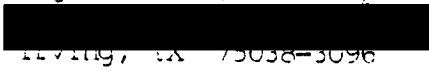

Boy Scout leader pleads guilty Admits fourth-degree sex offense against troop

A Rockville Boy Scout leader who is charged with sexually molesting four adolescent boys in his Scout troop pleaded guilty in county Circuit Court to a single sex offense.

Robert John Nino Longo, 25, a Scouting enthusiast who earned Scouting's highest award, the rank of Eagle Scout, pleaded guilty on Friday to a fourth-degree sex offense.

A fourth-degree sex offense is defined as sexual contact against the victim's will. It involves a victim between the ages of 14 and 15, and an offender at least four years older than the victim.

The offense carries a maximum penalty of one year in jail, a \$1,000 fine, or both.

Under the terms of a plea agreement, prosecutors dropped a charge of child abuse and asked Judge William M. Cave to sentence Longo to five years of supervised probation and psychological treatment.

Cave accepted Longo's plea, but deferred sentencing for 90 days to allow Longo to complete his special training sessions and no-ties program to help boys with their merit badges in first aid.

allow Longo's psychologist more time to conduct a psychological evaluation.

The judge allowed Longo to remain free on a \$5,000 personal bond until his sentencing in September.

Longo has resigned from his position as assistant Scout leader and will no longer teach first aid. He also has agreed to have no involvement with any other youth organizations.

Longo, whose two brothers are also Eagle Scouts, taught Scouts first aid at the Christ Episcopal Church, about 300 feet away from the county courthouse on South Washington Street.

He has taught these classes for the past three or four years as part of a program to help Scouts earn their merit badges in first aid.

Earlier this year, a janitor walked by a bathroom inside the church where Longo was conducting one of his special training sessions and noticed a group of boys with their clothes off, police said.

The janitor suspected homosexual activity and reported the incident to police.

Police charging documents say Longo touched the genitals of the boys in his class, whose ages were between 12 and 16.

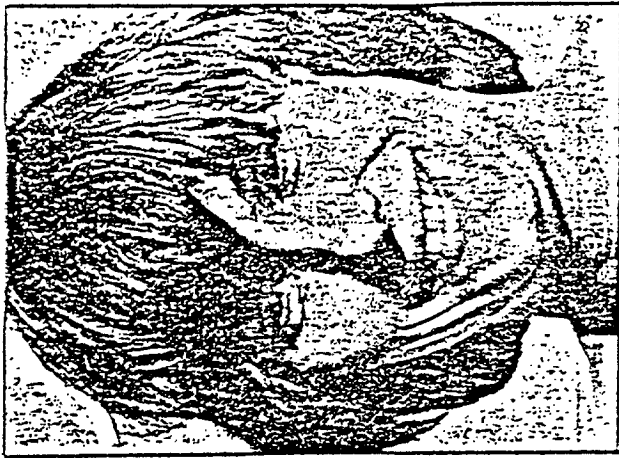
Longo's attorney, Carl Lee Frederick, said Longo is a religious man and is known to many as a community activist who has always had an interest in helping others despite his own hardships.

At 16, Longo fought a cancer, which forced him to have his lower left leg amputated. A year later, Longo had part of his right lung removed after the cancer reappeared in his lung.

While a student at Rockville High School, Longo was admired by his peers and family because he did not allow his cancer to affect his attitude on life.

In a 1978 interview with *The Journal*, Longo, then a student, said he managed his school's track team and was active in Junior Achievement and ran 2 miles a day despite his leg surgery.

He was a member of the Boy Scouts of America and a member of the church.

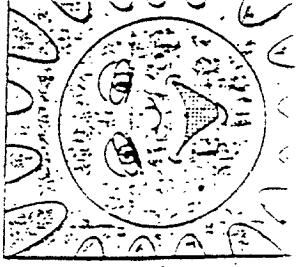

Boy Scouts' counselor charged with sex abuse

A Boy Scout merit badge counselor is charged with sexually abusing four adolescent boys he was teaching.

County police said yesterday they arrested Robert John Nino Longo, 25, of 635 Marcia Lane in Rockville. The boys he is charged with abusing range in age from 12 to 16. He is free on \$5,000 bond.

Longo has helped area Scouts earn their first aid merit badges for three to four years, said Richard Rogers, field services director for the Montgomery County District of the Boy Scouts.

A volunteer committee seeks merit badge counselors, Rogers says. There are 1,000 such volunteer counselors in Montgomery County alone, he said.

"(Longo) is like a needle in a haystack," Rogers said.

Longo had classes in churches in Montgomery County to teach Boy Scouts about first aid procedures,

said Ofc. John Hock Jr. of the Montgomery County Police Youth Division.

Hock said Longo advertised his services in an area Boy Scout publication called Scouter Magazine.

In that ad, Longo listed the times he would be having classes in first aid instruction, Hock said.

Hock said Longo taught classes using a group of boys as his aides.

He had special classes for the aides, teaching them various first-aid techniques, Hock said.

During one of these special training sessions, a janitor walked by a bathroom at a church and noticed a group of boys with their clothes off in a bathroom, Hock said.

The janitor became suspicious and called police, Hock said.

Police documents charge Longo with "touching the genitals" of four of his students.

It is an especially difficult time for the boys, who went along with Longo because they thought he was teaching them first aid, Hock said.
