

I am in receipt of your letter of August 31, 1988, regarding the above-cited individual. Please be advised that my client only resigned from the Boy Scouts, because he was compelled to by the Kootaga Area Council - No. 618, as a result of the false allegations concerning child abuse, made by one of the children in his troop. Mr. Thornton was told that once the matter was cleared up, he would be fully reinstated as Scoutmaster. I, therefore, request that you indicate the steps that must be taken to satisfy the Boy Scouts' concerns in this matter, in order that Mr. Thornton be reinstated as Scoutmaster. You should be aware that these allegations are vigorously contested by my client and are, in affect, defamatory. While the Boy Scouts may feel it is necessary to exercise caution in this regard, I believe it is incumbent upon them to conduct an investigation, regarding these charges, and to make necessary restitution once the charges have been proven false.

Please let me hear from you, as soon as possible.

Dear Mr. Bopp,

The Department of Human Services requested me to perform a psychological evaluation on _____ in July of this year. Referral questions had to do with his very poor school performance as reported by his school and father, and the question of possible sexual abuse. In order to evaluate these questions, I interviewed his father, was provided records from seem 's school and the Department of Human Services, and spent six hours with the boy talking with him and administering a comprehensive battery of psychological tests. I also spoke with Dr. Steven Hanna, the physician with whom I had arranged a physical examination for because of school reports of encopresis.

flatly denied that he had been involved in any sexual activity with anyone, and specifically with the Scout Leader with whom he had spent "special overnights" at the man's home alone. Dr. Hanna reported that there was no physical evidence of sexual abuse evident during his examindation of and that the boy and his father denied that he was soiling his pants.

There is no concrete evidence that is being sexually abused by his Scout Leader or anyone else. However, based on my clinical experience with sexually abused children, I believe that he is. I based my conclusions on his becoming encopretic when he joined Scouting, the lack of medical explanation for this behavior, his high potential for victimization or exploitation due to his past history of deprivation, physical abuse, and possible sexual abuse, and his isolation and alienation from peers partially due to learning difficulties and school problems. In addition, lives with his father and 82 year old great-grandmother between whom there is considerable conflict over 's parenting. The result is that he is inadequately supervised and disciplined. The close friendship between states is father and Scout Leader has apparently led to insufficient supervision of the time and his Scout Leader spend alone.

In conclusion, I have reported to the Department of Human Services my belief interest from registration is probably being sexually abused and recommend that time alone with his Scout Leader should be terminated.

MEETING BETWEEN ED DUNN, RUTH BARRY AND JIM BOPP...

MRS BARRY BEGAN BY GIVING THE BACKROUND OF HOW AND WHY SHE FELT THERE MIGHT BE A PROBLEM, STATING THAT SHE WAS WORKING AS AN INTAKE WORKER AND HAD BEEN DOING SOME INVESTIGATION REGARDING THE SCOUTS FAMILY AND HAD LEARNED THE BOY HAD BEEN SOILING HIS PANTS FOR THE PAST TWO YEARS. THE FAMILY SITUATION WAS SUCH THAT THERE WAS A POSSIBILITY THAT HE WAS BEING SEXUALLY ABUSED BY SOME MALE. FURTHER QUESTIONING REVEALED THAT HE WAS A BOY SCOUT AND HE SEEMED TO HAVE A GREAT AFFECTION FOR HIS SCOUTMASTER, BARY THORNTON. MRS BARRY INTERVIEWED THE BOYS TEACHER AND RECIEVED ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT INDICATED THERE IS A STRONG BOND OF FRIENDSHIP BETWEEN THE SCOUT AND BARY THORNTON. THE TEACHER ALSO SHE HAS HAD UNEASY FEELINGS ABOUT THE SCOUTMASTER AND HIS WAY OF OPERATING THE TROOP, BUT HAS NOTHING TO SUBSTANTIATE ANYTHING. MRS BARRY REPEATED SHE ALSO HAD NOTHING BUT A "FEELING" THERE MIGHT BE SOMETHING WRONG. SHE DID INDICATE THAT WHEN SHE ASKED HOW LONG THE BOY HAD HAD THE SOILING PROBLEM HE SAID FOR THE PAST TWO YEARS.

ED DUNN ADVISED THAT HE HAD BEEN OBSERVING THE TROOP OPERATION FOR THE PAST FOUR YEARS BECAUSE HE FELT UNCOMFORTABLE WITH BARY AND HIS MANERISMS, BUT HAD FOUND NOTHING OUT OF LINE WHEN HE TALKED TO THE MEMBERS OF THE TROOP EXCEPT THAT THEY WERE VERY AWARE OF SEX. ED ADVISED THE S.E. OF THE SITUATION WHEN HE CAME TO THE COUNCIL AND WAS ADVISED TO KEEP A CLOSE WATCH ON THE TROOP AT CAMPOREES AND TO VISIT THE TROOP WHEN THEY COME TO CAMP AND TALK TO THE MEMBERS TO TRY TO DETERMINE IF THERE IS A PROBLEM. ED DID AND ADVISED THE S.E. THAT THERE SEEMS TO BE NOTHING OUT OF THE ORDER, JUST A GUT FEELING. HE DID MENTION THAT AT ONE TIME BARY CONTACTED HIM WANTING TO KNOW WHY HE WAS BEING "INVESTIGATED". ED FILLED MRS BARRY IN ON AS MUCH OF THE BACKROUND AS HE KNEW ABOUT THE SCOUTMASTER.
