In December, you sent me a copy of a letter which had come from the Scout Association in London as well as the copy of the letter which you sent to the Scout Executive in Pennington, New Jersey.

I had recent communication with Mr. Flipski concerning this, since I also had written to him on April 2, 1991.

He indicates that he has talked to all of his professional staff, as well as many volunteers in the council and no one knows Michael Lee. They do not know what association he has had and with whom in the council. We also do not know if this was recent or several years ago.

I wondered if you could write to the Scout Association and ask them if they can give us a little more information concerning Mr. Lee. We really would like some personal characteristics so we can identify him.

It would be most helpful to have his age or birth date, his weight and height, the color of his hair and eyes, and any other personal characteristics which would help us in identifying him should he come to this country again and associate with some other local council.

Michael Lee is such a common name that a middle initial would help, and those other characteristics which I indicated would certainly make it much easier to identify him.

I am writing to let you know that the above-named individual is no longer a member of the Scout Association. He has recently been found guilty of serious offences with children, which make it inappropriate for him to continue to be involved with our organisation.

Mr Lee has a close association with the George Washington Council of the BSA, having visited several times and established friendships with volunteer Scouters and professional staff. We believe that he may attempt to continue these relationships, which we would consider to be undesirable.

No doubt you will inform your colleagues in the George Washington Council of this news and I expect they will take any necessary action.
