

what everybody was up too." He said
"I was just sleeping". I said, "Ok. see
you later." Then with my curiosity being aroused
I peered in an ~~side~~ eyelit of the
tent. There I witnessed Rick Roche

Having witnessed this I proceeded to get

When seen Both parties had their underwear around their knees, [REDACTED] seemed to be asleep but I wasn't able to tell. Rick's head was near [REDACTED] stomach, appeared to be kissing it. After people witnessed this someone called to Rick and he then answered and both [REDACTED] Rick came out and hung out in a different tent with everyone else. Soon after people went to bed including myself and [REDACTED] slept in Rick's tent that night.

ON JULY 6, 1991

At noon on July 7, 1991 Tom Deimler received a call from Kevin Mayeux at Flaming Arrow Scout Reservation related to use of alcohol followed by a sexual incident that happened the day before with Rick Roche and [REDACTED]. Documentation on this matter has been provided and action was taken to deny registration on the part of Rick Roche. The BSA policy letter was delivered in a meeting with Mr. Roche on July 8, 1991.

Upon further review of the matter, and in conversation with [REDACTED] father [REDACTED], Camp Director Louis LeBlanc and Field Director Brian Sindors, it was determined that beer had been provided by Rick Roche in the "staff city" tent area on the afternoon of July 6th. It was obvious that this was in violation of the policy of the BSA and consideration was given to termination of all staff members involved in this activity.

In an effort to separate the incident between Rick Roche and [REDACTED] from the others who were drinking alcohol, the matter that took place in Rick Roche's tent was first reviewed. At a meeting of Tom Deimler, Mark Griffin and Brian Sindors on July 8th the alternatives of disciplinary action were discussed. The decision had already been made to deny registration for Rick Roche. It was decided that in the best interests of character development and the program of the Boy Scouts of America, no further action should be taken against [REDACTED]. We had the total support of his father, [REDACTED] those listed above, as well as Camp Director Louis LeBlanc and Program Director Kevin Mayeux. The basis for that decision was that [REDACTED] was a victim of circumstances surrounding the inappropriate use of alcohol and Rick Roche's assertive action.

The matter had been reported immediately upon learning of this incident just after lunch on July 7, 1991. The incident between Rick Roche and [REDACTED] has been fully investigated by both the HRS of Florida and the Polk County Sheriff's Department.

The additional drinking resulted from the fact that it was provided by a senior camp staff member (Rick Roche) who offered his own interpretation to the policies of the BSA, giving strong indication that since no boys were in camp and the summer activity was not in process it would be acceptable to drink beer and not be in violation of any rules and regulations in Scouting. Aside from the fact that Rick Roche's registration has now been denied, he had served for approximately 10 years on camp staff and had become a strong influence on others.

A decision was made not to terminate those staff members involved and as an alternative provide severe disciplinary action as outlined in the Staff Guide would be done. Those actions included no nights off, waiter duty and service projects. A clearly defined memorandum dated 7-9-91 was given to each staff member that stated dismissal for any future activities involving the use of alcohol on camp property.

Further, it was decided that two volunteer camp staff members; Mark Heuser and Jim Malone, would be asked not to participate on staff during the balance of 1991. These individuals encouraged the beer drinking as well as Rick Roche and therefore have been dismissed from any activity in support of summer camp.

Lastly, it was decided that the Staff Guide book will be revised for 1992 to clearly state staff termination in the event of using alcohol at camp. Additionally, letters of contract will be revised to state this policy clearly. The matter of camp staff staying on the property after campers leaving at noon on Saturday and before the arrival of the new campers at noon on Sunday has been reviewed. The decision is that most will be encouraged to leave and those who absolutely cannot will be under close supervision with strict rules re-established..

This matter is being followed up by Camp Director Louis LeBlanc and will be reviewed periodically by Scout Executive Tom Deimler.

SUBJECT: Rick Roche

Tom Deimler and Brian Sindors met with Rick Roche in order to present the policy letter denying his registration with the Boy Scouts of America. His right to appeal this matter to the Southeast Region for their review was given to Rick Roche, as well.

Mr. Roche indicated that he was sorry for his action and that he had personally provided "beer and such" to [REDACTED] and several other camp staff members. He remarked that the entire matter was completely his doing and he accepted full responsibility.

Tom Deimler stated the policies of the Boy Scouts of America related to role model leadership and our right to deny registration upon review of these matters.

The meeting was concluded at this point.

FLAMING ARROW SCOUT RESERVATION


Dear Rick,

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be denied. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

The following information is provided should you desire a review by the Southeast Region, BSA, of the decision to deny your registration.

1. Within 60 days, you must request in writing a review of this decision. Your request should be sent to: Southeast Region BSA, [REDACTED] Kennesaw, Georgia 30144. In your request you must include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
3. If the regional review committee determines that a review hearing is necessary, the committee will advise you whether or not you may attend. In some instances, no useful purpose would be served by having the applicant present. The hearing is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you, if you attend, will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, in the event you attend, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
6. If you are dissatisfied with the decision of a regional review, you may request a further review by the National Council. The decision of the National Council will be final.


