██████, THE INF, DEP MARPLE AND MYSELF PROCEEDED TO INTERVIEW ROOM 26 WHERE IT WAS DETERMINED THAT ██████ HAD INFACT BEEN A VICTIM.

██████ STATED THAT HE WAS TO GO ON A CAMPOUT TO EARN HIS HIGHEST CUBSCOUT PATCH IN THE WEEBLO'S. THE CAMPOUT WAS TO BE A FATHER SON OUTING BUT MR ██████ WAS UNABLE TO ATTEND DUE TO OTHER OBLIGATIONS. AT THIS TIME IT WAS SUGGESTED BY AN UNK. SCOUTMASTER THAT S/NENNO ACCOMPANY THE VICT. IT WAS AGREED UPON AND S/NENNO TOOK ██████ TO THE FUNCTION.

THAT NIGHT BOTH ADULTS AND THE BOYS ON THE CAMPOUT SLEPT IN A LARGE TENT. S/NENNO AND THE VICT. WERE NEXT TO THE END OF THE TENT. THE VICT. STATED S/NENNO KEPT TALKING TO HIM AFTER THEY WERE ALL IN BED. THE VICT RELAYED THAT HE BECAME SLEEPY AND DID FINALLY FALL ASLEEP.

██████ STATED THAT THE NEXT THING HE REMEMBERED WAS THE SUSP. SHAKING HIM TO WAKE HIM UP. THE VICT. STATED HE HAD URINATED IN HIS BED. THE SUSP INSTRUCTED HIM TO GO TO THE BATHROOM AND COME BACK TO BED. WHEN THE VICT HAD DONE THS HE LAY ON TOP OF HIS SLEEPING BAG AND COVERED HIMSELF WITH HIS BLANKET

THE SUSP THEN ASKED THE VICT IF HE HAD
ANY URSER STOMACH TO WHICH THE REPLY WAS
"YES" AT THAT TIME THE SUSP REMAINED OVER AND
STARTED RUBBING [REDACTED]'S STOMACH. AFTER RUBBING
HIS STOMACH FOR AN UNK PERIOD OF TIME THE
SUSP ASKED [REDACTED] IF HE WANTED TO BE SHOWN
"A WAY TO STOP WETTING THE BED." THE SUSP
BEGAN RUBBING THE VICT'S PENIS AND TESTICLES.

[REDACTED] STATED THAT AFTER RUBBING HIS
PRIVATE PARTS FOR QUITE SOME TIME THE SUSP
HUGGED HIM, VERY CLOSE, NUMEROUS TIMES AND
KISSED HIM ON BOTH CHEEKS. THE SUSP TOOK
THE VICT'S TESTICLES AND SQUEEZED THEM
BETWEEN HIS FINGERS. WHEN THE VICT COMPLAINED
BECAUSE OF THE PAIN THE SUSP SAID "OK-OK!"
AND QUIT.

THE VICT STATED HE WAS NOT CERTAIN THE
LENGTH OF TIME THIS TOOK PLACE AS IT WAS LATE AT NIGHT
AND EARLY IN THE MORNING. THE SUSP HAD SAID
TO THE VICT. "THIS IS BETWEEN YOU AND ME - DON'T
TELL NO ONE ABOUT THIS. SCOUTS HONOR AND SCOUTS
DON'T LIE OR ANYTHING LIKE THAT."

THE INF. STATED THAT ON SUNDAY MORNING ONE
OF THE NEIGHBOR BOYS WHO WAS ALSO ON THE CAMPUS
KNOCKED ON THE DOOR AND RETURNED [REDACTED]'S JACKET.
THE INF. STATED HE THOUGHT IT WAS [REDACTED] RETURNING
HOME AND WHEN HE SAW THE BOY [REDACTED]
HE ASKED WHERE [REDACTED] WAS. [REDACTED] REPLIED THAT
HE ROGE BACK WITH MENNO.

PERIODS AND WAS SURPRISED WHEN MR. [REDACTED] STATED [REDACTED] HAD NOT YET RETURNED. MR. [REDACTED] BECAME CONCERNED STATING HE HAD BEEN 35-40 MIN. LATER THAN EVERYONE ELSE AS HE HAD STOPPED TO EAT AND CHANGE A FLAT TIRE. MR. [REDACTED] STATED HE WOULD DRIVE DOWN TO HONOLULU SCHOOL AND CHECK AS THAT WAS WHERE EVERYONE WAS TO MEET.

[REDACTED] STATED HE AND THE SUSP. HAD STOPPED AT HONOLULU SCHOOL AND THE SUSP. WAS TALKING TO HIM WHEN MR. [REDACTED] DROVE UP. THE SUSP. AGAIN REMINDED THE VICT. THAT HE WAS ON HIS SCOUTS HONOR. NOT TO TELL ANYONE. THE VICT. ALSO RECALLS S/NEENNO STATING "YOU WERE A LITTLE SCARED AND EMBARRASSED LAST NIGHT." [REDACTED] REPLIED "YES" S/NEENNO STATED "I'M THE TYPE OF GUY WHO SCARES AND DOES THINGS TO LITTLE BOYS."

[REDACTED] STATED TO HIS FATHER THAT THE SUSP. HAD BURSTED HIS STOMACH, BURKED HIM AND KISSED HIM ON THE CHEEK. IT WAS LATE WHEN THE VICT. TOLD HIS FATHER AND AT THAT TIME 61 PM'S DEP. COLLINS AND JOHNSON RESPONDED TO THE LOG. (T/RS).

[REDACTED] WAS ASLEEP AND MR. [REDACTED] ADVISED HE WOULD RESPOND TO SCV STATION THAT DATE.

AFTER THE STATEMENTS WERE MADE BY THE VICT AND INF. A RAMEY WARRANT WAS ISSUED AND SIGNED BY JUDGE CLARK.

DEP. G. JOHNSON! SGT. [REDACTED] W.A. [REDACTED]

AND MYSELF RESPONDED TO THIS CALL AND AT APPROX 11:00 AM
UNLESS THE SUSP WAS TEMPORARILY STOPPING WHEN I

[REDACTED] STATED THAT AT THE INDICATED TIME SHE OBSD THE ABOVE DESCRIBED VAN PARKED IN FRONT OF THE LOC. UPON LOOKING INSIDE THE PASSENGER DOOR WINDOW SHE OBSD A MALE ADULT (DESCRIBED IN SUSP COLUMN) FONDLING THE GENITALS OF A MALE JUVENILE APPROX 12 YRS OF AGE. FURTHER, SHE STATED THE JUVENILES' PANTS WERE DOWN TO HIS KNEE LEVEL, AND THAT THE ADULT & JUVENILE WERE ON THE FLOOR OF THE VAN, JUST BEHIND THE DRIVERS SEAT. I/W GIANFORTE ADDED THAT THE JUV HAD A FROZEN STARE AS SHE OBSD HIM, AS IF HE WERE UNDER DURESS.

WITNESS [REDACTED] STATED SHE OBSD THE VAN PARKED AT LOC. WHEN SHE LOOKED INSIDE, SHE OBSD A MALE JUV IN THE PROCESS OF PULLING HIS PANTS UP. SHE ALSO OBSD THE AFOREMENTIONED ADULT SITTING IN THE REAR OF THE VAN. SHE STATED THE ADULT APPEARED ANNOYED AT HER PRESENCE, AND THAT HE LEFT SHORTLY AFTER, BREAKING TRACTION AS HE SPED AROUND THE CORNER.

FURTHER WE NOTED THE DRIVER & SOLE OCCUPANT STRONGLY RESEMBLED THE ADULT DESCRIBED BY THE WITNESSES. (MR. PATRICK WILLIAM NENNO, MW-21, REDDISH BLONDE HAIR, BLUE EYES, 6-0, 240, UNSHAVEN, YELLOW T-SHIRT, BLUE JEANS, OF 28405 SPACE 4 SAND CYN RD, N/P BUSINESS-M.D.S. WE DESCRIBED THE NATURE OF OUR INVESTIGATION TO MR. NENNO & ADVISED HIM OF HIS RIGHTS PER SHAD '77, TO WHICH HE UNDERSTOOD & WAIVED). HE RESPONDED TO THE ALLEGATIONS BY STATING HE DID HAVE A JUVENILE IN HIS VAN AND THAT HE WAS PARKED AT LOCATION. FURTHER, HE (MR. NENNO) IS ACTIVE IN BOY SCOUTS AND WAS COUNSELING ONE OF THE SCOUTS RE: MISCONDUCT. HE STATED THE ONLY PHYSICAL CONTACT WAS WHEN HE HELD THE BOYS' HAND, DURING THEIR CONVERSATION.

MR. NENNO STATED THE BOY WAS SCOUTMASTER DEP'S DELIA S. NAGLER INTERVIEWED MR. [REDACTED] MWA OF [REDACTED] CYN CTRY, [REDACTED] WHO RELATED HE FELT SUSPICIOUS ABOUT MR. NENNO'S OVERLY FRIENDLY CONDUCT TOWARD THE SCOUTS, HIS

U/S DEP COLLINS INTERVIEWED AND WAS OF THE SAME OPINION. Patrick Nenko has responded to SCV Station on 5-11-78 and 5-12-78 and talked extensively with Sgt. Andresen, Detective Johnson, Sgt. Harand, 037501, and Sgt. Griffith. Suspect denied ever touching the boy's private parts or ever having his pants down. Suspect Nenko agreed to a polygraph examination for 5-22-78 but, prior to that date, he was arrested for 268 P.C., File #02653.

After Suspect Nenko's arrest, [REDACTED] again talked with Sgt. Griffith and Detective Johnson and denied any crime. For these reasons this case is inactive pending any additional information.

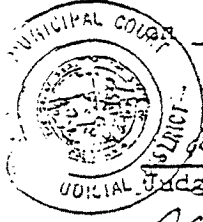

The purpose of this supplementary report is to add [REDACTED]'s statements.

[REDACTED] resides at [REDACTED], Canyon Country, (Granada Villa, N/P). Mr. [REDACTED] has a son in victim [REDACTED]'s Cub Scout troop. Mr. [REDACTED] attended the Cub Scout father-son overnight camp out on 5-20-78.

Mr. [REDACTED] stated that suspect Nenno had tried to fill a "Macho" role with the boys and had an unusual amount of physical contact. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he felt suspect Nenno's actions were abnormal and several times during the day thought of mentioning his feelings to the Cub Scout leaders, but did not want to make statements that may later prove false.

Mr. [REDACTED] slept across the tent lengthwise. He stated that during the night he got up several times to have a cigarette. He further relayed that during the night at an unknown hour, he heard [REDACTED] crying. When he started to get up, he heard suspect Nenno talking to victim [REDACTED] and decided it was not necessary.

Mr. [REDACTED] stated that the next morning there was some mention of [REDACTED] urinating in his sleeping bag but nothing further.

Mr. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] and two other boys rode home with suspect Nenno. Mr. [REDACTED] and his son stopped for breakfast with suspect Nenno and the boys. During breakfast S/Nenno made an excuse to return to his van which was parked next to [REDACTED]'s pick-up. On the way home Mr. [REDACTED] had a flat tire. When the tire was fixed, there appeared to be no punctures which lead Mr. [REDACTED] to believe that S/Nenno had let air out of his tires so S/Nenno would have more time with victim [REDACTED].

Mr. [REDACTED] returned his son, [REDACTED] to his mother, a neighbor of the [REDACTED]'s. [REDACTED] returned 7/[REDACTED]'s coat and when he did, Mr. [REDACTED] asked where [REDACTED] was. Mr. [REDACTED] at that time became aware that [REDACTED] had not yet returned home, and a considerable amount of time had passed. Mr. [REDACTED] agreed to drive to Honby School.

When Mr. [REDACTED] arrived at the school, he noted numerous persons in the area and S/Nenno with V/[REDACTED]. He pulled up to S/Nenno's vehicle and told the suspect to take V/[REDACTED] home, that his parents were waiting for him. Mr. [REDACTED] then waited to see that the suspect took V/[REDACTED] home.

Mr. [REDACTED] became aware of the fact that the above incidents had been reported to the Sheriff's Department, and on 5-21-78 had stopped at the [REDACTED]'s residence. Mr. [REDACTED] observed the suspect to drive up shortly after he had arrived and approached him stating, "What are you doing here?" Suspect Nenko replied that he had come to show [REDACTED] how to pack a backpack. Mr. [REDACTED] stated, "Hey, after what you've done, I don't think you're very welcome here!" On 5-31-78 Mr. [REDACTED], Sr., M/W 39, contacted investigators at SCV Station. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he lived at [REDACTED] Canyon Country, phone [REDACTED], and is currently a Cubscout leader for the troop which Victim [REDACTED] is a member of. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that the camping function which Victim [REDACTED] attended was to be a father/son outing to obtain the highest Cubscout award issued.

Mr. [REDACTED] stated he made an exception with one of the Cubscout members attending with his father and, therefore, when Mr. [REDACTED]'s father, could not attend he made a second exception.

On Tuesday night, May 16, 1978, Mr. [REDACTED] attended a troop meeting for local Boy Scouts, at which time Mr. [REDACTED] advised Suspect Patrick Nenno would substitute for Victim [REDACTED]'s father. At this time it was also mentioned by Mr. [REDACTED] that Suspect Patrick Nenno was having some problems involving his son, [REDACTED] ([REDACTED], M/W 10, File 178 02616 0679 444). Mr. [REDACTED] explained that the problems, as explained to him, were not such that the suspect was involved in any type of child molestation, but, rather, he had disciplined by using physical force. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he formed the opinion that the incident, as explained to him, was not of the nature to keep Suspect Nenno from attending.

The boys in the troop liked Suspect Nenno and at the camp-out the boys referred to him as "Super Scout."

Saturday night, the adults and boys slept in a tent. The sleeping arrangement was: [REDACTED], Victim [REDACTED], Suspect Patrick Nenno, Steven Stanchfield, [REDACTED], Mr. [REDACTED] and Mr. [REDACTED] (who slept crossways in the tent). Sometime in the night, Mr. [REDACTED] woke up and Victim [REDACTED] was crying. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he had stayed up until quite late and had also seen Mr. [REDACTED] awake and moving about. When Mr. [REDACTED] heard [REDACTED] crying he started to get up but heard Suspect Nenno talking to him.

The next morning Mr. [REDACTED] was told by Suspect Nenno that [REDACTED] had wet his sleeping bag.

On 5-22-78 at 1905 hours suspect Nenko was interviewed in Interview Room 26 by Sgt. Griffith and Dep. Johnson. The suspect was read his rights per SHAD-477 by Dep. Johnson, to which he stated he understood and waived.

Suspect Nenko stated that he is an assistant Boy Scout leader of Newhall Scout Troop 605. He related that on 5-20-78 three juvenile scout members of his troop and four adults went on an all night camp-out to Camp Josepno in the Santa Monica Mountains (located at 3000 Rustic Canyon Road, Pacific Palisades, 90902). On Saturday evening all seven persons slept in a tent which was approximately 9 ft. by 12 ft.

During the early morning hours the suspect related that he was awakened by victim [Redacted], who was sleeping next to the suspect. The suspect stated he was awakened because the victim had wet his sleeping bag. The suspect stated that at that time he instructed the victim to remove his wet undershorts, and the victim complied. Suspect Nenko stated he then turned the victim's sleeping bag over and had the victim lie on top of the sleeping bag, and he covered him with a blanket. A short time later the victim wet the sleeping bag again. The suspect instructed the victim to go outside and urinate. When the victim returned, the suspect had the victim lie close to him for body warmth and he again covered the victim with a blanket.

Suspect Nenko stated that due to the victim's wetting the bed twice, the victim was upset and stated that he had urinary problems but had not wet the bed in a long time. The victim also complained of being homesick and having stomach ache. The suspect stated he recalled when he was a young boy scout and had a stomach ache. His scout leader then massaged his stomach and it helped to relieve the pain. The suspect, therefore, began to massage the victim's stomach cramps and also kissed the victim on his forehead and hoped it would calm him down. The suspect said the victim also kissed him.

The suspect stated that as he massaged the victim's stomach, he began to massage the victim's penis as well. The suspect related that as he massaged the victim's penis that the victim obtained an erection. The suspect continued to massage the victim's erect penis for 2 to 4 minutes. As he did so, he told the victim that as long as his penis was hard, he could not urinate. Suspect Nenko stated he could not remember ever squeezing the victim's testicles or hearing the victim state, "Ouch, that hurts!" The suspect stated that he was very tired that evening and he remained in his sleeping bag while he massaged the victim. He stated that he never obtained an erection nor did the victim ever ejaculate.

Suspect Neruo continued to state that after he massaged the victim's penis, he began to massage the victim's back. But soon thereafter, he began to massage the victim's penis again, which was now limp. As he massaged the victim's penis again, the victim again obtained an erection and the suspect continued to massage his erect penis for an unknown amount of time.

The suspect states that while he was caring for the victim, that he did kiss him several times but he could not recall when or what was occurring at the time as he was too tired to remember.

After the camp-out the scout group returned to the Newhall area with the suspect transporting three of the young scouts, including the victim. The suspect drove the other scouts home first. The suspect then drove to a location near the victim's home and stopped and parked his van so he could talk to the victim. Suspect Neruo stated he was parked with the victim for approximately 5 to 15 minutes. During this time he informed the victim that he would not tell the other scout members about the bedwetting incident and that it was their secret. The suspect denied that he had the victim take the Boy Scout Oath not to tell about what occurred. Suspect Neruo states he knows what he did was wrong and does not know why he did it.

Facts of this case to be presented to the District Attorney's office under the jurisdiction of where the crime occurred.
