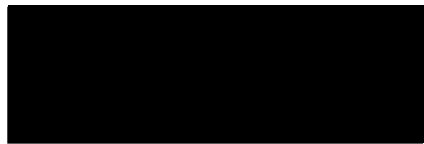

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is inclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a council review committee, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated.

Please find enclosed the confidential record sheet on Michael R. Debose. In addition a copy of his adult application with his signature is attached.

The council attorney and I, along with the parents of the two Cub Scouts, met and statements were tape recorded. At the beginning of each interview with the tape recorder on, our council attorney had the parents swear that their testimony was the truth, etc.

The mother and father of one of the Cubs was interviewed by our attorney within a week of the incident. The mother of the second Cub was interviewed several weeks later.

The statements recorded from the parents parallel the statements made by Marcal W. Young (a professional staff member and Camp Director at the time of the problem) in his letter to you on June 30, 1987.

These tape recorded statements are on file should they be needed in the future.

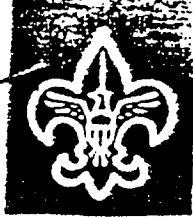

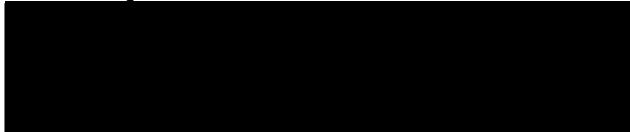

Dear Paul:

After lunch at Camp T. L. James, I was called aside by a father, [Redacted], who was attending Cub Camp with his son. [Redacted] brought his son and another boy from the same pack over to tell me of a problem. They told me that Michael R. Debose, a registered volunteer Scouter in our Council (Troop 59, Pack and Troop 113, Ruston, LA), who was serving as a campsite leader at Cub Camp and the Camp Commissioner on our Summer Camp staff, had told them the night before to take a shower and check for chiggers and ticks. They said they told him they had already taken a shower. They said Mr. Debose then made them come in to his tent, take off their clothes, and applied a medicine to their "private parts." Then they told me that Mr. Debose took off his pants and made the two boys apply medicine to his "private parts." According to the boys, this took place following a rain the previous night in his (Mr. Debose) tent with the flaps down.

I then alerted our Scout Executive, George Lambert, of the incident. He told me to talk to Mike Debose alone.

Immediately after lunch I spoke to Mike Debose. I told him that I was going to tell him exactly what the boys said and I wanted him to level with me. After I told him he said that he never made the boys do it, it just happened. He said he was administering chigger rid to some chigger bites on them and that it had happened. He began to get pretty choked up about it. He said he knew he had over stepped his boundry. He asked me about the status of his application to become a professional Scouter, and how it would affect him. I told him he would need to talk to George Lambert. I asked him to leave the camp and that he would not be on Boy Scout Summer Camp Staff any longer. He told me he would never do it again. I explained to him that I could not take the chance of it happening again. I told him I had told the staff that any medical problem should be brought to the Medic, and he disobeyed that.

The story from both parties was the same with the exception that Mr. Debose said he did not force them and the boys said he did.

I then explained the details to [REDACTED] and told him the action I had taken. He told me later that the only thing he wanted was Mr. Debose barred from Scouting--permanently.

Later in the day, our Aquatics Director told me a couple of staff members had told him that Mr. Debose was encouraging them to masturbate. If you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to call me at [REDACTED]

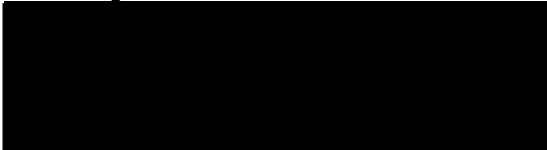

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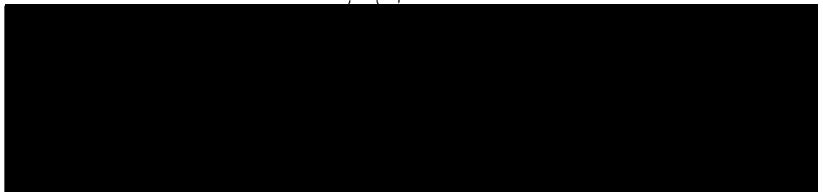


