Dear Paul.

The United States Air Force has discharged Richard W. Latham as unfit for military service. He was then charged by the State of Nebraska in substance, Debauchery of a Minor, to which he entered a plea of Nolo Contendere -- see attached copy of the Journal Entry of the District Court.

Without detailed explanation, a great deal of evidence of tape recordings regarding actions with minors dating over the past many years, was found by police officers. Richard W. Latham is now under psychiatric care and is seeking a job in New York or Chicago in his related field.

The Mid-America Council recommends placement on the Confidential File and under no circumstance should he be allowed to be involved with boy leadership in any program.

I am sending a copy of this letter to Wallace Hill at the Tioughnioga Council in Cortland, New York for his information, since Richard W. Latham for many years served as a volunteer in that council.

Details in your file reveal the confidential record sheet on Richard William Latham, previously sent to you. We have severed all relationships with Richard William Latham in the Mid-America Council. Please keep me informed should you need further details.

This cause came on for hearing this 17th day of February, 1972, it being one of the regular days of the January, A.D., 1972 term of this Court, the State being represented by Dixon G. Adams, County Attorney of Sarpy County, Nebraska, and the defendant, Richard W. Latham, being present in person and represented by his attorney, Philip H. Robinson.

The defendant was then fully advised by the Court of his constitutional rights, including his right to trial by jury, his right to confront the witnesses against him and his right to compulsory process for witnesses in his own behalf.

The defendant was also fully advised by the Court of the nature of the accusations against him and of the character of the pleas provided by the laws of the State of Nebraska open to him and the defendant stated that he fully understood his rights and the nature of the charge and acknowledged that he had consulted with his attorney concerning the same.

The defendant then requested what his arraignment proceed.

Defendant was arraigned and asked to plead to the Information charging in substance Debauchery of a Minor, to which the defendant entered his plea of Nolo Contendere. The Court accepted said plea and deferred sentence pending a pre-sentence investigation by the Adult Probation Officer of the Second Judicial District.

Now on this 13th day of April, 1972 this matter came on for

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further hearing, having been continued for pre-sentence investigation by the Probation Officer. The defendant appeared in person with his attorney and the County Attorney appeared for the State. The Probation Officer having completed his investigation and made his report thereof, the matter came on for final disposition pursuant to defendant's plea of Nolo Contendere heretofore entered on February 17, 1962.

Defendant's request for probation was granted and further proceedings were suspended and the defendant was placed on probation for a period of eighteen months, the terms and conditions of said probation being set out in a separate order of the Court which is attached hereto and made a part of this Journal Entry. Costs to the defendant.



We received the confidential record sheet on Richard W. Latham plus a copy of the letter of apology you sent him, since he is not the same man we have on the file. I am also enclosing a copy of a letter we received from Mr. Latham here at the home office and our reply.

All that has happened so far is most unfortunate and there are a few points which we would like clarified. On August 31, we received a letter from Haynes Harbaugh stating that Richard Latham was being processed out of the Air Force. What truth is there to this and what reason? It was after this that other communications led to the discovery that your Mr. Latham was not the man we have on the Confidential File and we assumed that you had more information, since the Air Force was separating him. What has transpired since is unfortunate but is this the end of it? Is Mr. Latham being separated from the service? Is there more information we should have?

Please let us know further details as soon as possible.

A confusion, we regret to inform you, was caused by the fact that a Richard D. Latham is on the confidential list and we apploping to the wrong conclusion.

For your information, the Richard D. Latham on the confidential file was never in the military service, attended Duke University, and is over 6 foot tall.

You have my personal apology for the inconvenience and distress that we have caused you and our extreme thankfulness for the fine service you give to the Scouting movement both here and in other places you have served. I have sent copies of this letter to all those concerned and you should feel completely free to use this letter in support of your character references.

Dear Mr. Ernst,

During July or August 1971, a report was received by the Mid-America Council from your office indicating that a Richard Latham was listed on your "Confidential List." This information was relayed to my commanding officer at Offutt AFB, where I am stationed.

As I am an intelligence officer with an extremely sensative security clearance, information of this character is very embarassing. As a result my security clearance has been temporarily withdrawn pending a resolution of this problem. When I was finally notified that my services with the Council here were to be terminated, several questions arose. Further investigation showed that the initial report, in fact, refered to a Richard D. Latham although the middle initial was omitted from the report. My middle initial is W. and I am definiately not the individual concerned in your report.

To assist me in regaining my clearance and clearing up this matter, I request a statement in writing to the effect that I, Richard William Latham, am not, nor ever have been on the "Confidential List" of the Boy Scouts of America. This statement should be addressed "to whom it may concern," and sent to me at the address below as quickly as possible.
