

We learned of this matter through the newspaper article and never actually spoke with the victim's parents, [REDACTED], as they would not return phone calls. Church leadership was reluctant to release the victim's name. Since Mr. Fischer pleaded guilty, I did not pursue the matter further.

Molestation trial set for October

Spanaway church leader accused of attacks on family friend

A Spanaway church youth leader is to go on trial in October on charges that he repeatedly molested a 14-year-old family friend, some 15 times while driving the boy to church events.

Michael James Fischer, 31, a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, was jailed July 16 and charged with three counts of molestation after conferring with a sheriff's detective.

He pleaded not guilty in Pierce County Superior Court and was freed July 17 on \$2,000 bail. Fischer, a former manager at the Burger King Restaurant at McChord Air Force Base, resigned from the restaurant July 19.

A trial date has been set for October 10. The encounters began last fall, when the boy was 13, and continued until the boy told his parents about them two weeks ago, according

to the charging papers. The parents then contacted police. Fischer was a "young men's president" for the Spanaway ward of the church, the principal authority coordinating social and religious programs and activities for the ward's 15 of so junior high- and high school-aged boys. Federal authorities have indicated they plan to prosecute Fischer for acts committed at McChord, according to prosecutors' documents.

though that could not be confirmed Thursday. The Office of Special Investigations is monitoring and assisting the investigation being conducted by the Pierce County sheriff, said McChord spokesman Capt. John Litten.

Fischer, who is married with three children, said in an interview Thursday that he had been relieved of his church leadership duties and been ordered by the court to have no contact with the boy or his family.

Charles Hansen, a church leader for the area that includes the Spanaway church, said, "We're very concerned about it. We support the laws of the land and we believe in cooperating with those laws. We have faith in the courts. All things come to light, we'll weigh the evidence and decide if action is warranted." Capt. Litten said Fischer was employed by the Army-Air Force Exchange Service, a civilian contracting company that ran McChord's Burger King.
