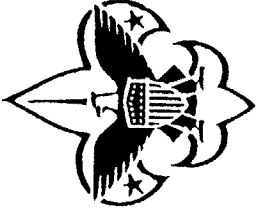

After a careful review of the information, the committee found no basis to overturn the decision of membership denial.

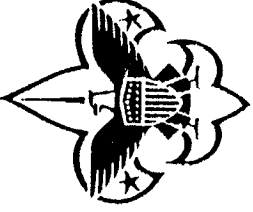

REGIONAL REVIEW HEARING FOR MICHAEL ECK

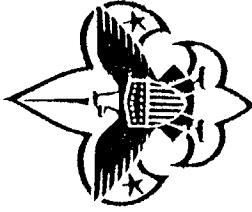
The Regional Review meeting was held September 27, 1991, at the Omni Hotel, Richmond, Virginia. Present: Hugh Riley, Chairman; Pete Janson, C. S. Clardy, Jr., James D. Wilson, and Paul Moore.

The committee reviewed all documents related to this membership denial. The accusations were not denied; in Eck's first letter to the region, he admits wrongdoing but promises not to do so again. Some concern was expressed as to whether, under the process outlined in Step 7 on page 13 of "Procedures for Maintaining Standards of Membership" more information on the nature of the charges should be given to the accused.

The committee concluded that they had seen no information which would cause them to recommend rescinding the action of the local council.

Area Director Paul Moore will coordinate the date and time for this meeting. Please contact him at [REDACTED] to let him know if you will be available to serve on this committee.

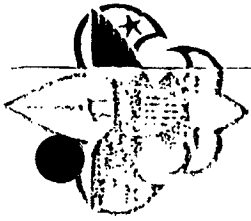

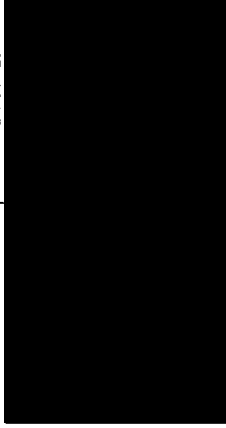

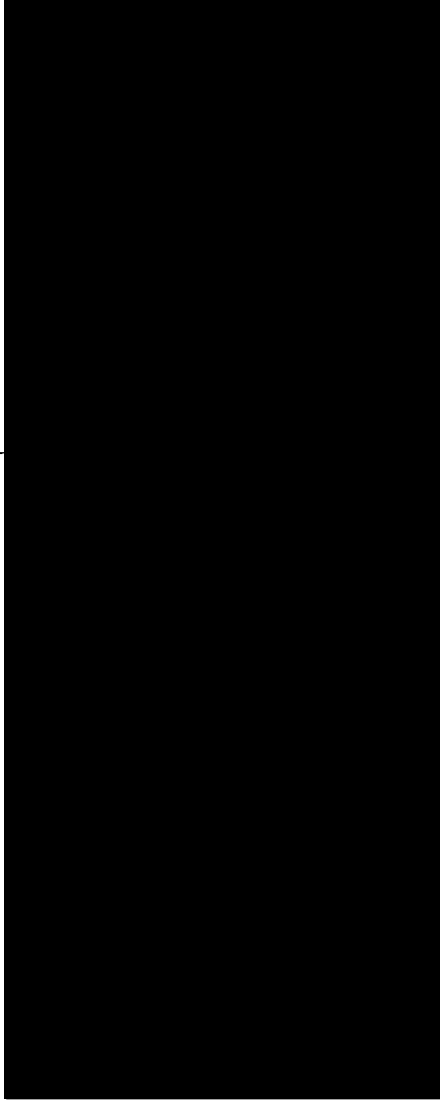

In addition to taking these classes, I began a new job which, too, is in the medical profession. I started this job in February as well. My position involves both simple and invasive procedures.

Wanting to be an excellent EMT-Cardiac Technician as well as a Physician's Assistant, I wanted to become extremely proficient with my patient assessment skills. I felt this was a way to find out what is wrong with my patient, and this - you must be able to detect any and all problems your patient has to provide correct care.

I had asked some fellow Scouts I have known for some time - several years - at least - to be a practice patient/mock victim so that I may practice my patient assessment skills. This was absolutely voluntary on their part and I told them, up front, what was going to be done. If they did not feel comfortable with something, then they could tell me and it would not be done! No harm was ever intended for them.

I have since completed my certification course and I have no longer required the services of these volunteer "patients", or asked them for any other favors concerning the ^{medical} profession. Also, I have accepted a new job which no longer requires invasive procedures as numerous as the previous. These events were very short-lived and will never be necessary nor will happen again. I hope that this information has been adequate for your needs to reach a decision and I hope to hear from you soon. To me, this has all been a very grave misunderstanding!

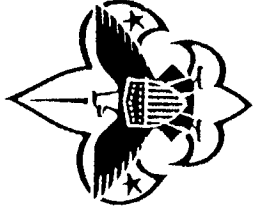

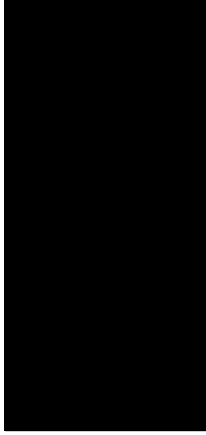

Dear Mr. Hoyt Hunt,

I am writing to you to convey my request that my application for registration to the Boy Scouts of America be reviewed for reconsideration. I hope you don't mind me writing this request personally, but I feel it is my way of being on a personal, one to one basis, rather than a formal, typed letter.

Virtually my entire life, 22 years, has involved the Scouting program. My father and my two older brothers have been in the program and I grew up learning and living the principles and morals of the Scouting movement when I would go with them to meetings and outings. Without Scouting, my life is incomplete!

I have met many, GREAT friends and have had the opportunity to participate a great deal in the Scouts, both locally, regionally, and nationally. I earned the rank of Eagle Scout in 1984, I was honored by my fellow Arrowmen of Newkwa Lodge #3 and was given the Vigil Honor in 1987. I have helped others learn and grow by showing them that there is no limit to the things you can do in Scouting. I have held many Troop positions as a youth. I have been on the 1985 and 1989 National Sambaer Staff as well as the 1990 NOAC Staff. In addition, I have had the opportunity to travel to Philmont as well as the 1988 NOAC. 1988 was the year I was elected as SE-8 Vice-Chief for the Order of the Arrow. Lastly, I have served

on the District level as a Member at Large, Camporee Chairman two times, a member of Summer Camp Staff two years, as well as several committees within our Order of the Arrow Lodge as either Youth Chairman or adult adviser. I have remained active in Scouting since 1978.

I certainly haven't forgotten about my home Troop, because if it wasn't for them, I would not have had the chance to do all of these things and have loved every single moment of it!

I have seriously contemplated about the possible incident (or incidents) that may have stemmed this matter of my membership to the Boy Scouts of America, denied. I know now that I made a very grave error in both judgement and morality. Nothing will ever occur, as long as I live, that has ~~been~~ been, or will be, thought of as poor judgement and moral thoughts ~~violated~~ violated! Scouts' Honor! You now have this in writing - a promise that has come from the spirit, heart and mind - and will NEVER be broken!

I have since reminded myself that the foundation of the Scouting movement is to provide our youth members with positive, solid male role models and to teach them that the Scout Oath and Law, as well as the Scout Motto and Slogan, are ways to have a happy and successful life. This is our method of turning boys into men who are the hopes and dreams of a better tomorrow!

I ask of you to please grant me the opportunity to register with the Boy Scouts of America, as an adult leader, and you will see that nothing, like what has happened in the past, will happen ~~again~~ again!! I would like to continue to serve the Scouting program

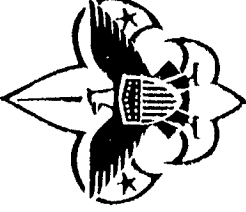
