Newark priest gets 25-year term for sexual abuse of young boys

A former associate pastor of a North Newark Catholic church was sentenced yesterday to 25 years in prison for sexually assaulting an altar boy and molesting two other sixth graders.

Criminal Assignment Judge Sidney Reiss of Superior Court in Newark said he wanted the sentence imposed on the Rev. Richard M. Galdon to have a "chilling effect" and show "the safety of our children cannot be compromised even for our reverence for men of the cloth."

Galdon, 54, who is also a former Boy Scout chaplain and youth leader, served at Our Lady of Good Counsel Church for 27 years before he was removed by the Newark Archdiocese in 1986. For the past 20 months he has been in treatment at Foundation House in New Mexico, a center established for the care of Catholic priests who are diagnosed as pedophiles.

"I recognize, especially over the past 20 months, what I have done is serious. I know I have no one to blame other than myself," said Galdon, who did not wear the priestly collar yesterday. He said he was "filled with remorse and sorrow for what I have done to the youngsters."

Last March Galdon pleaded guilty to three crimes contained in the 17-count indictment. Under the terms of the plea bargaining agreement. Reiss was prohibited from sentencing him to more than 30 years.

Defense attorney Peter Manahan asked that Reiss consider allowing Galdon to remain at Foundation House and continue rehabilitation there. If a prison sentence must be imposed, Manahan asked it be no more than 12 to 15 years.

"He gave his life to the service of others," said Manahan as he argued for mercy. "He has, except for this offense, lived a law-abiding life."

First Assistant Prosecutor Edward J. Bilinkas contended, however, that Galdon's vocation should be weighed as an aggravating factor in deciding his punishment-not as a reason to show mercy. "This man was put in a particular position of trust. He violated that trust and because of this he should be held more accountable," said the first assistant.

Bilinkas said the priest engaged the altar boy in sodomy about three times a month after playing a strip card game during a one-year period from 1980 to 1981. Another boy was molested repeatedly as he also played cards with Galdon two years ago, according to the first assistant.

The third victim was molested numerous times while watching television with the priest over a period of two

years, dating back to September 1983.

"These children, as far as I'm concerned, their lives have been destroyed," said Bilinkas, adding that the "mother and fathers have tremendous guilt." He said the victims are now in therapy.

Reiss said Galdon admitted to authorities he has been sexually assaulting children for the past 17 years. Investigator George McGrath of the Essex County Prosecutor's Office said about a dozen victims are known.

The judge remanded Galdon to the custody of the state Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center in Avenel, a corrections facility for sex offenders. Galdon must remain there until the Avenel administrators determine he has been cured, the judge said.

Newark priest admits sex assault on altar boy, two other pre-teens

A former Boy Scout chaplain and associate pastor of a North Newark church pleaded guilty yesterday to three counts of sexually assaulting three pre-teens, one of them an altar boy.

Rev. Richard M. Galdon, 54, who spent 27 years at Our Lady of Good Counsel before he was removed from the parish last year and entered a New Mexico treatment center, pleaded guilty in Superior Court, Newark, under a plea bargain stipulating that any prison sentence not exceed 30 years,

The charges involve boys aged 10-12 who attended the parish elementary school from 1980 to 1985, according to Essex County First Assistant Prosecutor Edward J. Bilinkas.

Under questioning by Bilinkas. Galdon admitted committing various sexual acts with the boys.

"He has given the state the names of all of the boys who have been his victims," Bilinkas told Superior Court Judge Sidney H. Reiss.

One of the charges Galdon pleaded guilty to was con-

tained in a 17-count indictment sealed in May and opened yesterday. The remaining 16 charges, which all involved the same victim, will be dismissed as part of the plea bargain when Galdon is sentenced May 6.

Galdon was removed from the parish of 2,500 families after the pastor, Rev. Joseph P. Plunkett, received a report from a school officer and contacted the state Department of Youth and Family Services (DYFS), according to JoAnn Rizzolo, coordinator of media relations for the Archdiocese of Newark.

At a press conference in Our Lady of Good Counsel on Summer Avenue, Rizzolo said Galdon is on administrative leave and cannot function or dress as a priest or celebrate Mass, except privately.

Galdon spent nearly 10 years as Archdiocesan chaplain to the Boy Scouts, three troops of which met regularly in the parish, Rizzolo said.

About 600 children attend the parish's elementary school and 600 students attend the parish high school. Rizzolo said. Galdon was not a teacher at either school, she added.
