CONFIDENTIAL REPORT - PATRICK GAGNON

At 10:10 A.M. on Thursday, September 22, 1983, I delivered Council President Bill Melville's refusal of registration letter to Patrick Gagnon. This took place at Patrick's place of employment, (a private "special needs" children's busing service) on Warren Street, Roxbury, after I had been unable to contact Gagnon by phone (he had none) or at his residence (he recently has noved from Beacon Street - no forwarding address available.) I was accompanied by Michael Silva, Challenge District Executive, who introduced me to Patrick Gagnon and then remained silent throughout our five minute conversation.

remained silent throughout our five minute conversation. Upon being introduced, I presented President Melville's letter to Patrick, which he read rapidly. He looked puzzled and quickly asked "What's this all about?"

I informed him that registration with the Boy Scouts of America was a privilege, not a right, and that his application for registration was being denied, based on his alleged involvement in two separate incidents, one in Forrfield, Conn. several years ago, the other more recently in South Boston.

Patrick denied any wrongdoing in Fairfield, Conn. He claimed that although he was in the Marines and moved around the Country several times, that he had never lived in Fairfield, Conn. Being unfamiliar with specific details of that occasion, I directed his attention to the South Boston incident, Stating that we had received a complaint from the mother of a former Scout from Troop 210.

Gagnon, without using any names, immediately stated that he knew who the woman was and went into a controlled but angry tirade against her for about 3 minutes. He claimed that she is an evil woman who abused and misuses her children. He claimed (1) that she often goes out and locks her children up in the home; (2) that she was trying to get her hands on a trust fund that he had set up for the boy. He mentioned also that this money was set aside because he was the troop's Scout of the Year. He was very unclear as to whether he or the troop had set up this "trust fund" and for what purposes; (3) that he often sent small sums of money (\$5.00-\$10.00) to the Scout but that his mother had kept it; (4) that the Scout's brother and sister were often Cruel, like the time they hid his Pack when he was going camping.

At this time, Gagnon's supervisor came by and told Gagnon that he had a job for Pat "as soon as you're through with these gentlemen". I then told Gagnon that he should cease all involvement in Scouting, both on the District and Troop levels. He claimed that he was no konger active with the troop (two years). I stated that although he wasn't registered with the troop, I knew that he had attended the Spring (1983) Charlenge District Camporee with Troop 210. He said that this was true, but he hasn't been active since.

Gagnon claimed that he had done nothing wrong, had been active in Scouting for over 25 years, and Wished to remain so.

I suggested that if he felt wrongly accused, that he take the steps outlined in the letter and request a hearing with the Council President. He said that he would probably do that.

Michael and I then thanked him for his time and left.

Throughout the entire episode, Gagnon kept calm and looked genuinely surprised. He did ramble on, make accusations, and not make a lot of sense when talking about the alleged incident in South Boston.

₹₂₂₂2 In response to your confidential inquiry of Patrick Gagnon, 146 Beacon St., Boston, Massachusetts:

- Patrick Gagnon was registered as Scoutmaster of Troop 210, South Boston 1. from Jan. 1974 thru Dec. 1981. When he priginally registered as a mul-tiple here, he claimed current registration status in New York. He also registered as multiple in Pack 210 from time to time. (See Veteran app.)
- Patrick is single, approximately 47 years old He listed his age in 1974 2. as 37, and on one occasion, listed June 1937 as his birth date. He has sparse (on top) sandy-blond hair, blue or grey eves, is about 5'6" tall and weighs approximately 165-175 Tbs. His name would indicate that he may be of Irish decent.
- Questions asked of three individuals that know Patrick, including the Pastor of the church where he served as SM, failed to reveal whether he 3. had been in the Marine Corps, or had lived or served in Fairfield, Conn. However, the enclosed application for 20-yr. Veteran Award indicates that Patrick was registered in Scouting positions throughout the country in the 1960's and early 1970's, a pattern not uncommon for an individual in the military. -SUSUARDER
- On the Veterants application, Patrick claims to have been Scoutmaster of Troop 161, Becford, Ma. from Jan 1969 thru Sept. 1971. He makes no reference to serving in Fairfield Connecticut. (approximately 200 miles from Bedford) during 1969. However, I checked with the Registrar of Minuteman Council, Stoneham, Ma. She found no record of a Patrick Gagnon registered anywhere with Troop Tol in Bedford during 1969-71. The Scoutmaster for the three years was a Theodore Sandy. I also checked his registration in the Algonquin Council, Framingham, Ma. and found that he was registered from May 1972 thru November 1973, which contradicts the Veteran application.
- Patrick Gagnon uses the name Brother Patrick, claiming that he was once in 5. the religious brotherhood, but left. This would lead one to believe that he may be catholic.
