
Dear Howard:

I have been cautioned by Cameron H. Speck, who  
has identified himself as Juvenile Probation Officer, who  
has warned me as follows:

WARNING

I am a police officer. I warn you that anything you say will be used in a Court of law against you;  
That you have an absolute right to remain silent;  
That you have the right to the advice of a lawyer before and the presence of a lawyer here with you during questioning, and  
That if you cannot afford a lawyer, one will be furnished for you free before any questioning if you desire.

I hereby state that I want to make a statement without a lawyer, that is to say, give up and do without the right to talk to a lawyer and ask his advice before I make a statement, and also I wish to give up and do without having a lawyer present with me during the time when questions are asked me and during the time when I answer those questions. I am willing to make the following statement to the above person, knowing that any statement I make may be used against me in Court and that I have an absolute right to remain silent.

I declare that the following statement is made of my own free will without anyone having promised me anything or offered out to me any hope of reward, and I make this statement without any fear of physical harm, without anyone having offered to do me any favor and without anyone promising me leniency.

I further state that I am able to read and write the English language and have completed 6 years of school.

I have known Mr. Unklesbay since I was in the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. He started playing around with me, this I mean by playing with my privates, for about a year and a half. He started by first showing me some pictures of naked men and women. He then started by pulling down the zipper on my pants and began playing with me. This first time took place about a year and a half ago. The most recent time took place this past Saturday afternoon at Paul's house. Up till this past Saturday he has done this with me on many other occasions. There are at least 9 or 10 times that this took place in the <sup>room</sup> while all he had on was his bath robe. He has also asked me to suck his "peter" but I wouldn't. He did put his mouth down on my "peter" once, but this was about a year or so ago.

On Saturday April 1<sup>st</sup>, 1967 I first went to town with my grandparents, this was about 10 A.M. we got back home about noon. I then went directly over to

Paul's to get some money he owed me for playing with me. He owed me this money, a total of \$150, for about 3 weeks, he had given me 50¢ the day he played with me and said he pay me the rest later. He usually paid me \$200 for each time he played with me. When I first got to Paul's, he was shoveling dirt and [redacted] was rolling the yard. I then hopped on the roller with [redacted] and rode around the yard with [redacted]. We then rode over to where Paul was. I then got and talked with Paul about the money he owed me, meanwhile [redacted] went on riding the roller. Paul told me that he didn't have any money yet but his wife will have some later on. I then got back on the roller with [redacted]. After a few minutes [redacted] turned off the tractor and said he was going to look at some pictures. I knew what pictures [redacted] was talking about, they are the same ones that I saw. While they were gone I started the tractor and drove around awhile. Then I went into the basement of Paul's house. The first person I saw was [redacted] looking at the dirty pictures. These are the same pictures Paul showed me. I talked to [redacted] for just a few seconds then left. As I left Paul came back. I went back to ride on the tractor for awhile then left to go home to change clothes. After I had changed clothes I went back over to Paul's. When I got there Paul told me to go ahead

AFTER ABOUT 15 MINUTES [REDACTED] GOT OFF AND WENT TO PAUL TO GET HIS MONEY. THIS IS THE LAST I SAW OF [REDACTED]. AFTER A FEW MINUTES MR. HARPER CAME OVER AND ASKED IF THE ROLLER BELONG TO ME AND I SAID NO IT BELONGS TO PAUL. THEN PAUL CAME UP. PAUL THEN ASKED ME IF I WANTED TO ROLL MR. HARPER'S YARD. I SAID YES AND DID SO. MR. HARPER PAID ME \$100 AND GAVE PAUL 50¢ FOR GASOLINE. AFTER I HAD ROLLED MR. HARPER'S YARD PAUL TOLD ME TO PUT THE TRACTOR AWAY AND COME DOWN IN THE BASEMENT. AS I WENT INTO THE BASEMENT PAUL WAS BEHIND THE DOOR AS I LOOK AROUND HE CLOSED THE DOOR AND STEPPED OUT. HE WAS FULLY DRESSED BUT HIS "PETER" WAS OUT OF HIS PANTS. HE THEN TOLD ME TO COME OVER, WHICH I DID

AND he then unzipped my pants and he then started playing with my "peter" and he took my hand and placed it on his "peter".

This took place for about 5 or 6 minutes. I then said that I wanted to go out and ride my bike. He told me to come back later to get the money he owed me. I then went out to go riding Robert Miller who was waiting for me.

While I was in the basement with Paul, Mrs. Unklesbay was upstairs.

I haven't been over to Paul's since April 1st when this last act took place. I think that these things that I've done with Paul are wrong.

The above statement has been printed for me by Mr. Cameron H. Speck Juvenile Probation Officer.

The above statement is true to the best of my knowledge.

On Sat. 4/7/67 at 10:30 AM I was called by a boy called my house name [REDACTED] he asked my mother if I could come over to his house to roll his yard. The yard was in the back of his lot. When I got there he asked me to roll the back of his lot. I asked him what he wanted me to roll. He said "out in the front yard." As I was rolling out in the front yard he started to talk dirty to me. The words he used were "SORE" and "BUTT". These words were very dirty. After he finished rolling he started to look around his house. Every time he saw something he said had dirty words. Then he said he had some pictures he wanted to show me. He also wanted to show me the pictures in his basement. I went down stairs and he gave me a stack of cards with pictures on them. These pictures were of naked men and women. I think that the pictures are very

dirty. I only looked at about (5) five or (6) six pictures then stopped. I then ran out into the back yard. [REDACTED] was on the roller and had run over a rose bush. When I went with into the basement [REDACTED] was fooling around with the tractor.

I forgot to say that before we went into the basement Paul was riding on the tractor behind me, and asked to show me "how to play with it" and "how would you like that". I said no because I want to be a minister and this is not the way to start out.

When I left the basement I rode the roller for awhile the left and went home. I told my mother that after that I didn't want to ever go back there to work. I told my mother the rest of story on Monday evening.

The above statement is true to the best of my knowledge and has been written by Cameron H. Speck for me.

In order to strengthen our position in refusing to accept any future application for registration from this individual, we would very much appreciate your obtaining for us any substantiating documents that may be available pertaining to this situation, such as: statement from the directing psychiatrist of the Massillon State Hospital; statement from the boys involved or the parents of the boys; copy of police report; or any newspaper clippings. We would also appreciate your advising us of the final disposition of this case when it comes before the courts.

This additional information will enable us to identify Mr. Unklesbay should he ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program. Thanks for your help.


