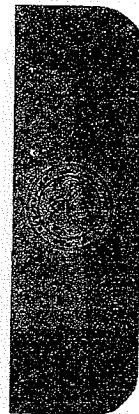

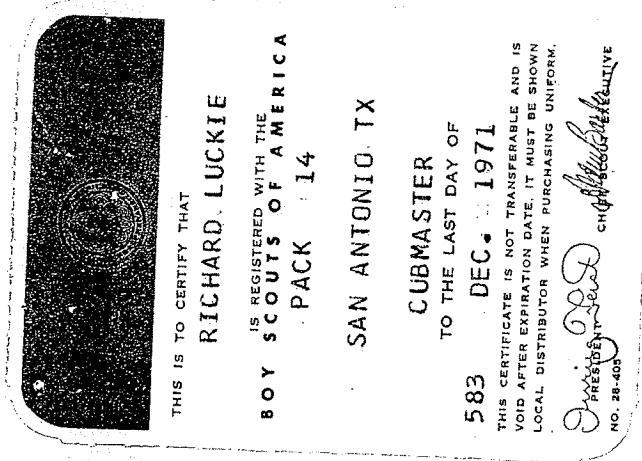

He is a life long resident of Corpus Christi, is unmarried and lists his occupation as student. He has held several part-time jobs, but has never been permanently employed.

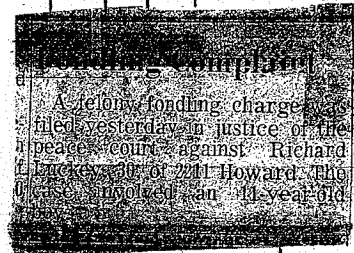
