The information here is excerpts from interviews conducted by the two gentlemen whose cards are printed below, Jerry Woolsey and William Marks. The interviewees were: the staff person who first reported the situation; the "victim", a ten year old boy (son of); and the perpetrator, William Frankenfield. The interviews were witnessed by myself and the camp manager and all three stories matched on acts.

The first act, unreported at that time, involved a hike to the waterfront. On the return trip William Frankenfield masturbated in front of the young boy. This took place in 1988 during camp.

The incidents this year that brought the situation into the open took place in camp this year.

The game Truth or Dare was played involving William, ten year old son and a friend of the same age. Dares that were carried out included the removal of clothing to complete nudity and at one time the ten year olds were required to place each others penis in their mouth for a period of time. Contact with the older boy was not required.

The recuring incidents indicated to me that this was not just a game that got out of hand.

The ten year old confided in another staff person who in turn reported to the camp manager. The staff person then encouraged the boy to tell the camp manager who then called me and was instructed to call the child abuse hot line.

The interviewers arrived and began their work. The parent of the ten year old gave her permission for the interview.

During the interview of William, when the question "why" was asked he said, "I don't know". When asked if he would consider counseling, he expressed a desire to use his past counselor. It was then he revealed that had been required to participate in counseling for four years. When asked, "Why" he stated, "We had a case of sexual abuse

Counselor: "Who?"

William: "And who?"
William: "And who?"

Counselor: "Was intercourse involved?"

William: "No."

It is on this question and answer series that I determined the need to file the report on Robert Frankenfield, who is not registered at this time.
