Dear Rick:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

The following information is provided should you desire a review by the South Central Region, BSA, of the decision to deny your registration.

1. Within 60 days, you must request in writing a review of this decision. Your request should be sent to:

Regional Director
South Central Region
Boy Scouts of America
P. O. Box 152079
Irving, Texas 75015-2079

In your request you must include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that registration should not have been denied.

2. Upon receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
3. If the regional review committee determines that a review hearing is necessary, the committee will advise you whether or not you may attend. In some instances, no useful purpose would be served by having the applicant present. The hearing is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you, if you attend, will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, in the event you attend, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
6. If you are dissatisfied with the decision of a regional review, you may request a further review by the National Council. The decision of the National Council will be final.

On January 8, 1991, I spoke to [REDACTED] age 26 (works at [REDACTED]
[REDACTED]. Father was killed when
he was seven years old and mother was in prison - drug charges.)

He told me that when he was a ten year old Webelos Scout, he was
molested by Rick Griffith who was his Webelos leaders.

He said it first started when, one night after the meeting, Rick took
all the other boys home but took [REDACTED] to his (Rick's) parents home
where he lived. Rick explained that no one was at home. He said
everyone had gone to a basketball game. His reason for taking [REDACTED]
to his home was to work on a first aid badge. He took [REDACTED] into his
bedroom and asked him to take off his pants. He then rubbed his penis
and then asked him to do the same to him. [REDACTED] said that he did not
resist.

The same thing happened on a number of occasions after that night.
Each time it was at Rick's home. He would take [REDACTED] into his
bedroom while the meeting was in progress. Each time they would feel
each other but no oral sex up to this point. On one occasion he said
that [REDACTED] young brother walked in on them.

The oral sex started on a camping trip. He was always paired up with
Rick. There were approximately four camping trips. [REDACTED] gave oral
sex to Rick on one occasion.

[REDACTED] dropped out of Scouting and told his grandmother that the
reason was that they were mean to him.

[REDACTED] received counseling on and off between the age of 14 to 16
years old.

I asked [REDACTED] why he was coming forward now as an adult. He said
that he has been back in counseling for about a year and has talked
about it with the counselor. He said that last month he developed some
pictures of Boy Scouts. When the lady picked up her pictures, he asked
her if she knew Rick Griffith and if he was still involved in Scouting.
The lady said she did not know but would find out. He said that the
lady called him back and said that Rick was still working in Scouting.
He said he knew that he had to stop him from hurting other boys.

[REDACTED] asked to be present when Rick was confronted.

NOTE: [redacted] said that he knew of three other boys [redacted] in their Webelos den who admitted to each other that Rich had molested them. [redacted] did not know if these boys ever told their parents. He said their names should be kept confidential [redacted].)

* * * * *

On January 17, 1991 I met with Rick Griffeth and told him of the accusation and that his BSA registration had been suspended. I told him that his accuser wanted to confront him. I explained that Circle Ten Council was not encouraging nor discouraging this meeting. It was strictly up to him. I told him that if they decided to meet, they could meet at the Circle Ten Council office and I would be present. He said that he would be willing to face his accuser. Rick did not ask the name or names of his accuser. I told Rick to think about it over the weekend and decide whether or not he wanted to have the meeting with his accuser. I asked him to let me know.

* * * * *

On Monday, January 21, [redacted] called me. He identified himself as the father of [redacted] who was a Webelos Scout under Rick Griffeth at the same time [redacted] was a Webelos.

[redacted] said that his son [redacted] died last year of AIDS. He said that he and his wife were always concerned about the large amount of time Rick Griffeth spent alone with their son [redacted] while working on badges.

[redacted] said that he would do whatever it takes to make sure that Rick Griffeth never again works with young boys.

* * * * *

[redacted] said that he has been told that one of the Webelos, [redacted] committed suicide some years ago.

* * * * *

On Monday, January 31, 5:30 p.m., [redacted] and Rick Griffeth met in the conference room next to my office. I introduced them to each other and they shook hands.

[redacted] asked Rick if he remembered him. Rick said that he did not. [redacted] told him that he was one of his Webelos Scouts some 15 to 16 years ago. He then told Rick the same story he had previous related to me (page one).

██████ told Rick ██████ that he has impacted his life ██████ a very negative way and that he has been in counseling since he was 14 years old. ██████ said to Rick, "My grandmother entrusted me to you and you violated that trust." He said that if his mother, who was in prison at the time and a member of the Mafia, had known about the situation, she would have had him killed. He further said that she would probably still do it even today if she found out.

Rick listened and said very little.

I asked if either of them had anything else to say. They both responded no. I told ██████ he could leave, but asked Rick to stay for a few moments.

After ██████ left, I reminded Rick that this would be kept confidential as long as he did not attempt to work in Scouting. He said that he understood that he is suspended from Scouting and will never again be involved. He said that he has a son who is ready to join Scouting, but now may change his mind. I explained that if his son joined that he could attend Courts of Honor and parent functions, but re-emphasized that he could never again serve in any adult leadership role in Scouting. He said that he understood.

Rick told me that this was a bad day for him. He said that he lost his job today, his son had a fight at school and his wife wanted to go to a marriage counselor. He added that he knew he was probably going to lose his job and that it had nothing to do with the suspension from Scouting.
