Effective this date, your appointments as Junior Assitant Scoutmaster and member of the Troop Leadership Corps are terminated and you are suspended indefinitely from participation in all Troop activities and programs.

Specifically, the reasons for the above action are:

1. Lascivious and indecent acts committed by you on Scout A, at Philmont on or about July 21, 1984;
2. Physical assault by you upon Scout A, a smaller and younger Scout, at Philmont on or about July 25, 1984;
3. Fondling by you of Scout B at Zaleski State Forest on or about May 26, 1984;
4. Slanderous accusations by you of indecent conduct on the part of Scout C with other members of the Troop, in an attempt to discredit Scout C, knowing the same to be false and malicious, in July, 1983.

These acts constitute major breaches of the ideals expressed in the Scout Oath and Law and give rise to both criminal and civil liability on your part under the laws of Ohio and New Mexico.

I propose to present the above facts to the Troop Committee for evaluation. If they concur I will ask the Committee to certify the matter to the Central Ohio Council for such action as the Council deems appropriate and will recommend the withdrawal of your Eagle Scout rank and permanent expulsion from the Boy Scouts of America. In lieu of these proceedings, you may submit your unconditional resignation on the letter form attached.

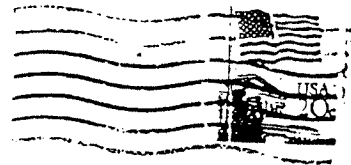

The enclosed items are self explanatory. They refer to an unfortunate affair which occurred in 1954, prior to your coming with us.

The reason I bring them to your attention is that Bob Fairer related to me Monday that Mike Highman called him, asking to be reinstated.

I believe doing so would be a serious mistake. The man possesses moral and character traits which preclude him serving as an adult scoutmaster (he is now 19½). Moreover, the Council would have no defense to the claim of any boy or parent injured by him and, as the incidents referred to in the letter are widely known among scouts and scoutmasters in the Council, approving him as a leader would certainly discredit and embarrass the Movement.

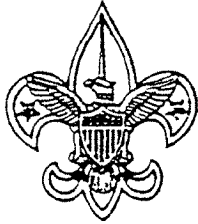

Dear Mr. Earnst,

I am writing you in regard to a letter sent to you from Mr. Bob Faris of the Central Ohio Council B.S.A.. The letter was sent approximately 3 months ago. Although I do not know the specifics of that letter, I do know that it was written concerning the re-admittance of myself, Michael S. Highman, to the scouting program.

In August of 1984, I signed a contract expelling myself from Scouting and related organizations of the B.S.A. in lieu of certain discipline measures. A copy of that letter was supposedly sent to National Headquarters under classified documents.

It has been nearly 2 years since that series of events occurred. I have attended Otterbein College for those last 2 years and currently am an Elementary Education major with a concentration in Psychology. I have a 3.52 grade point average, have been accepted into the Honors Program, and will become a Student Orientation Assistant, as well as a member of our Host and Tour Staff for prospective students. I also am currently Vice President of Lambda Gamma Epsilon Fraternity at Otterbein. I understand that this information may not mean a whole lot on the surface, but I hope it can prove that I am trying to better myself and become a better person.

I attained Eagle Scout while in the Scouting program and now, looking back on the entire situation, I am ashamed of what I did and feel that I was given a second chance at life in general. As far as my scouting experience itself, I don't think anyone will argue that I was far above average in leadership ability as well as a skill in craftsmanship. I believe that Bob Faris can attest to that.

Please don't misinterpret this request as my way to get back into the program easily. I realize how wrong the act was that I allegedly committed was. I am willing to enter the program under any conditions that the National Council would deem necessary. I wouldn't expect it to be any other way.

My aspirations for the future include many things. Educationally speaking. I expect to complete my degree in Elementary Education and plan to teach 7th or 8th grade math. I then plan to enter graduate school to pursue a Masters degree in Administrative Education. After that, I expect to go back to graduate school and earn a Doctorate in Child Psychology. Career-wise, I plan to begin teaching once out of school, then I plan to move on to an


