### Former teacher placed on 3 years probation

A former Monroe school teacher already serving a seven-year state prison sentence for indecent behavior with a juvenile Thursday was placed on three years supervised probation for a federal weapons conviction.

Lewis T. Bivins, 43, 4007 S. Grand St., Monroe, was sentenced in U.S. District Court in Monroe for illegal possession of a firearm, an M-16 rifle. He pleaded guilty to the charge Dec. 8.

Monroe Police found the gun in his home after his February 1989 arrest on oral sexual battery and carnal knowledge of a juvenile charges.

Bivins pleaded guilty to the indecent behavior with a juvenile charge and was sentenced in 4th District Court Dec. 23. The charge resulted from a relationship with a 13-year-old student.

He was employed as a fourth grade teacher at Sherrouse Elementary School in Monroe.

U.S. District Judge Donald Walter withheld imposing a jail sentence and said he would not fine Bivins because Bivins is financially unable to pay a fine. A special condition of probation requires that he perform 60 hours of community service. His probation begins after he finishes serving the state sentence.

Bivins could have been sentenced to 10 years in prison and fined \$250,000.

## Ex-teacher adn Bivins to ac

A former Sherrouse Elementary School teacher arrested in February on sex charges involving one of his students pleaded guilty in 4th District Court Tuesday to indecent behavior with a juvenile.

Lewis T. Bivins Jr., 42, 4007 South Grand St., was charged in a March 15 bill of information with oral sexual battery and carnal knowledge of a juvenile in connection with incidents involving a 13-year-old girl.

The incidents allegedly occurred between Sept. 1, 1988, and Feb. 20, 1989, and between Aug. 1, 1988, and Feb. 20, 1989.

Indecent behavior with a juvenile carries a maximum penalty of seven years in prison or a parish jail, a fine of \$5,000 or both.

State law defines the charge as the commission of a lewd and lascivious act by anyone over age 17 upon the

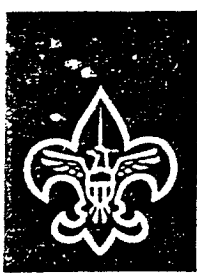


