Former sanitarian, advisor arrested for child molesting

A former Rushville resident who at one time served as the Rush County Sanitarian, and was a former Big Brother and adult advisor to the Boy Scouts, is free on \$5,000 bond after being arrested last Friday on childmolesting charges by RPD Det. Robert Bridges.

Rushville Police Chief Ron Cameron reported Monday that Michael R. Alter, 34, formerly of Rushville but listed by court records as residing at 3113 S. Tibbs Ave., Indianapolis, was arrested at the Indiana State Board of Health office in Indianapolis, Alter's place of employment. He allegedly molested an 11-year-old Rushville girl, and has been charged with a class C felony.

According to court records, the arrest came after the girl told her mother of the incident, occurring on November 16. The mother then notified Rush County Welfare Department caseworkers. Bridges

began his investigation after being notified by the Welfare Department workers.

Court records show that, in a video-taped interview on the day following the incident, the giri alleged that Alter, who was previously acquainted with the family, came to her home on Nov. 16 and said that a foreign exchange student had left a pair of boots at his house that might fit her.

According to the girl, Alter obtained permission from her mother to take her to see if the boots would fit. Alter allegedly took her to his former residence in Rushville. There, after failing to gain access to the house, he pulled his vehicle into the garage and molested her, the girl charged. She also reported that Alter used paper tissues to clean up afterwards, which he discarded in the garage.

The girl reported that Alter gave her a \$10 bill and a pair of boots, then drove her back to her home. Later she told her mother of the incident and showed her the \$10 bill.

Bridges said in court records he then went to the residence no by the girl and recovered se pieces of stained tissue paper the garage, which he sent to the diana State Police laborator analysis.


