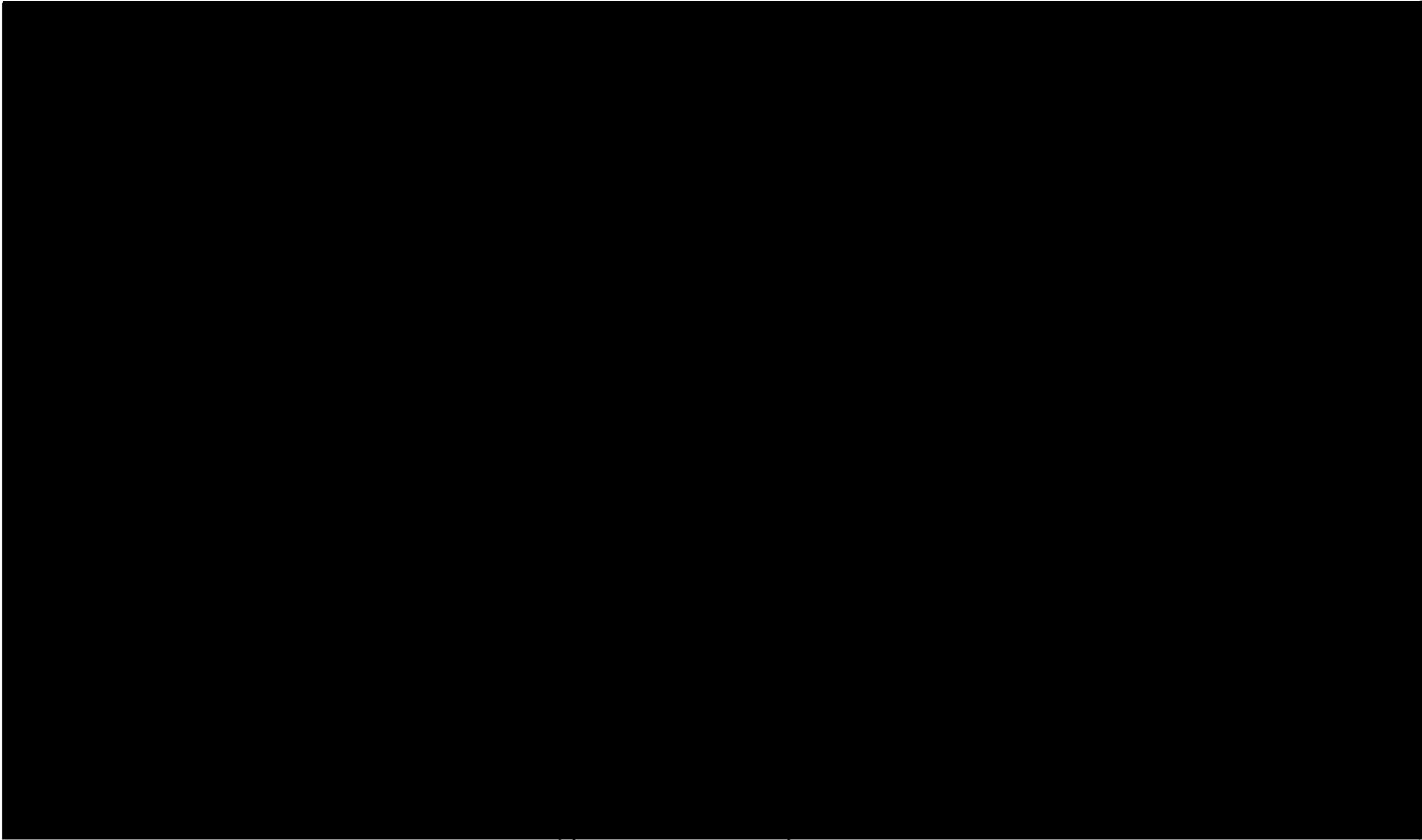



Dear Greg:

Please find enclosed a courtesy copy of a plea agreement that was entered on today's date by the Judge concerning the criminal prosecution of Mark Jagers. The case was set for jury trial last week on October 31, 1991. During my trial preparation for the case on the 29th and 30th, I had several interviews with the victim [REDACTED] and his parents. I had my witnesses subpoenaed, lined up and ready to testify. Without any warning, I received a telephone call from the mother of [REDACTED] at 4:00 p.m. on October 30, 1991 that "she" and [REDACTED] had decided that he did not want to testify and they didn't care if the charges were dropped. As there is not much sense in prosecuting a case where the victim doesn't care, I decided to try a bluff and at least salvage a misdemeanor conviction. Please note the conditions of probation in the event that Mr. Jagers ever attempt to get involved in Scouting in the future. If you have any questions, or need further information, please do not hesitate to call me here at the office.

JUDGMENT AND FINAL SENTENCE ON GUILTY PLEA

MARK JAGGERS

DEFENDANT

This 5th day of November, 1991, came the DEFENDANT MARK JAGGERS, together with Counsel, Attorney Mike Nichols and Attorney James C. Ladd appearing for the COMMONWEALTH.

On Motion of the COMMONWEALTH, and sustained by the Court, the Indictment was amended from Sodomy in the Second Degree to Sodomy in the 4th Degree.

WHEREUPON, the Indictment as amended, was read to the DEFENDANT and he was advised of his constitutional rights, viz: right to trial by jury; right to confront his accusers and cross-examine the witnesses; and that these rights could be waived only by him with the agreement of his Counsel and the COMMONWEALTH.

DEFENDANT was further informed that if convicted by a legally constituted jury, he had the right of appeal to the Court of Appeals; and, if he was without sufficient funds, Counsel would be appointed and a record prepared at public expense.

DEFENDANT was further advised by the Court that the Court was not bound by any promises or commitments made to him by anyone and that if he waived trial by jury and agreed together with Counsel and the Attorney for the COMMONWEALTH to have the

Court fix punishment, the Court could fix punishment at the minimum or maximum penalty.

DEFENDANT was then questioned by the Court as to whether he had been under the influence of alcohol, marijuana, narcotics or any controlled substance within the past 48 hours, to all of which the DEFENDANT answered in the negative.

DEFENDANT was further questioned by the Court as to whether he had had any mental problems during his lifetime, to which the DEFENDANT answered in the negative.

The DEFENDANT was then questioned by the Court as to whether he was satisfied with the services of his attorney, to which the DEFENDANT answered in the affirmative.

The Court, having advised the DEFENDANT of all his constitutional rights, and having questioned him as above stated, and being of the opinion that the DEFENDANT was of sufficient mental capacity to understand the charges against him and to understand his rights, and the Court being of the further opinion that there was a factual basis for the DEFENDANT'S plea, said DEFENDANT was then questioned by the Court as to what his plea was to the charge as set forth in the Amended Indictment.

WHEREUPON, the Defendant, with the agreement of his defense counsel and the Commonwealth, waived the above rights and entered a plea of Guilty pursuant to North Carolina vs. Alford, 400 U.S. 25 (U.S. Sup. Ct., 1970) to the charge of Sodomy in the Fourth Degree.

WHEREUPON, the Court found said DEFENDANT guilty and upon recommendation of the COMMONWEALTH, sentence was fixed at 12

months in the Larue County Jail. Provided however, that the entire 12 month sentence is hereby SUSPENDED for a period of 24 months conditioned as follows:

1. The Defendant is to remain on good behavior during the entire period of probation.


2. The Defendant will not come into Hart County for any reason during the period of probation.

3. The Defendant will immediately terminate any involvement that he has with the Boy Scouts of America and will not be involved with the Boy Scouts in the future.

As the Defendant is indigent and represented by the Public Defender, the court costs of this action are waived.


It is further ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the DEFENDANT is hereby credited for the time spent in custody prior to the commencement of sentence, namely 10 days toward the service of the maximum term of imprisonment.



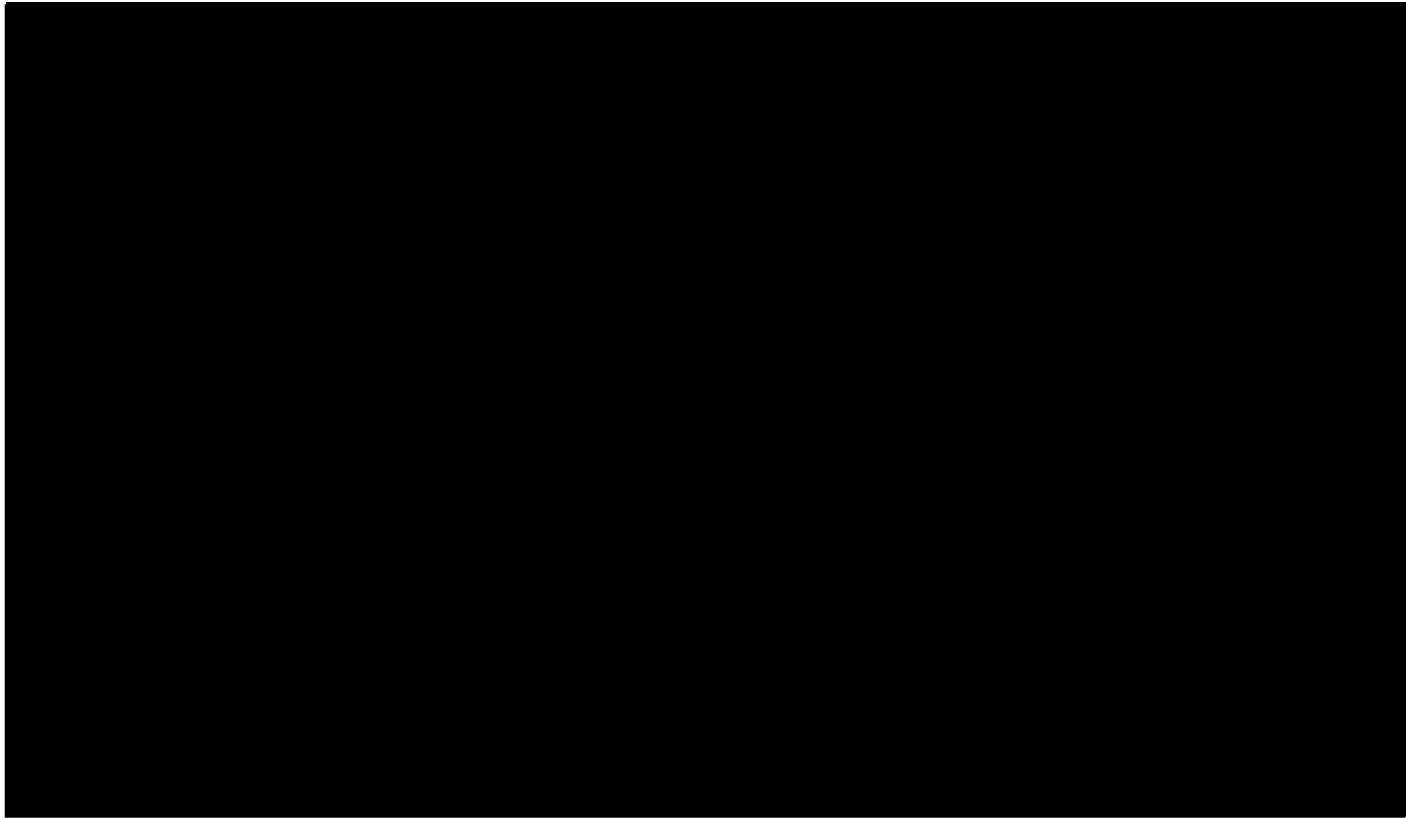

Thanks for your help in this matter. We hope you will tell us if we may be of help in any other way.

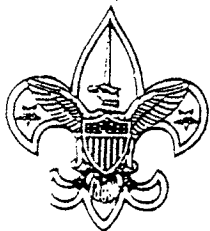


Dear Mark A. Jagers,

After careful review , we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be denied. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who may apply. We reserve to the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for the American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

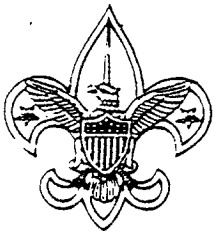

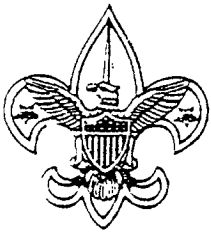

Behavioral indicators: The youth will not speak to his mother about the incident, he will only speak to his scout leaders.

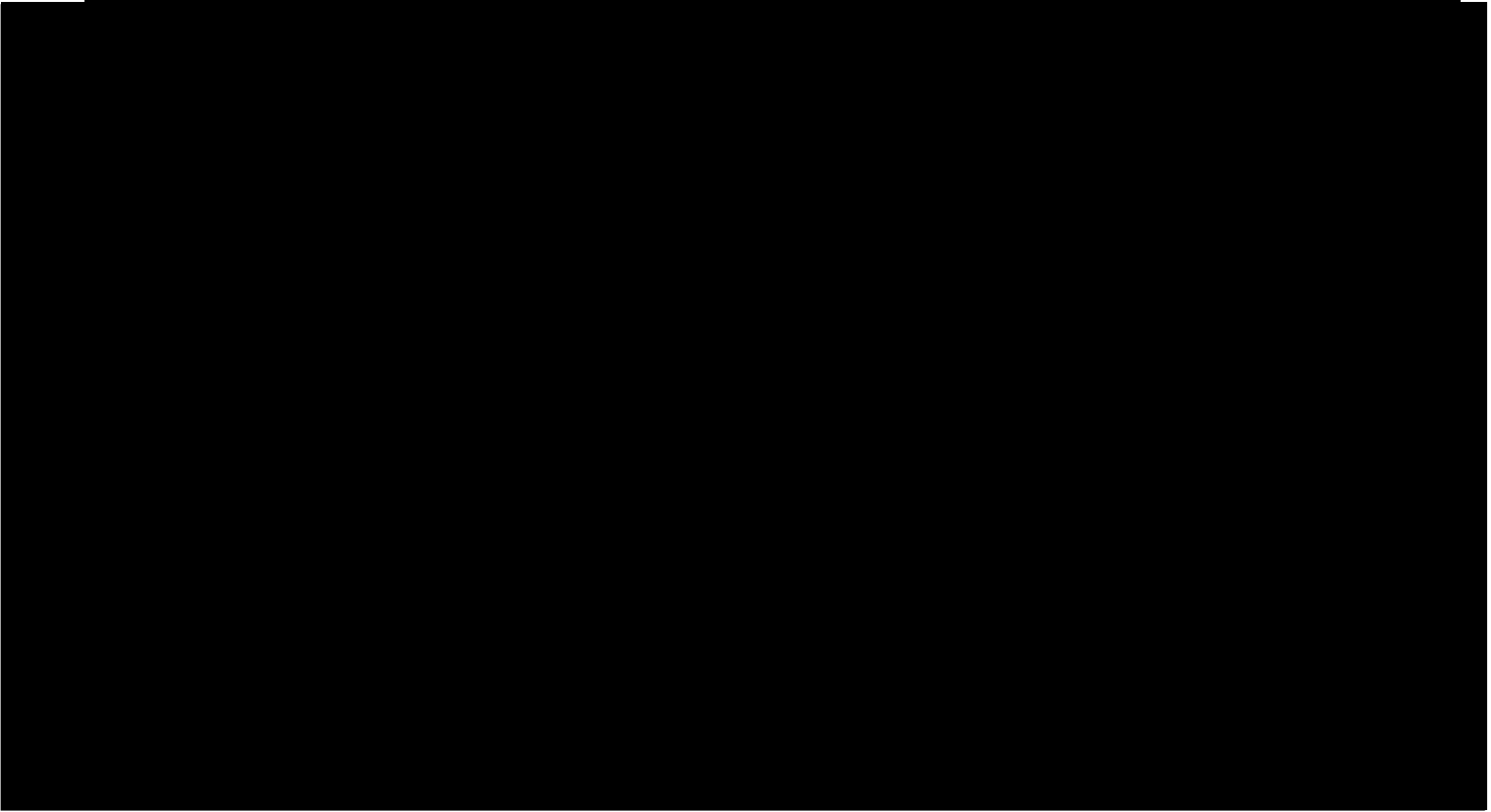
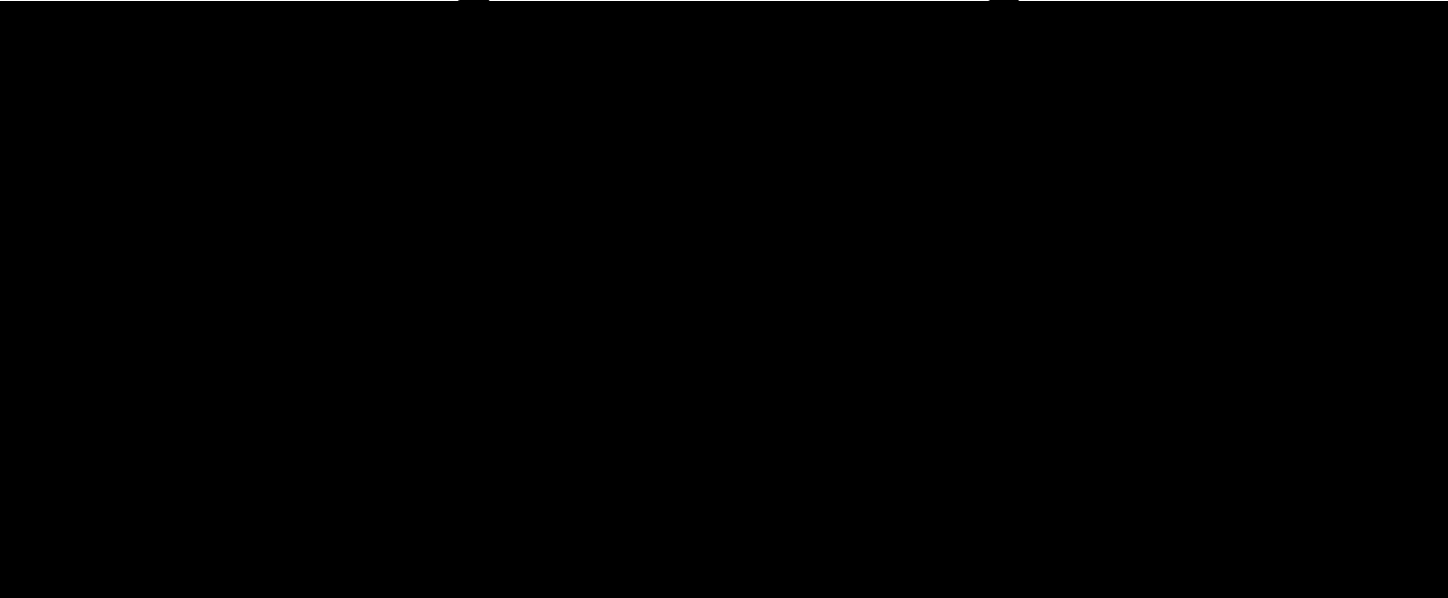
