Dear Paul:

Reference your letter of April 29, 1991 regarding Robert Allen Cook.

Duval County Court Records currently indicate that Robert Allen Cook has a case number 5072-CF-A. The case was file on May 3, 1990, disposition indicated was "9" (deferred prosecution program) the State Attorney assigned to the case is 90-9046-A (Anthony Berry).

I visited with Assistant State Attorney Anthony Berry and asked about status of Robert Allen Cook. Mr. Berry introduced me to Yolanda Jones, who is the co-coordiantor for "kids in distress" program. This program is a pre-trial intervention program and if the subject successfully completes this program, no trail will occur. He must sign an agreement, (a "contract") with certain stipulations outlined for his treatment and performance within this two year period, prior to a decision by the court on what further action to take. This agreement was signed on April 19, 1990.


Some of the highlights of the agreement at this point indicate that he is required to successfully complete therapy. He will be supervised by the Department of Corrections with weekly contact. He will perform 80 hours of community service. He will pay for any necessary victim counseling. He must have no contact with the victim and he must have no unsupervised contact with minor children. He must not leave Duval County. There are other stipulations within the contract that are similar in nature.

It is indicated that he is showing good response as of this date.

I would recommend that we follow up in April of 1992 to see what his performance has been at the end of the two year period.

Let me know if you have any further suggestions of ideas.

Dear Mr. Cook:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be denied. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

Attachment to Letter

The following information is provided should you desire a review by the Southeast Region, B.S.A., of the decision to deny your registration.

1. Within 60 days, you must request in writing a review of this decision. Your request should be sent to the Regional Director, Southeast Region, B.S.A., PO Box 440728, Kennesaw, Georgia 30144. In your request you may include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that your registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
3. You may attend the review hearing, but it is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
6. If you disagree with the decision of the committee, you may request a review of this decision by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America.

Date September 24, 1990

I visited with Raplh Thieman, Chairman of Muskogee District and from his office I made a phone call to Mr. William C. Chitty, Charter Representative of Police Athletic League Scout Troop 19. I advised Mr. Chitty that we were interested in having a conversation with him regarding Robert Cook and his relationship with young people. We arranged to meet Mr. Chitty at 10:30 the morning of September 24, 1990.

Time 11:20 a.m.

The conversation with Mr. Chitty went well and I shared a copy of the arrest report with Mr. Chitty. He advised us that Robert Cook had to come to his house shortly following his arrest and indicated that he had to withdraw from active Troop operation until the issue of the arrest was settled.

We indicated to Mr. Chitty that we needed to proceed and remove Robert Cook from active registration with the Boy Scouts of America and invited him to come along with us to do this if he chose. He indicated he was not interested in accompanying us, he also indicated he had no problem with our decision.

Monday September 24, 1990: Time 2:30 p.m.

I reached Mr. Cook at his residence and he would not agree to a visit without my first indicating what the visit entailed. I indicated to Mr. Cook that I needed to discuss the issues of his recent arrest and his continuation with the Boy Scouts of America with him and share with him his opportunity for reinstatement if he wishes to do that at some point in time. Mr. Cook then agreed to visit with me and I made a trip to his residence at [REDACTED], Jacksonville, Florida I delivered his letter and his attachment that indicated his appeal procedures and a check for \$2.80 for his registration. Mr. Cook did not seem adversarial.

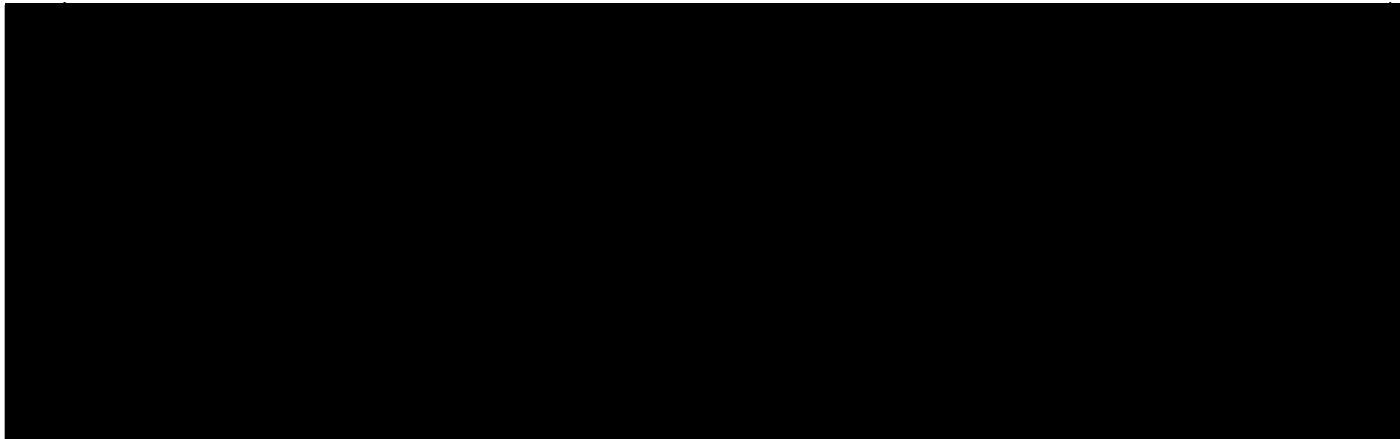

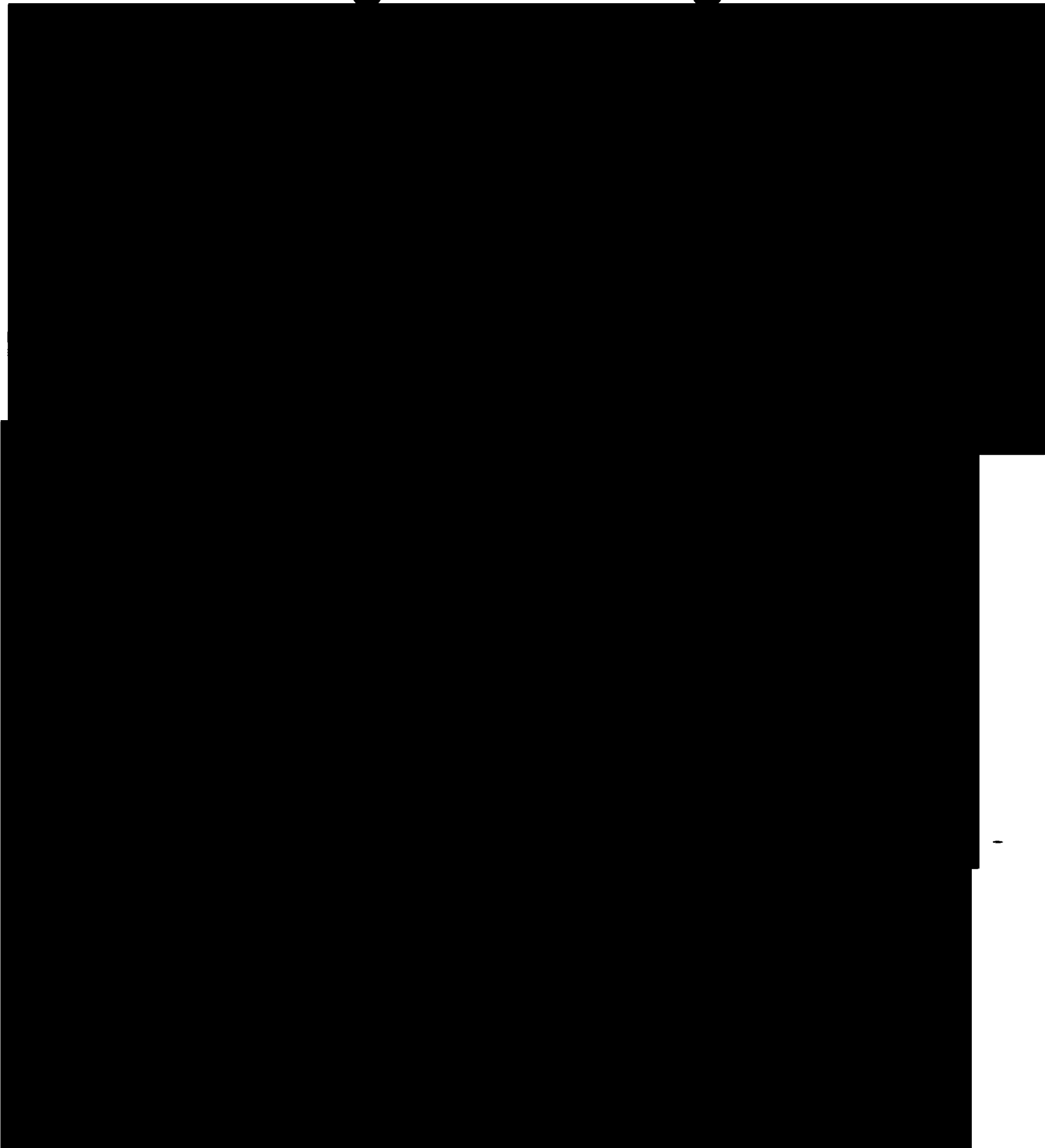
