Please note the attached newspaper article appearing in the Tucson Citizen Newspaper, December 19, 1980, regarding Miles Vaughn. It is the recommendation by the Catalina Council that Miles Vaughn, has served as a Scoutmaster of Troop 700 for many years up until March, 1980, at which time he did not reregister in the capacity of Scoutmaster or any volunteer Scouting capacity. The article is self-explanatory, and has been verified by the Council President, Walter E. Lovejoy, III, Executive Board Member, Harold F. Warren, Assistant Scout Executive, Robert C. MacConnell and the Scout Executive, that Mr. Vaughn did in fact admit directly to us and the Church Pastor, Troop Committee Chairman, and now current Scoutmaster, Larry Campbell, that he did in fact have a homosexual relationship with a minor at a prior period.

It is recommended that should Mr. Vaughn attempt to reregister in any volunteer capacity in the future, that his application be closely screened before acceptance.

# Ex-scoutmaster to be jailed for molesting young Scouts

For 15 or 20 years, forier Tucson Scoutmaster files Vaughn hid what he alled his "had side" from cours in his troop, and en from himself.

in his public life, ughe, 148, was a proud, pully, and well-respected ided whose troop turned t more than two dozen: igle Scouts.

But in secrecy, he was a in who sexually molested young Scouts, ages 10 to who looked to him for guidance and leadership.

The molestings went on, Vaughn has recently admitted, in his home, at his ranch and on Scout camping trips from the 1960s. unill late 1979.

The boys kept the secret, because Vaughn was an audidn't know what else to;

And Vnighn himself, a former gunshop owner, now says, "I was ashamed of it; I wanted to keep it in the dark.

Finally, though, a year ago tomorrow, one young

man was so tormented by the shameful things that had happened to him years carller that he went to authorities with the story.

With the secret at last uncovered, there suddenly was "an outpouring of people" coming forward, said Deputy County Attorney Cludy Martinez, and the names of 25 possible victims were given to sheriff's. investigators.

Many of the 10 victims who could be contacted by . authorities were in their 20s, and they told a grand

Vaughn's delense attorney thiged the Judge to give Yaugin probation, because Vaughn has responded well lo founseling and has adinified his acts, but prosecutor Ms. Martinez said she believed the victims and the community should not be forgotten and Vaughn should be punished as well as tirated for his prob-

Carrith, while noting that Vaughn has the support of most of the people who bould be expected to be angry with him, said Vaugan should spend time in Jall, because so many people were hurt by his acts for such a long time.

"I do doi believe you when you say it is a few brief incidents," the judge said. I'In addition to turning out Engle Scouts, I believe you have turned out several homosexuals and some very disturbed peo-ple."

Carruth told Vaughn that Vaughn's personal problems were no excuse for his behavior, and he admod-Ished him never to violate his probation or he will land In pilson, "And If you think your life was miscrable be-

Vaughn was brdered to continue receiving psychiatric counseling and to never work with Boy Scouts again without "the express corporate permission of the Boy Scouts of America "

"If you're at all sincere," Carruth added, "then morally, you ought to pay for any counseling or medical treatment the victims require." Vaughn has agreed to do so.

At least one of the viclims has suffered severe emoțional trauma, and his father's letter was the only one of numerous letters the Judge received that urged a prison sentence for Vaughn. "He should do at least, live years at Florence," that father said today.

Other parents, however, left the courtroom with] Vaughn. Some had tears in their eyes. "He must have been one of the greatest scoulmasters there ever was," said Vaughn's de lense attorney, Armand Salese, for the parents to be so willing to forgive him for what he has done " . '.
