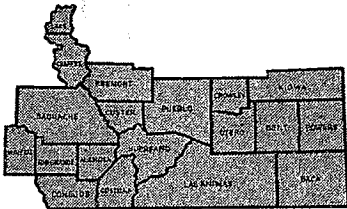

Here are two men I recommend placing on the Confidential list:

Marvin Leroy Rhoads, 3333 Elizabeth, Pueblo, Colorado, currently registered as Committeeman with Pack 22 sponsored by Somerlid School P.T.A., Pueblo, Colorado. Enclosed is a news clipping dated October 31, 1968 indicating that Marvin Leroy Rhoads was given five years probation on sentences involving immoral liberties with a 7-year old boy.

The second man is Elmer A. Ross, age 60, residing at 1525 East 4th, Pueblo, Colorado and registered as an Assistant Scoutmaster in Troop 81, Mesa District, Pueblo, Colorado. Elmer A. Ross, according to information submitted to me by one of my staff associates and checked out with the Police Department of Pueblo, served time in Canon City prison after being sentenced in 1964 for taking immoral and illegal liberties with a young girl.

**Marvin Rhoads
Given Probation**

Probation for five years was granted to Marvin Leroy Rhoads, 33 of 3333 Elizabeth by District Judge Matt J. Kikel at a hearing Wednesday morning.

Judge Kikel emphasized that the probation on two 4-to-6 year concurrent sentences involving immoral liberties with a 7-year old boy, was granted in large part because of the approval of the victim's mother. Judge Kikel also cited the defendant's good employment record and lack of record with police, sheriff or FBI officials. Terms for the probation include submitting to treatment at Colorado State Hospital.
