After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be denied. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership-which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedure for a review of this decision are attached.

August 5:

At approximately 9:00pm Scout Executive Rees A. Falkner received a call from Bishop Mark Gubler of Dixie Downs Ward, Santa Clara Stake of St. George Utah. Bishop Gubler indicated that he had a 28year old man in his Ward who had been molested as a Scout by one of our professional Scouters.

He reported that single, had reported to him in a personal interview that he had been repeatedly molested by Mike Stillman who was his Scoutmaster and a professional Scouter during 1974-1976.

Bishop Gubler stated that had been inactive in the LDS Church for the last 10-12 years and was now striving to put his life in order. The incidents of involvement with Michael Stillman had caused great mental anguish for him, and he was trying to clear his conscience of his had reported to Bishop Gubler that Mike had repeatedly molested him while he and were alone in Mike's home. When asked the: nature of the molestation, Bishop Gubler reported that it involved fondling of the crotch area through the clothing. had indicated to him that it had not gone further than that.

Rees Falkner then assurred Bishop Gubler that he would follow up on this swiftly and take the appropriate action. He arranged to have a phone conversation with and Gubler the next day. Mr. Falkner indicated he would contact Bishop Gubler after reporting this incident, which he did.

November 6:

Rees Falkner called Dick Harrington of Region about 9:30am and was advised to, if possible, make a personal contact with

9:15am: Rees Falkner contacted Boyd Ivie, Area Personnel Director, to report the incident.

November 7:

5:00pm: Rees Falkner called Council attorney, John Valentine to report on the incident. Mr.Valentine indicated that, from a legal standpoint, we are following proper procedures and stated he felt we should ask Mike to resign and that, if he did not resign, a letter of suspension with subsequent followup would be appropriate.

November 8:

1:30pm: Mike Stillman met with Rees Falkner, Scout Executive, and Darryl Alder, Director of Field Service. Rees explained to Mike why he had been called to this meeting today. Rees pointed out that, as a followup to Mike's probationary status, the Council had just received some very disturbing allegations. Rees reviewed with Mike the allegations made by

Mike admitted knowing of having served as his Scoutmaster during the 1973-76 period but denied he had ever molested the boy. Rees asked Mike if he felt that this young man would have any reason to make false charges against him, and he said no. Mike indicated that he was not sure why these allegations were made against him.

Rees also discussed with Mike the allegations made against him for misappropriation of funds as charged by his District Chairman, Quinn Christensen. Mike denied any wrongdoing with his handling of the District checking account and activity funds.

Rees then pointed out his concern for these serious allegations and the compromising situation he has left himself in both with his professional colleagues and his volunteers. Rees then outlined Mike's options as to immediate suspension and his option to resign of his own free will.

After further discussion, Mike decided that he would resign as long as it did not imply guilt on his part. Mike filled out a letter of resignation, signed it and turned it over to Rees for his acceptance. He then turned in his keys, his District materials and his registration card. He indicated he would let his bishop know of his resignation and of his need to separate from any involvement as a volunteer.
