'Anna had a fuzzy idea of the operation of our Confidential File, and I find that most of my staff members did not realize that there is only one reason for barring a man forever from Scouting.

Hibbert was discharged as unsuitable for the Air Force. He must have been a sorry airman and it appears that he was chasing other women, but these bad marks do not qualify him for our Confidential File.


I regret, however, that Atkins does qualify for our infamous file. He was found guilty in a case which involved a Boy Scout. He was discharged and his personnel records are no longer in the SETAF Command. Military authorities will not discuss the case since it is closed. He was registered as ASM with Troop 76 of Leghorn, Italy. He should be placed on our Confidential File.

It's a beautiful day in Heidelberg and I can see the castle on the hill from my office window. The fruit trees are blooming, and I am looking forward to driving to Frankfurt this afternoon.

Normally, we hate to drive in Germany. The death rate in West Germany is 40 persons per day, and the accident rate is nine times that of the USA! These figures are from the local press and are reliable.

I'll be back in the good old USA in July, and will look forward to seeing you again at that time.
