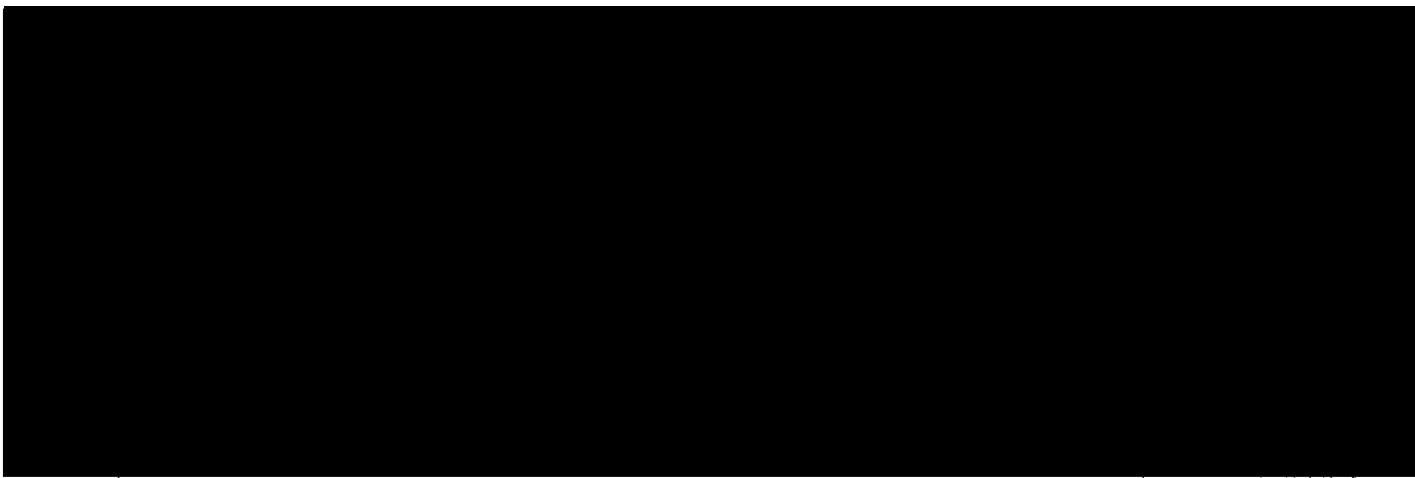

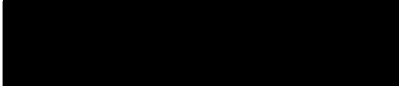

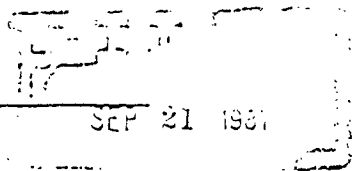

JUDGMENT

COURT'S NOTICE OF DISPOSITION

SEP 21 1987

The above defendant was, on the 1st day of July 1987, duly charged by complaint in the above county with the crime of Criminal Sexual Conduct in the Second Degree and that on the 6th

day of July, 1987, he was duly arraigned before the above Court on said charge.

On the 13th day of July, 1987, at Brainerd before the Hon. Clinton W. Wyant, a judge of the District Court, he duly pleaded guilty under said charge to the crime of Criminal Sexual Conduct in the Second Degree was found or pleaded Criminal Sexual Conduct in the Second Degree.

On the 21st day of September 1987, said defendant was Placed on probation to the Department of Community Corrections, Crow Wing-Morrison Counties, Adult probation Division, for an indeterminate term not to exceed 15 years, pursuant to the Court's Order Staying execution of 21 month sentence. Imposition of Execution

Sentenced to confinement in the county jail of the above county for a term of 1 year - credit with time served.

Now therefore, the Sheriff of the above county, State of Minn. is being commanded to take said defendant into custody and keep him in the above County Jail until the expiration of said term of sentence and until defendant shall from thence be discharged by due process.

In addition to the regular rules of probation or confinement in the County jail, the Court imposed the following special conditions:

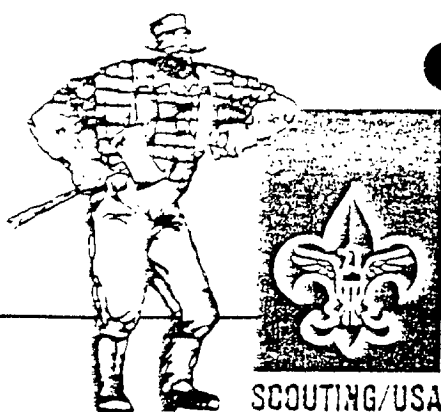
1. Apply for, participate in & complete sexual offenders treatment program at St. Peter. May enter treatment after serving 6 months in County Jail. To undergo evaluation at St. Peter as soon as arrangements can be made.
2. Refrain from use of intoxicants. Submit to chemical testing. Refrain from entering establishments dispensing intoxicants.
3. No contact with victims.

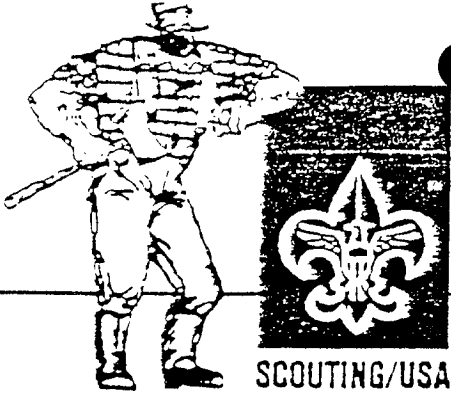

We reserve the right to suspend registrations whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be reinstated.

COMPLAINT

The Complainant, being duly sworn, makes complaint to the above-named Court and states that there is probable cause to believe that the Defendant committed the following offense(s). The complainant states that the following facts establish PROBABLE CAUSE:

Complainant is a police officer for the City of Brainerd. On June 29, 1987, complainant executed a search warrant at the residence at [redacted] in Brainerd. There, officers located a number of poloroid photos of a girl. Some of these photos depicted the girl nude, in sexually suggestive positions. Officers talked to NOBLE who stated that he had taken all of the photos and that the girl in the photos, here identified as [redacted] was 12 years old. NOBLE stated that [redacted] was at his residence on June 23, 1987, the date the photos were taken. NOBLE stated that he gave her a body rub with body lotion on her nude body and in the process touched her breasts and buttocks. NOBLE stated that he became sexually aroused during the massage. NOBLES' date of birth is September 20, 1943.

The above facts constitute his basis for believing that the above-named defendant, on the 23rd day of June, 1987, at City of Brainerd

in the above-named County committed the following described offense(s): Charge: Criminal Sexual Conduct in the Second Degree in violation of

Section: 609.343, Subd. 1(a) Maximum Sentence: 15 years/\$30,000

OFFENSE DESCRIPTION: At the time and place alleged above MARTIN FREDERICK NOBLE did unlawfully, wrongfully and feloniously engage in sexual contact with another person, to wit: [redacted] this [redacted] being less than 13 years of age and this MARTIN FREDERICK NOBLE being more than 36 months older than [redacted] having been born on September 20, 1943.

THEREFORE, Complainant requests that said Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release be:

- (1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain defendant's appearance in court; or (2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings;
