On January 20, 21 and 22 of 1967, Robert Newman attended a skiing campout with Troop 1139 and Troop 754 at the ski lodge at Hubbard Lake.

During the course of the weekend, he made advances to a Scout in Troop 1139 and had immoral relations with him. Robert Newman at that time was the District O &E Chairman and had been working with these two Troops in the possible formation of an Explorer Unit.

The father has told has told has story to the state police and action is pending from the prosecutor's office.

ROBERT E. NEWMAN

In January and February of 1967, Robert E. Newman was the District O & E Chairman of Huron District. He was assisting in the organization of Troop 754.

During February he visited the home of one of the Patrol
Leaders of the Troop,
on the pretext of helping
the boy make a patrol flag. At the time it did not appear to be
necessarily out of line because he had been working very closely
in the organization of this Troop. During the course of the visit at
the boy's home, he made advances to
and had
relations with him while the parents were out of the house. The
parents did not find out about the situation until April and at that
time signed a complaint against Newman.

After a number of court delays, he was prosecuted in the Canton Township Court in Belleville, Michigad. He was allowed to plead guilty to a lesser charge of being a disorderly person. The court found him guilty, fined him \$75.00 and he was put on probation for one year on the condition that he get psychiatric help. Detective Robert Johnson of the Michigan State Police, Ynsianti Post, has been the investigating officer in both cases.
