Jury getting two views of molestation suspect

Leslie Leon Paul exploited the trust of four boys when he molested them repeatedly for two years, a prosecutor told jurors Tuesday.

But the lawyer defending Paul, 48 told the jury that evidence will show the parents of three of the boys did not want Paul prosecuted und! they learned they could lose their children if they did not cooperate.

Baul, a former member of the Air Force, went on trial this week on 53 felony charges including numerous counts of molestation, sexual conduct with a minor and public sexual indecency.

He is accused of molesting the boys, who are between the ages of 8 and 12, from 1987 until July 1989. Three of the boys are the sons of a friend of Paul's and the other is a neighbor.

Deputy County Attorney Allen C. McVey told jurors that Paul was close friends with the father of the boys and the two met in the Air Force in 1978.

"They developed a friendship that ripened over the years," McVey told jurors.

The two worked together in West Germany. In 1987, the men ended up in Tucson and the friendship continued.

Paul stayed with the family for several months, and "basically was like a member of the family," McVey said. After he moved out, he stayed in close contact with the family and spent time with the boys, he said. They spent the night with him

and went on trips together, McVey said.

Last summer, police learned of the alleged molestations while arresting the neighbor victim. The youth, who was accused of forcing two children to have sex, told police he had been molested by Paul.

A police officer then talked to the three brothers. The two he first spoke to said they had not been molested. The third originally said he had not, but then said he had. The two other children then admitted they had been molested by Paul, said Assistant Public Defender Richard Lougee.

McVey said the allegations came as "quite a surprise" to the parents of the three boys.

"At first they simply couldn't believe it." he said.

McVey and Lougee said that even after Paul was in jail, the family continued their friendship with Paul.

Lougee said the family wrote to Paul, did his laundry and visited him in jail almost weekly.

Lougee said the family indicated they did not want Paul prosecuted. When a police officer told the family they had to stop visiting Paul, the family became hostile toward the defendant. Lougee said. He said the family feared the children would be taken away by the state.

"You are going to have real problems finding 53 counts have been proven against Mr. Paul." Lougee told jurors.

Testimony began Monday before Pima County Superior Court Judge Pro Tempore Richard Nichols. March 1, 1990

Tucsonan indicted in boys' molesting

73-count case involves 4 youngsters, 8-12

A Tucson man has been indicted on 73 felony counts involving the

alleged molestation of four boys.

Leslie Leon Paul, 47, was charged with multiple counts of molestation, sexual conduct with a minor and public sexual indecency in a Pima County grand jury indictment Friday.

The case is among those with the highest number of counts involving molestation in county history.

The boys, three of whom are brothers, are between the ages of 8 and 12, said Blaise Romeo, a detective with the Tucson Police Department.

Paul is accused of molesting the boys between October 1987 and last month. He was arrested Aug. 3 after Romeo was told by the father of one of the victims that the child had been molested.

Romeo said he was investigating allegations that one of the victims in the case had forced a girl to engage in sexual activity with an 8-year-old boy. Before the boy was arrested, his father told Romeo that his son said he had been molested by Paul.

Romeo said he interviewed the four alleged victims and each said nothing had happened. But he said when he was interviewing the last boy, the child finally admitted he had been molested. Romeo said when he talked to the other boys

again, they all said they had been molested by Paul.

Romeo said Paul had been friends with the father of the three boys for at least 10 years and he spent a good deal of time with the boys

"He befriended those kids," Romeo said. "They really, really cared for him. He really treated them nice. He did good things for them. He would watch movies with them and a lot of other things."

But while the man was friends with the boys, he also molested them, Romeo said.

"It's a hard thing to imagine, but it happens," Romeo said.

Romeo said the boys were molested individually and in groups. He said Paul would molest one of the boys while the others watched.

Several counts are charged in most of the incidents because there was usually more than one victim involved, Romeo said.

"And I only got probably onetenth of what these kids remember," Romeo said.

He said the victim who was suspected of forcing a girl to engage in a sex act with an 8-year-old boy was probably a product of his victimization.

"This is how he learns these things," Romeo said.

Paul, who is a subcontractor, was being held in Pima County Jail on \$45,000 bond last night.
