

Dear Bill.

This letter is per your request to inform you of the events leading up to the termination of Lynn Sill as a member of our Cub Scout Fack.

In 1980, we reformed pack 79, and Lynn wanted to become a Webelos leader as he had been one in his previous council. He seemed very interested in working with the 10 year olds and did take time off from work to take the Webelos to summer camp at Custalogatown, at that time it was for an entire week. He would also have the boys camping on the Pack's campgrounds, several times a year. I have attended several of these campouts with him. At some of these weekend campouts when the weather was extremely hot, we would take the boys down to the stream near the campgrounds and the boys could take off their cloths and jump in. Some of the boys took everything off, while others left their shorts on. At that time I saw nothing wrong with letting the boys do this. But as time went on I found out that he encouraged all the boys to take off their cloths each time they went camping.

Over the next few years I noticed that we were loosing boys after they were in Webelos for only six months or so. A problem surfaced in that Lynn was pulling the elastic on the boys underwear and releasing it. This occured at the den meetings as well as at summer camp. Lynn was advised that this practice would stop immediately. With no more complaints I assumed that it did.

The problem of the boys quiting just before graduating from Webelos continued. Many talks with Lynn did not lead to a reason why the boys quit. Then in 1984, following the Webelos summer camp at Custalogatown, a parent called me and indicated that their son has just made statements of what went on at summer camp.

It was stated that while several boys were in the tent with Lynn, the discussion somehow centered on sex. A 10 year old boy just does not start talking about sex. Appearently the discussion lead to a complete explanation of how the sexual act was performed. That was not the time or place for that type of information to be given to a boy by a non parent. The boys were also warned not to tell their parents about the discussion. As far as we have been able to fine out, Lynn has never touched a boy in a sexual manner, so it appears to be voyeurism.


Once this came to light, the pack committee held an emergency meeting to discuss this problem. It was decided to releave Lynn as a Webelos leader but leave him stay as a committee member. But several days later more information was obtained concerning the pack in that they had a leader who did thing with boys. This presented to a creditability factor for the pack. The orange sheets of paper enclosed is a copy of the emergency meeting and what was decided.

Lynn did not seek any counciling as he felt that he did not have a problem. The committee did not press to ban him from scouting except from the local council. Then with in the past year the president of the PTA called me and asked if these stories were true because her son was on a campout with Lynn and that the swimming in the nude problem occured. She was upset especially because of the time of year it occured. Boys will be boys, but when an adult is present and encouraging this type of activity. Also, she was not sure if she wanted to run as president of the PTA because Lynn was running as vice president, and she felt that it would be hard to work with him, knowing what she did. It appears that the problem has not corrected itself, this is why the committee of our pack want to prevent him from ever becoming a member in the Boy Scouts of America. We may not be able to have him convicted in court, but we want to prevent him from working with boys and giving the BSA a bad name.

When I reorganized this pack, the pack had a bad name, because of how the previous leaders operated the pack. It took several years to give it a good name again. Two years after the above incident, which brings us to the present, a parent called me because she wanted to have her sons join Cub Scouts, but wanted to know if I was a member of the PTA. The inference was there. She wanted to know if I was the scout leader, now PTA member who ?????? SO THE STORY GOES ON.
