SUSPECTED CHILD ABUSE REPORTING FORM HUDSON-HAMILTON COUNCIL BOY SCOUTS of AMERICA

The following information was provided to:

Gerard J. Chiara, Lodge Advisor, , Jersey City, N.J. Child's Name: Jersey City, N.J. Child's date of birth unknown to me at this time. Physical Indications Observed: None observed. He appeared to be fine. Behavioral Indications Observed: He spoke with me in the presence of another young man by the Jersey City, N.J. is also a member appeared calm and in control; he did not appear upset or confused. I arrived at Alpine Scout Camp on 8 April 1989 at approximately 7:00PM. When I arrived the Scouts were having Diner and I joined them. The Scouts from Elauwit Lodge were seated at one table with the adult advisors as well. All appeared in good spirits. I left the table to speak with Mr. Iannaccone, the Section Advisor. Shortly thereafter, Mr. Manzari, an adult advisor with the lodge came over and indicated to me that wanted to speak with me before I left. After the show I returned to the main lodge to make a telephone call. The Scouts returned to the main lodge as well and Mr. Manzari asked me if have spoken with me yet; I said not yet and said what was up. Mr. Manzari indicated that the boys wanted to speak with me. I approached the boys and asked them what they wanted. Both indicated that they had to speak with me in private so we walked outside on the building porch. indicated that Mr. Raymond Krajewski, an adult advisor with Elauwit Lodge, awoke him from bed last evening. Stated that Mr. Krajewski was attempting to undo the string on his sweat pants. Stated that he first thought was fooling around but was startled when he realized it was Mr. Krajewski. further stated that when he awoke Mr. Krajewski said "go back to bed". I asked if Mr. Krajewski touched him in any way other than his attempting to undo his sweat pants string. said no. was present during this conversation. I further that he should speak with his parents and I would speak with the Scout Executive. I further advised that he should return home with another adult as he told me he came to camp with Mr. Krajewski. I asked if he thought he was in any danger that evening as I was leaving; he said no. I further instructed him that if he needed any additional help or wanted to talk with an adult to do so with Mr. Iannaccone. Mr. Iannaccone was not only the Section Advisor but is a member of Elauwit Lodge who knew. I advised Mr. Iannaccone of the situation before I left camp. I left camp about 11:30PM, Saturday, 8 April 1989. I advised Mr Cinquina (Lodge Professional Advisor) of the situation on Monday, 10 April 1989. On Tuesday, April 11th. at 3:45 P.M., I received a call from the mother of a Scout a member of the OA in Hudson-Hamilton Council, on National Leadership Seminar April 7-8-9.

She wanted to speak to Marcel Cinquina about a problem her son had on the OA Training Weekend. After speaking with this woman, who wanted to remain anonymous, she informed me that her son, who was on the OA Weekend, was sleeping in his cabin in Camp Alpine, of the Greater New York City Council, located on Route 9W in Alpine, New Jersey. He was touched by Ray Krajewski and woke up and chased him away. In the morning he mentioned the incident to another Scout who was with him and both of them talked to one of the advisors, Robert Manzari, in camp that weekend. The OA Lodge Advisor, Jerry Chiara, was informed of the incident when he came up to camp later that day and he called my office on Monday, April 10th. He was unable to reach me and left a message for me to call him. I returned the call on April 11th., and reached him at approximately 4:30 P.M. that day.

We met at approximately 6:00 P.M. on April 11th. with the Executive assigned to the OA, Marcel Cinquina. Jerry informed me what he was told by the boy and one of the other leaders on this OA trip.

We discussed the incident and decided that Basil D'Armiento, the Scout Executive, would get a letter signed by the President of the Council and himself, stating that we would not accept the registration of Ray Krajewski, who was due to re-register this month. At the same time, Marcel Cinquina, who is also the District Executive where this man is registered, would contact the head of the institution to inform him that we would not accept the registration of Raymond Krajewski. Then Marcel and Jerry would meet with Ray on Thursday, April 13th. and hand-deliver the letter to him, making sure that he is not registered or involved in any Scouting functions of the Council.

Basil, the Scout Executive, called the SAVA unit of the Prosecutors office of Hudson County and was informed that Sgt. Farrell was in charge, replacing Lt. Racek. He was not available at this time and would call him back. Basil also called the local Jersey City Police Department Youth Bureau and spoke to Lt. Pizzelanti. He was informed that unless charges are brought against this man in Jersey City, he could do nothing and if charges were brought against this man, they should be presented in Alpine, where the incident occurred. Upon contacting DYFAS was informed that unless the crime was committed against a youth, they do not handle it. Talking to the youth's mother, charges must be placed through local authorities by parents if they want them to take action.
