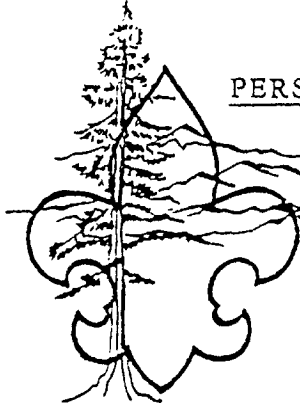

SUBJECT: MARK L. DUNKIN AND CHARLES GREWE

Dear Paul:


I am responding to your letter of September 21 requesting some information on Mark Dunkin. Enclosed is a copy of his signature which is highlighted on the last charter renewal.

I have talked with detective Pince regarding the status of Dunkin's case. On September 30, he told me that the case is now formally closed. The reason is that they couldn't prove a statement by [redacted] that he had been forced to be fondled by Dunkin. Since [redacted] was over the age of 14 and the State could not prove force, the case was dropped. The law has since changed, and if the same situation arose today Dunkin could be charged with the crime of child molestation. It's important to know, according to detective Pince, that in 1984 Dunkin was charged with five counts of indecent liberties. There were no convictions because the youth and parents would not follow-up on these accusations. If you wish verification of these statements, you may talk with detective Pince at [redacted]. I have looked for a copy of the letter that we gave to Dunkin denying his involvement, but cannot find it. Dunkin did receive the letter and came to my office; however, we did not keep a copy. Please advise me on this oversight.

Attached is a newspaper article regarding Charles Grewe which I'm sure you will want to add to your file.

As always, whenever I have new information regarding any of our former dismissals from the Scouting program, we will keep you informed.

We would also like to have a copy of a paper with Mr. Dunkin's signature, as this aids in the identification process. Perhaps, his signature appears on a copy of an application or an advancement report.

You indicated that you had communicated with the police and they were investigating and I have had nothing to substantiate this. Are there no newspaper clippings, or court records, or other information which you can secure to tell us the outcome of this situation? This is most important, if we are to have a complete case which is strong enough to refuse registration anywhere in the country.

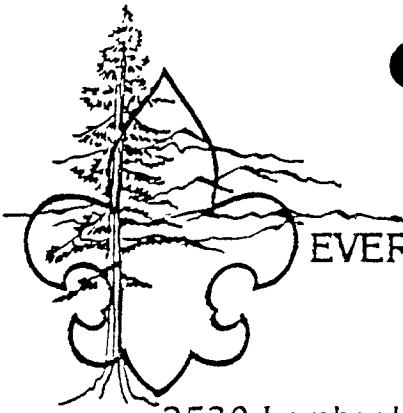

Acting on your suggestion, we mailed a registered letter to ^Durkin at his last known address, even though the police indicated he was no longer living in the area.


^Durkin was living at his old address, received the letter and came into the office demanding to know why he would receive such. My reply was he didn't meet the membership standards of the BSA. He wanted to know if he needed an attorney and I replied I was not accusing him of anything. He just no longer met our standards for membership. Thus, I saw no reason for him to have an attorney. He left perplexed, but knowing he was no longer in the program and not angry.

I then called Detectives Hughes and Pince informing them that he was still "in town", where he worked and a better physical description of him so they could pursue their investigation.

Attached is an updated Confidential Record Sheet with more specific information.

MARK L. E. DUNKIN

On November 19, 1987 I was contacted by Detective Hughes of Child Protection Service that Mark L. E. Dunkin had either raped, molested or had homosexual relationship with a [REDACTED] on June 8, 1986. [REDACTED] was brought into police custody on some other charges and in conversation revealed this information. [REDACTED] is not, nor has been, registered with the BSA.

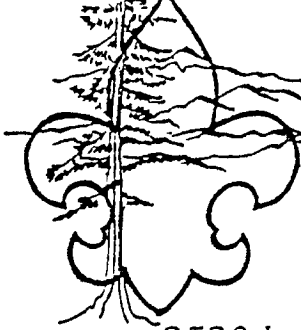
[REDACTED] had met Dunkin at a Roller Rink in Everett and supposedly been invited on a Scouting outing by Dunkin.

The investigation has been turned over to Detective Pince [REDACTED] with the Snohomish County Sheriff's Department. We have been working with them to locate Dunkin for the last few weeks.

At this point Dunkin can not be found by the authorities, nor have the Council President and I been able to deliver the letter denying Dunkin's membership in the Boy Scouts of America.

The troop Dunkin is registered with has not been active since February 1987. Father Jon Frenkovic, Executive Officer of St. Mary of the Valley Catholic Church in Monroe (our chartered partner), is aware of the allegation and will notify us if Dunkin shows up.
