Nutley cultist facing new sex charges_

Further charges will be filed against a 22-yearold man arrested last week in connection with a devil-worshiping ser cult involving at least 35 teenagers. Nutley police said yesterday. "At this point, this is far from over, "Acting-

At this point, this is far from note, where Police Chief Robert Delitta said. John Sileo of 168 Bloomfield Ave. was arrested after police raided his home and confiscated various drug paraphernalia and sexually oriented material, Delatta said. Also taken from Sileo's residence were three rifles and two handguns, which police said. Sileo legally possessed. Sileo was charged with three sex offenses and is

Sileo was chargen with three set utilities in lien being held in the Esser County Jail, Newark, in lien of \$75,000 bond.

An investigation into Sileo's activities was started three weeks ago when some of the parents of the teenaged victims complained to police. Delitta saidsileo lured his victims, who ranged from 15 to 17, with drags and alcohol, said Det. Sgt. John Holland, is charge of the investigation "I realized we were becoming a cuil," Holland unoted one of the female victims as telling him. He said Sileo apparently used a form of devil worship as an initiation ritual. Found in Sileo's home was a crimson-colored robe and a pair of hores, Holland

said. Sileo had been involved with the Boy Scouts in Nutley and been associated with other civic organizatoos, Holland said.

The enclosed news article refers to Mr. John Sileo, 163 Bloomfield Ave., Nutley, NJ 07110. Birthday May 1961, formerly registered as a Den Assistant in Pack 145, sponsored by Padeliff School PTA. Nutley, from October 1980 to October 1931.

Mr. Sileo has been denied registration locally due to a Neurological Impairment which causes difficulty in relating and functioning as an Adult Leader. We did not and could not find any indication of moral problems as indicated in this article. Pack 145 registered him as an Assistant: however, soon after registered him as an Assistant: however, soon after registration, did not allow him to continue in their activities. His problems were reviewed with the datley Family dervices Arency over the past 31 years and we have avoided registering him except for this aforementioned period since he was a Scout in Troop 159, a Troop for the mentally hundicapped, when he was under 13 years of age.

Michael Abidiwan is an Earle Scout as of July 29, 1932, and is currently registered as an Assistant Scoutnuster in Proop 147, sponsored by Franklin Reformed Church, Nutley, N.J. until February 1984.

I have informed their Troop Leaders and Church Pastor that we are suspending his membership and requesting his membership card and Eagle credentials and bades be returned.

The Detective in charge of this case will furnish additional information including both men's description in the first week of December and I will forward the full report to you at that time.

The original cases started in 1983 and there was communication with the council during '83 and '84.

If you can help us with this, we would most appreciate it so we can close our files.
