8-6-85 Detective Crane and myself contacted Marcos Adrian Arevalo at a restaurant across from the courthouse in Tacoma. Marcos was staying with the owners of the restaurant and is in the U.S. as an exchange Boy Scout Counselor. Marcos was the suspect in an alleged Indecent Liberties that occurred at Camp Hahobas in the Tahuya peninsula.

Marcos was read his rights in spanish by Officer William Meeks of Tacoma P.D. Marcos stated that he would prefer to have an attorney present who was fluent in spanish before he answered questions. The interview was terminated at this point.

8-7-85 Detective Crane contacted the victim in Orting at his residence and obtained a statement reference the incident. Detective Crane contacted me at the Tacoma P.D. and we went to the restaurant and contacted Marcos at about 12:40. Based on the victim's statement, Marcos was advised that he was under arrest and he stated that he understood. I then transported Marcos to the Mason County Sheriff's Office for booking.

Robert Rabelo arrived at the Jail to act as an interpreter and Larry King was contacted since Marcos had indicated a desire for an attorney. Marcos was read his rights in spanish by Mr. Rabelo and he signed the form stating that he understood his rights. Larry King conferred with Marcos for a short time and Marcos decided to follow the advise of Mr. King and not give a statement.

The interview was terminated and Marcos was booked.

08/12/85 This writer contacted [REDACTED], possible witness and tent partner to the victim, via telephone. [REDACTED] acknowledged he was in the tee pee with the victim and Marcos on the night in question. [REDACTED] stated that he did not observe or hear any unusual activity between [REDACTED] and Marcos Arevalo. [REDACTED] expressed some concerns about the validity of the allegations against Marcos. His first concern was the fact why [REDACTED] did not ask for help if something was happening to him. [REDACTED] said that he was in the same tee-pee and only a few feet from the victim. [REDACTED] stated that Marcos would not do anything like that to anyone and does not understand why anyone would make such allegation against Marcos. This writer verified with [REDACTED], that he did not hear or see Marcos touch [REDACTED] in any manner. Further [REDACTED] first learned of the problem the next morning, from the Camp Director Mike Davitt. The victim, [REDACTED] had requested to sleep in the tee-pee occupied by [REDACTED] Marcos was not assigned a particular tent to sleep in. [REDACTED] stated that Marcos came into the tent after he was asleep.

Mickey McAllister asked me to provide you the following information. An International Camp Staff member from Mexico serving in the camp operated by the Mt. Rainier Council at Tacoma, Washington, has been arrested, arraigned, and charged with indecent liberties, due to an incident at camp, charges have been brought by the victim's parents. Arraignment took place on August 15th. The individual is Marcos Adrian Arevalo Leal, age 24, from Mexico City.

He has been released on his own recognizance under the supervision of Mr. and Mrs. Edmund Carey, [REDACTED], Tacoma, Washington 98405. They are Scouters who he became acquainted with during the camp season. They are providing shelter and food for him. He is represented by legal counsel, Larry King, Phone [REDACTED]. He is required to have evaluation by an expert in sexual deviation behavior by a Spanish speaking individual. He is also limited in his movement, and in contact with minors. Representatives in the council at Tacoma are securing a written statement from the prosecutors office regarding these charges and will send us a copy. The next hearing is set for 9:00 AM, October 16th, and the trial for October 18th.

We have notified, by telex, on this date, the Asociacion De Scouts De Mexico and Jose Leal Trejo, at Yurecuaro #60, Mexico D.F. 15200, who was listed as the emergency contact by Marcos. Copy of the two telex are attached.
