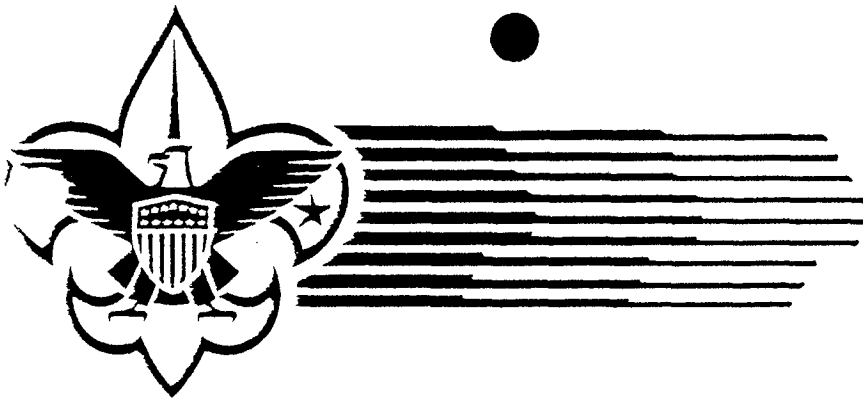

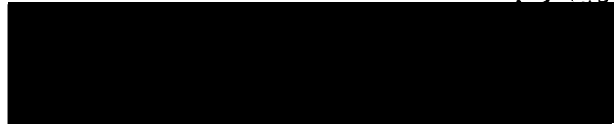

Dear Dave:

The new stand of the Boy Scouts of America concerning sexual abuse of children is very commendable. Because of our new stand, I am asking you to give me a ruling on a particular case, which I will describe below. Would you please indicate how far in the past we should review different cases.

I received a letter from Nick Stamos, Scout Executive of the San Francisco Bay Area Council, along with a copy of a letter from his Camping and Properties Director concerning Robert "Skip" Auleb (see enclosed). Mr. Auleb is presently serving as Scoutmaster of Troop 264 in the San Mateo County Council. The above mentioned letters refer to a letter (see enclosed) which was sent to me by Ronald G. Walsh, Director of Program for S.F.B.A.C. and an accompanying letter (see enclosed) which was sent and dated January 14, 1984, to Nick Stamos from a [Redacted] and [Redacted].

Upon receiving the February 2, 1984 letter from Ron Walsh, I phoned Ron and he told me that he had not talked with either of the [Redacted] concerning the matter, but that he would and would then give me a call. I then called Richard Chandler, Area III Director of the Western Region, and read the letters to him. Dick told me there was not enough information at that point and to try and get more. I then spoke with our council attorney on February 8, 1984, and was advised that we would have to have more information before we could do anything.

I then talked to Paul Ernst on February 15, 1984. After reading the attached letters and telling him all of the information, he said there was not enough information for him to deny Robert Auleb registration with the B.S.A. He also suggested that San Francisco Bay Area Council follow-up with the Camp Director and Program Director from Wente Scout Reservation. I then wrote to Ron Walsh (see enclosed) on February 15, 1984, so indicating the above.

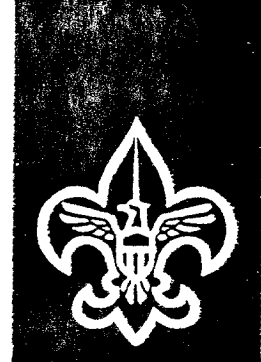

Dear Mr. Stamos,

We are writing this letter regarding an incident between our son, [REDACTED] and Robert "Skip" Auleb. This past September, when [REDACTED] decided that we should inform the Boy Scouts administration about the incident, we asked him to write down what had happened. The following is a summary of what he wrote.

[REDACTED] and Skip became acquainted during the summer of 1982 at the Wente Scout Reservation when [REDACTED] worked on the waterfront and Skip was Program Director. [REDACTED] felt Skip was trustworthy and sincere and they had several long talks. At the end of summer camp, they agreed to get together sometime and go out for pizza or a movie.

On June 12, 1983 they made a date to see a movie and at Skip's suggestion, went to a movie playing in Pacifica. Afterwards, Skip asked [REDACTED] if he wanted to smoke marijuana. [REDACTED] said he did not. Skip then asked if [REDACTED] wanted to drink some beer and [REDACTED] said he would. After Skip bought the beer they went to Skip's house to drink it. They went to his room which is in a small building separate from the rest of the house. After three or four beers each, Skip suggested that [REDACTED] spend the night since it was getting late and he didn't think he should drive in his condition. The conversation turned to swimming and Skip talked about his work as a swim coach and how he used to massage his swimmers' muscles before their events. At this point, he asked [REDACTED] if he would like a massage before going to bed. [REDACTED] said yes. Skip suggested that Wick take off his shirt and jeans. After giving [REDACTED] a massage, he asked if [REDACTED] would give him one, which [REDACTED] did. After the massage session, Skip tried to put his hand under [REDACTED] underwear. [REDACTED] said no, that he was

not a homosexual. Skip tried to persuade him that it would be all right and [REDACTED] refused, got dressed. Skip gave him a sleeping bag and [REDACTED] slept upstairs on the couch.

Early the next morning we were concerned because [REDACTED] hadn't returned home and called Skip's house and asked him to bring [REDACTED] home. On the way, Skip apologized to [REDACTED], said he didn't know what came over him to do such a thing and he hoped it didn't hurt their friendship. He has not contacted [REDACTED] since that time.

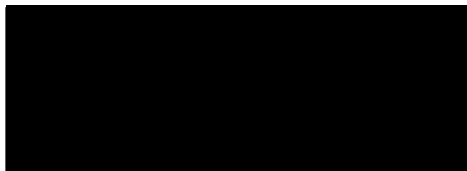
We will ask [REDACTED] to read this letter before we send it.
