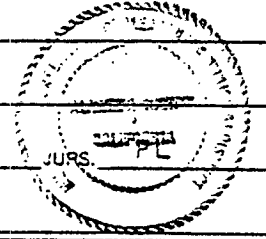

NARRATIVE:

I was called at home by Officer GALLAGHER, #46, on 06/21/86 about 2200 Hrs. GALLAGHER informed me that he had one [redacted] at LPD and that [redacted] was reporting a Robert Edward COX, his scoutmaster in troop 999 for offering him oral sex.

GALLAGHER told me that the offer by COX to [redacted] for oral sex had occurred in Willits, California, on 06/20/86, while enroute back from the Wente Scout Reservation. I told GALLAGHER to make a report and that I would forward it to Mendocino County Sheriff's Department on Monday, 06/23/86.

GALLAGHER also told me that there appeared to be no other boys involved at this time in the offers of sex by COX, but that [redacted] had apparently received some pornographic magazines from a [redacted], also in troop 999 and [redacted] (Refer to GALLAGHER's original report)

On Sunday, 06/22/86, about 1215 Hrs, I was notified at home by radio that one Robert COX had been involved in a major injury accident on [redacted]. I was informed that COX had apparently attempted suicide by crashing his van into a pillar underneath the Portola Avenue offramp. (Refer to C86-0622-06)

On Monday, 06/23/86, about 1430 Hrs, I went to VMH/ICU and briefly talked with COX to ascertain his physical and mental condition. Also present was [redacted]. COX appeared tired and had several lacerations to his forehead that appeared to be sutured. He said that he was sore but that he would talk to me. I did not give COX his Miranda Rights as I was not investigating a specific crime and I just wanted to find out COX's feelings about what was being alleged. I asked COX if he knew [redacted]. He said that he did. He said at no time did he ever have sexual contact with [redacted] or any other boy. He did say that he has been open with the boys about human sexuality.

He said he had never given any of the boys any pornographic magazines but it was more like Playboys and Penthouses. He did say that in retrospect that his behavior was "inappropriate". I left the hospital about 1440 Hrs.

On Tuesday, 06/24/86, Guss JARAMILLO, Air Force Office of Special Investigations, called me to ascertain any information about COX. He said he had been called by [redacted] and informed of COX's crash and allegations against [redacted]. [redacted] told me that COX was in fact on active duty with the U.S. Air Force, stationed at Sunnyvale Air Station. I also talked with Detective C. [redacted], Mendocino County Sheriff's Office. He had been apprised of the situation by [redacted] and was going to conduct interviews with the boys. He had also told me that AFOSI agents from Travis [redacted] would be assisting him. They had been alerted by [redacted] who had asked their assistance. [redacted] also called me and said that a meeting was being held that night with the parent's of the boys of troop 999 to let them know about the allegations against COX.

On Wednesday, 06/25/86, I received a phone call from [redacted] saying [redacted] I should talk with several other boys in the troop. He said that a meeting had been held with most of the parents of the boys of the troop to inform them of the allegations against COX. [redacted] also informed me that [redacted] one of the parents in troop 999, had in fact seen COX at [redacted] me after the meeting and had talked to him at length. [redacted] said that COX had evidently called [redacted] and wanted to talk to him. (I have not been able to talk with [redacted] at this time as he has been involved in the troop's activities in Willits and now in New Mexico)

He did tell me that most of the troop was back in Willits at a Jamboree. He said that one boy in particular, one [redacted] had been paid "special" attention by COX on several occasions and on several day and overnight trips.

I talked with [redacted], [redacted] mother by phone. She told me that he boy was already in therapy for emotional problems. I asked her what she meant, and she told me that her son has had several problems at school and home and has been seeing a doctor, Dr. Larry DILLER, Behavioral Pediatrician, [redacted]. She went on to say about two weeks ago, her and her husband had caught [redacted] sticking a toothbrush up his rectum. [redacted] said [redacted] did not have any explanation for his actions.

She said that he also had not told his psychiatrist anything. [redacted] said she had heard about the allegations against COX at the meeting of the troop's parents. [redacted] said she had an appointment with his doctor for Thursday, 06/26/86. I talked with Dr. DILLER by phone. He said that this new information could be helpful in trying to find out what is wrong with [redacted].

On Thursday, 06/20/86, Dr. DILLER said that [redacted] had not told him anything about any molestations. DILLER said that [redacted] was open about his interest in sex and girls. DILLER finds [redacted] actions highly suspect, but said [redacted] is very emphatic about not being molested by COX. Dr. DILLER said he would notify me if [redacted] gave him any information concerning any molestation done to him.

Also on Thursday, I was informed by [redacted] that COX had been transferred to the David Grant Medical Center at Travis AFB. He said COX would be undergoing a psychiatric evaluation for his attempted suicide. [redacted] called me again and said that his older son, [redacted] had a copy of a magazine that he had gotten from [redacted].

I went to the [redacted] house and talked with [redacted]. [redacted] told me that he had received the magazine ("Live") from his younger brother, [redacted]. [redacted] said that [redacted] had gotten the magazine from [redacted]. He went on to say that [redacted] had told him that [redacted] had gotten the magazine from COX. [redacted] said he got the magazine about two months ago. (Late April, 1986)

I was called by [redacted] on Friday, 06/27/86, who told me that COX did want to talk with me. I called Travis AFOSI and arranged an interview with [redacted] for 07/02/86. On Saturday, 06/28/86, I talked with [redacted] at [redacted] home. He had already been interviewed by Detective C. JACKSON. (Refer to his attached report)

[redacted] told me that when COX propositioned him it was while they were driving alone in his van. He also related that he had seen "sex toys" that belonged to COX at COX's house. [redacted] said that the "toys" was a white plastic "vibrator" and some type of "surgical" tubing made of latex with a dome at one end and a bulb and tube similar to a blood pressure cuff device to inflate the tube. [redacted] did not see the "toys" being used.

On Wednesday, 07/02/86, myself and Detective ROBERTSON, #28, drove to Travis AFB and met with AFOSI Agent George JACKSON. JACKSON had arranged for the interview and escorted us to the medical center where COX was a patient. Upon our arrival, COX met us with a lawyer, who informed us that COX would not be making any statements. No interview was attempted and we left the medical center.

On Monday, 07/07/86, I received Det. C. JACKSON's report on his interviews with the boys from troop 99S. C. JACKSON had called me prior to this and had informed me that he would be submitting his report for several misdemeanors

against COX (Refer to his report) He also told me that one boy [REDACTED] had been propositioned for oral sex by COX in Livermore.

I called [REDACTED] who told me that [REDACTED] would be returning from a boy scout outing to New Mexico on Sat, 07/12/86. I interviewed [REDACTED] on Tuesday, 07/15/86. [REDACTED] told me that on Saturday, 06/21/86, about 1800 Hrs, COX picked up [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] house and drove him to Swensen's Restaurant in Livermore. They got a soft drink and then drove to the [REDACTED] residence, [REDACTED] to drop off a trailer. [REDACTED] said they spent a while at the [REDACTED] and talked with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said they spent about a 1/2 hour there and then drove back toward home, but ended up on Patterson Pass Road at the deadend near Joyce Street. It was at this location while in the van with COX that [REDACTED] was propositioned by COX. [REDACTED] said COX told him that if he wanted to have oral sex with him (COX) he [REDACTED] would have to ask. [REDACTED] said he did not say anything to COX but just listened to him. He said COX went on talking about sex saying that "sex should be very open and if you [REDACTED] want to know anything to come to me".

[REDACTED] went on to say that they spent about 1/2 hour out on Patterson Pass before COX drove him home, about 2045 to 2100 Hrs. He said COX never [REDACTED] him, but that he was so upset by COX's offer and subsequent remarks it took him a couple of hours to go to sleep that night.

[REDACTED] said the day before, Friday, 06/20/86, he was returning from a ski trip when COX brought up a standing joke that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have with COX. The joke concerns being molested on Thursdays. [REDACTED] said that after he (COX) had dropped off the other boys, COX told [REDACTED] that the joke about Thursdays was getting old and what would he (COX) have to do to have [REDACTED] end the joke, "suck you off"? [REDACTED] said he thought COX was joking. [REDACTED] told me that the first person that he told about COX's propositions and remarks was Det. C. JACKSON in Mendocino County.

I called [REDACTED] on Friday 07/18/86 and she told me that [REDACTED] and COX did come to her house with a trailer on 06/21/86 and stayed for about 15 minutes or so. She said COX was alone with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had some type of drink from Swensen's. She went on to tell me that there had been an incident between [REDACTED] and COX on 06/17/86 during a day rafting trip.

She said that she heard this information second hand and told me to check with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. I called [REDACTED] on 07/18/86 at his business and talked with him about the raft trip. He related to me that he had not witnessed any event directly between [REDACTED] and COX, other than an "overbearing" attitude toward [REDACTED]. He did say

[redacted] that his daughter, [redacted] originally at the beginning of this raft trip was in the same raft as [redacted] and COX. He said COX asked her to get out of the raft, telling her that he wanted to be alone with these boys.

I then called [redacted] at home. [redacted] She recalls being told to leave one raft before the start of the trip by COX. She told me that COX came up to raft she was in and told her she would have to go in another raft. When she asked why, COX told her that he wanted to go in this one. There were three boys from the troop in the raft, but does not remember if [redacted] was in the raft.

She said she did not see an argument between COX and [redacted] later that day. I then called [redacted] at his business. [redacted] told me that he was on the raft trip and [redacted] was in the raft that COX kicked [redacted] out of. He said that he recalls COX being overzealous in his play with the boys and at one point everyone on his raft involved in a water fight, including [redacted]

He went on to say that at one point a wrestling match started with COX, [redacted] and a couple of other boys [redacted] said [redacted] seemed to become angry and yelled at COX, saying: "You goddam fucking faggot". [redacted] he was not taken back by the language that [redacted] used when talking to COX, but COX's seemingly complacent attitude to the remark. [redacted] does not recall anything else out of the ordinary for the rest of the trip.

[redacted] was brought to LPD by his mother, [redacted] on Friday, 07/18/86, about 0900 Hrs. I had previously talked with [redacted] briefly and at that time he was visibly upset and did not want to talk about COX. (This was on Saturday, 06/23/86) [redacted] did not want to talk about COX today either. He said he had nothing to say about him. [redacted] still seemed bothered by the situation and I did not interview at this time. He was told that if he felt like talking, he could call me. [redacted] said he understood and he and his mother left LPD.

I am requesting a review by the DDA for a complaint of 647a PC, Child Annoying, against Robert COX for his actions and remarks with [redacted] on 06/20/86 and 06/21/86. At this time the investigation is continuing and more complaints may be forthcoming.
