He also took boys to his home where kept the "used" uniforms and had the boys try on the pants. He would then have the boys remove all of their clothing and he would "examine" them to make sure they were physically fit to join the Troop. As far as can be determined - nothing beyond this took place between the man and the boys.

During the investigation, we have been able to determine that he was also asked to resign from his former Troop because of a number of the "Birthday" spankings.

I am typing this paper for my son [REDACTED] on Sunday, October 28, 1978. [REDACTED] is telling me his experience with Mr. John Quick in his own words.

Mr. Quick took me to his home to try on a Boy Scout uniform. He told me to take off all my clothes, and gave me a uniform to try on, after that he told me to remove the uniform and he gave me a physical. He examined me below the waist in front and up my bottom.

Mr. Quick did this again only this time he took me to his camper and called it his "private fitting room"

Dear Sir:

We the Parents of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], after questioning our sons have written their statements, honestly and truthfully. To submit over two years of incidents with dates and places is impossible in [REDACTED]'s case.

We have worked and believed in the Boy Scouts of America for years, we have entrusted our three sons to Mr. John Quick, Scoutmaster. So we believe that the Boy Scouts of America should handle this situation, out after your investigation and confortation if any retaliation against our sons should occur, we will immediately contact the Royal Oak Youth Bureau for their protection.

On September 21, 1978 this was brought to our attention by Mrs. T. Nichols at a P.T.A. Meeting, at home we awakened and asked our sons, "if Mr. Quick had ever put his hands in their underwear?" Their answers were, "Yes." Mr. Jack M'Nie was called immediately.

It is to our knowledge that other boys in Troop 1604 have been approached by Mr. John Quick.

I ([REDACTED]) have been under care by Dr. Robert Weitzman M.D. and Dr. Phillip Freidman M.D. Psychiatry, counseling has been advised for our sons, especially [REDACTED] as soon as possible, because of their humiliation and guilt feelings. Therefore we ask that this investigation be kept confidential and discreet.

Some time ago after seeing the picture of the boys, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], I became suspicious and questioned Bob if Mr. Quick had ever done anything funny? But did not further the situation when he answered, "no."

This is [REDACTED]'s statement giving the facts concerning his experiences caused by Mr. John Quick beginning two years ago, dates will be hard to determine.

Two summer camps ago [REDACTED] went to Mr. John Quick's to try on used Scout uniforms and was given a physical examination.

On a camping trip with Mr. Quick and [REDACTED], they were forced to go swimming in the nude while pictures were taken.

Many numerous Birthday Spankings in which, [REDACTED] has been laid over Mr. Quick's lap naked have taken place. On camp-outs, during summer camp, always unwitnessed until this summer at Lost Lake in which, [REDACTED] witness, supposedly sleeping, the approach of Mr. Quick in the tent trying to undress [REDACTED] in his sleeping bag for a "Birthday Spanking" in which [REDACTED] fought him off.

[REDACTED]'s only comment is that he thought for the two years, he was the only chosen one, to whom these incidents have occurred to until this years summer camp.

This is the statement requested by you, from [REDACTED] giving facts of incidents caused by Mr. John Quick, beginning May 1978.

1. At Mr. Quick's home a Tenderfoot Requirement Meeting: Attended by Robert Anderson, John McVie, [REDACTED], Andy Race, and [REDACTED] Mr. Quick asked [REDACTED] to go into his camper outside to try on used Scout slacks, [REDACTED] was told to remove his underwear, he then performed an extended physical examination checking for ruptures. [REDACTED] was told this had to be done so that he could attend camp.

2. On two other occasions in July 1978, Mr. Quick Picked [REDACTED] up here from home and took him to his house under the guise of tryin, on uniforms. The physical examination was then repeated two more times. These examinations did cause him pain from the poking and proding.

3. Birthday spankings are given on Mr. Quick's lap after he has removed their Jeans and underwear;

1. Webelos Day at Bowman Lodge-Charles Howell, Brighton
2. Lost Lake Boy Scout Camp-August 1978  
We asked if anyone was in camp at the time and [REDACTED] said, "No."
