SUBJECT: ABNOTMAL SECUAL DELAVIOR OF PHIL PHLEGTY, SCOUTMASTER, TROOP, 51

DATE: JULY 9, 1976

ON THURSDAY JULY 8, 1976, CAMP CORMISSIONER

CALLED TO MY ATTENTION A SITUATION INVOLVING THE BIZAR E SEXUAL SEMAVIOR OF PAIL PHELEDY, SCOUTMASTER OF TROOP 51. THE REPORT CAME TO FROM SEMIOR PATROL LEADER OF THE TROOP, AND SCOUT UPON LEARNING OF THE INCIDENT, I VISITED WITH SCOUTS AND AT 2:00 P.M. ON FRIDAY JULY (9), 1976. THEY RELATED THE FOLLOWING. BOTH SCOUTS SAID THEY WOULD TESTIFY FURTHER ON THE FACTS, IF MELDED.

- a. Mr. Phology has been the Scoutmaster for four years, and this activity has been joing on during his tenure.
- b. On Troop Campouts, Phelegy takes boys into the woods, or up the road for "conferences", at which time he plans with their genitals.

 says that the older boys in the troop have devised a buddy system whereby, boys never go alone with Phelegy unless accompanied by two of the older boys.
- c. The do. mittee Chairman, Walter Murphy has known about the situation for sometime, via a letter written and signed by the older boys. His response to them was, "can't do anything about it."
- d. In the basement of Mr. Phelegy's house in late May, Scout was asked to help assemble camp manual's for the troop. While in the process of assembling manuals, Phelegy pulled down his pents, producing a large erection and asked Scout if he wanted to "such his dick."
- e. While in camp the weak of 7/4/76, while in swimming, he has made a game out of diving under water and grabbing the genitals of troop members.
- f. On 7/9 while placing sunburn ointment on the legs of Scout e also applied ointment to his genitals.
- g. On 7/8, then Scout went to Phlege, for aspiring Phelage grasped his genitals.
- h. On 777 , Phelege placed his hand on the genitals of Scout
- I. Scout indicated that Phelege is very open about his activities. He once said, "There is nothing wrong with what I do, my brothers and I used to do it all the time when we lived down on the farm."

NIEMO TO: Russ Hart FROM: Bob Winschief SUBJECT: Phil Rhegley, Scoutmaster, Troop 51 DATE: July 19, 1976

As a result of a memo from - Camp Sakima, regarding the alleged abnormal behavior of Phil Phegley, Scoutmaster of Troop 51, Our Lady of Sorrows R. C. Church, Cherokee District, I called Troop 51 Committee Chairman, Walter Murphy, and arranged to visit with him that morning (Monday, July 12, 1976) at his house.

Shortly after my arrival, Mr. Joe Grana, Committeeman for Troop 51 joined Mr. Murphy and myself as a result of a call to him placed by Mr. Murphy. I shared the content of the memo with them and committeeman and father of referred to in the memo - was called and he also joined us.

Because Scouts and and (also mentioned in the memo) and available, they also were called and asked to join us. is a member of the Troop 51 committee.

The four committeemen present decided to question the two Scouts to confirm that what had been told to was correct. Shout was called in.

substantiated all points mentioned in the memo without having seen it and confirmed the incident between himself and Mr. Phegley of the Scoutmaster's home in late May. (Item d in memo)

was called in and mentioned one personal incident and commented that among the boyo in the troop the Scoutmaster's actions were common knowledge and in fact, joked about at several area high schools.

The Socuts were told of the seriousness of their accusations and both Scouts were asked to state under Scout Oath that what they had said was true and they did. They then were dismissed.

Committeemen present, Messrs. Murphy, Grana and agreed that Mr. Phegley's resignation as Scoutmaster would be asked for and they discussed who on the committee would do so.

It was agreed that since the following evening - Tuesday, July 13, 1976 was the regularly scheduled troop committee meeting, the Scoutmaster would be asked for his resignation there. Mr. Murphy indicated that he would contect, that very evening, the three remaining regularly notive committeemen and brief them. The committeemen then separated.

In. Fail Pagley called me Tuesday morning - July 13, 1976 at approximately 3:40 a.m. and said he had been confronted the previous evening with the allegation mentioned in the memo. He stated he had given his resignation to the individual calling on him. Mr. Pagley said he had tried to recall any actions on his part that could have been construed as urong and could not recall any except item f mentioned in memo.


He said he had given his resignation because he could not be associated with the troop if people believed he did the things alleged. He asked if he needed to do anything in so far as the Scout Council was concerned and I said no. I stated that we did not make the accusations and I had no comment on them. After some silence he said goodby.

Following Mr. Phegley's phone call I called Mr. Murphy who said that Mr. Vern Thurman had visited with Mr. Phegley Monday evening and had gotten Mr. Phegley's resignation. The regularly scheduled Troop Committee Meeting would be held that evening, Tuesday the 13th of July. I said I would call again on Wednesday to see if anything further had developed as a result of the meeting.

IIr. Murphy was called Mednesday, the lith of July, and he confirmed that the committee did, in fact, have Mr. Pheglay's resignation in writing and stated that all Scoutmaster mail should be directed to him as Troop Chairman.

With regard to the anonymous typed letter to Mr. Murphy in November, 1975: No action was taken because the letter was unsigned and those older Scouts questioned by Mr. Murphy denied sending the letter. Mr. Murphy shared the letter with two additional committeemen in November and they agreed to watch for any indication that allegations in the letter might have basis in truth. They saw none and dismissed the letter as a grudge note by some Scout no longer with the troop.

Men questioned by the committee on Monday, July 12, both Scout said they knew of the letter, but gave no indication that they knew who sent it. Asked why they had not come forward sooner to the committee the boys said Mr. Phegley was a good Scoutmaster and they wished him no harm.
