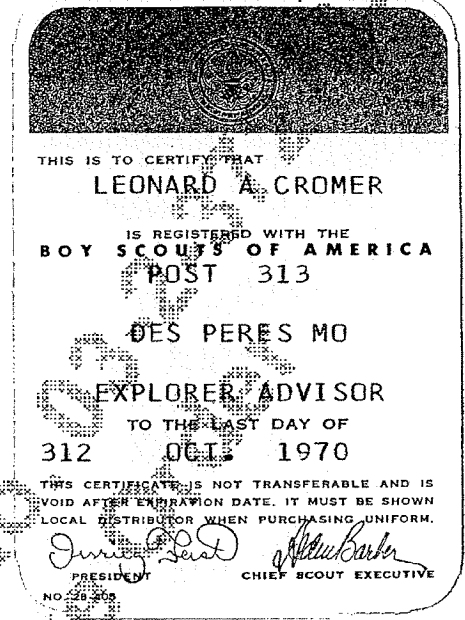

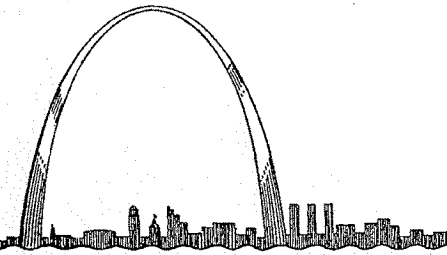

Mr. Cromer has volunteered to resign from his position with the Boy Scouts.

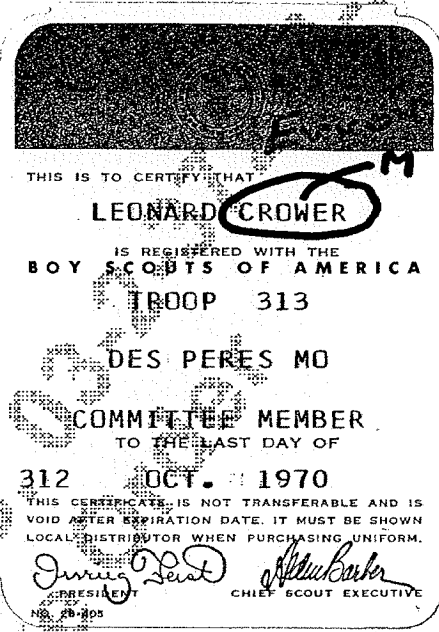
