Dear Mr. Verneuy:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 4 concerning your registration in the Boy Scouts of America.

You indicate that your name has been misspelled by us. I note your letter clearly indicates your name as <u>Verneuy</u>, but I also have in my hands a handwritten application for adult registration in the Boy Scouts of America, in your own handwriting which very clearly indicates the spelling of your name to be <u>Verney</u>, both in its printed place and in its signature location on the application. Could it be that when you applied for registration in Pack 254 you mistakenly spelled your name <u>Vernelly</u> and then when applying in Pack 296 you spelled it <u>Verney</u> and now you indicate it should be Verneuy. If we have made an error responsibility for an error on this point.

Mr. Don Johnson was correct in the information he provided you concerning your recent application for registration. As you know, because of your past association in Scouting dating back to the time when you served as Assistant Cubmaster of Pack 111 at the Naha Air Force Base in Okinawa while you were with the Air Force prior to your leaving Okinawa in June 1964, the Boy Scouts of America is primarily concerned in inculcating its objectives of character development and citizenship training in the lives of youth.

In keeping with these objectives, the Scouting organization has always reserved the prerogative of accepting applications from those individuals it feels are best qualified to give the kind of leadership that this organization wishes for boys enrolled in the Scouting program.

Occasionally, the Boy Scouts of America decides that, in its best judgment, it is unwilling to accept an application to commission an individual for a leadership role. Whenever it makes this decision, it gives no reasons for this action and this is never intended as a criticism or accusation of any type.

On behalf of the Boy Scouts of America, I regret to advise you that at the present time we are unwilling to accept your registration as a leader of boys in the Scouting program.
