Prison site finalists named

SPRINGFIELD (AP) — Six communities, including one that promoted itself in a rap music video aimed nationwide, have been named as finalists for the site of a new 750-bed prison, state corrections officials said Monday.

Possible sites for the \$41 million medium-security facility are Decatur, Fla., Mount Vernon, Indiana, Sycamore and Taylorville.

Several towns went to great lengths and expense to win over state officials.

Flora, with about 3,000 people, drew national attention when it produced a music video featuring local people and portraying the Southern Illinois town as a prime site for the prison.

Edgar may be no confirmation

CHICAGO (AP) — Bruce S. Kelly, secretary of state, said on Friday he would not reveal whether President George Bush has chosen Republican presidential nominee at a rally Friday in Springfield.

Edgar's spokesman, Gary Mack, said Monday he would neither confirm nor deny newspaper reports that Edgar will announce his endorsement of Bush when the vice president stops in Springfield on his way to Des Moines, Iowa.

But Mack outlined a schedule for the Republican secretary of state and Bush on Friday that made it appear Edgar was going to endorse the vice president for the GOP nomination.

Mack said Bush is scheduled to arrive at the Capitol at 12:20 p.m. for a 25-minute rally with Edgar in

Two men facing sexual abuse charges in court

Two-area men facing sexual abuse charges appeared before Judge Paul Komada Monday.

A jury trial was set for Feb. 9 for Daniel Edward Scribner of Humboldt. Scribner, no age available, is accused of fondling his 10-year-old stepdaughter Nov. 25.

Lester D. Lee, 39, of Ashmore, was appointed a public defender and had a preliminary hearing set for Jan. 11. Lee is charged with having oral sex on three occasions in February, April or May and August with a 14-year-old boy.

Larry D. Oliver, 44, 1400 18th St., Charleston, was sentenced Monday to three years' imprisonment and ordered to pay \$100 in court costs after being found guilty of having in his possession June 3 a shotgun with a barrel less than 18 inches long. Komada gave Oliver three days credit off his sentence for time spent in jail awaiting trial.

In other court developments, Russell J. Jordan, 29, 2015 Commercial Ave., Mattoon, pleaded innocent to two charges of delivering 19 to 29 grams of marijuana on Nov. 18 and Nov. 19. Jury trial was set for Feb. 9.

Steve Anderson, 41, 477 LeWitt Ave., Mattoon, pleaded innocent to charges he wrote 22 bad checks totaling \$815.04 between Aug. 25 and Sept. 25. Jury trial was set for Feb. 9.

At his preliminary hearing Monday, Tommy J. Hoover, 29, Leland Mobile Estates #123, Mattoon, pleaded innocent to delivering between 10 and 30 grams of marijuana April 24. A jury trial was set for Feb. 9.

A jury trial on Feb. 9 was also set for Charles E. Williams, 28, 1810 Broadway, Mattoon, and for Manuel Baker, age unavailable, 1320 N. 10th St., Mattoon.

Williams pleaded innocent to charges he delivered between one and 19 grams of cocaine on two occasions in June and Baker pleaded innocent to charges he delivered 3.4 grams of Diazepam, a controlled substance, April 17.

Also Monday, a public defender was appointed for Greg A. Harris, 21, 1812 Dakota Ave., who is charged with aggravated assault and disorderly conduct following a fight at Hardee's in Mattoon.

Residential burglary charges were filed Monday against Billy J. Woodard, 17, 708 N. Second Livestock St., Woodard is charged with taking a wallet and currency Sunday from Tom Raymond, 62, 747 North Ingram Heights, in Taylor Ave., Mattoon.

DULUTH, Minn. (AP) — Former Illinois Gov. Dan Walker surrendered Monday to authorities at a minimum-security prison to begin serving a seven-year federal prison term for bank fraud and perjury.

Walker arrived at the Federal Prison Camp at Duluth at mid-morning, said spokesman Ronald King.

"He was assigned to a dormitory room, and he'll be sharing it with three or four people," the spokesman said. "After he understands orientation later this week, he'll be given a job."

The Duluth prison facility houses about 750 inmates and offers a range of recreational activities from weightlifting to bowling. King
