Dear Paul,

I received your letter dated June 2, 1988 concerning Michael L. Larsen who has been recently placed in the confidential file. In reply to your questions regarding the sexual abuse charges, it is my understanding that the boy was about 8 years of age and Mr. Larsen's father told me that his [REDACTED] noticed that the boy's pants were unzipped and invited him back behind a coat rack to help him zip up his pants. Where Michael Larsen had only the somewhat limited use of one hand, according to his father, he had a difficult time zipping up the boys pants and was quite shaky, causing the boy to become aroused, leading to the sexual abuse charges.

I have had several visits with Michael Larsen's father, [REDACTED] who currently serves as a district chairman in the Great Salt Lake Council. He is most disturbed that I have accepted the police records and have taken their word in making our decision. It is my feeling that I have no alternative but to accept the police records, and where Michael Larsen admitted to the sexual abuse charges, we have no choice.

Thank you for your assistance in this matter.

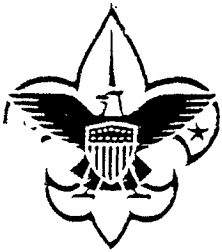

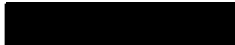

Dear Paul,

I am enclosing a confidential record sheet on Michael L. Larsen. This is the individual that I visited with you by phone about on February 25th. More than a month ago, we delivered a letter to Mr. Larsen removing him from all Scouting involvement.

This young man was injured in a hunting accident as a young boy, at which time he was left disabled, losing the use of his legs and arms and causing a speech impairment. Through much therapy and hard work he is able to walk and function fairly normally. He however, has the use of only one arm and is slow in walking. He and his father claim that because of his disability with the use of only one hand, he had a most difficult time in trying to help a young boy to zip up his pants, resulting in the charges of child abuse. When he was arrested and taken to the sheriff department, he went without the assistance of his family or counsel and confessed to things that his family said he was never involved in. This could be possible being the individual suffers from some retardation as a result of his hunting accident. The district is asking if they might use this individual now in putting together their monthly newsletter. I have told them that until I have your approval on such activity, he is to remain totally uninvolved from the Scouting program. I think I would feel better not letting him be involved, at least during his two year probation period.

Dear Hart:

We received a telephone call from your office on February 25, 1988, concerning the above named individual. At that time you indicated that there has been some sexual abuse activity which was not involved in the scouting activity, but the charges were filed.

We feel that Mr. Larsen should not be registered at this time with the Boy Scouts of America. I am enclosing a Confidential Record sheet which I would like to have completed so that we may identify him should he attempt registration in another location. We would also like a copy of paper with his signature if this is available.

Please send us a statement relating to the charges which were made and any newspaper clippings or court records, if these are available. We must have adequate information if we are to support the refusal of registration at a later time when neither you or I might be on our present job.
