Dear Mr. Lyons:

Please convey for me, to your patient that I sincerely regret the incident that he has revealed to you.

Unfortunately Scouting like all of society, was not addressing this issue in the time this occurred. I can say that Scouting has now made this a priority.

Scouting is working closely with our community sponsors to make it almost impossible for a known child abuser to be a participant in Scouting leadership. Our Scouting handbooks and videos address the problem directly to youth as well. We are trying to set up safeguards for all concerned, but you must also recognize that we are limited by what the youths, parents and our laws will permit us to do.

We only keep records for seven years. We do not currently show any registered leader by the name given.

Again, please convey my sincere regret to your client.

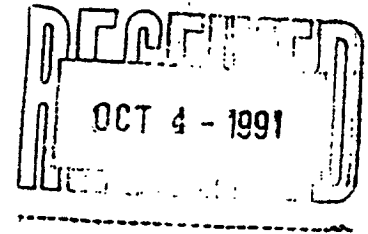

Dear Mr. Brock:

How do I start, to tell of something that was done to me about 21 or 20 some years ago, by one of your leaders. A person that was to help shape my early development, instead he helped destroy it.

Where do I start, a friend said to "just tell the facts." The fact is this -- a man sexually abused me while I was a member of his Explorer group.

What happened -- one night after a meeting when nobody was there he lured me back to a room. Where he had x-rated films. While viewing them, he pulled my pants down and began to fondle my penis. I asked him to stop after a while. I guess I knew when I said no that the film would stop. This was his bait. He did, and asked me to tell nobody. He would no longer be a leader, the other boys and girls (one of which he married and took from one of the other boys, but that's another story) would have a group, this would be my fault. Which I have learned would not be.

What has happened since then? I have survived this. I have started counseling of which this letter has come out of. I'm married and have two children of my own who I pray this never happens to.

What do I want from your organization? This man stop from being a part of your organization, if he still is. That this man knows that you know. An investigation, I have heard there are others he may have done this to. Who am I and who is he? RAY ALEXANDER - his name - Wilmerding, PA - place where the group met -- 1968-1972 are years I was a member. My name I feel isn't important because I'm still afraid of what he could do. Like I said, I have a wife (who knows) and two kids I must support if he denies this. I would not like my people at work to know this. I still live here. You see this abuse still has an impact on me.
