

Upon receiving the February 2, 1984 letter from Ron Walsh. I phoned Ron and he told me that he had not talked with either of the concerning the matter, but that he would and would then give me a call. I then called Richard Chandler, Area III Director of the Western Region, and read the letters to him. Dick told me there was not enough information at that point and to try and get more. I then spoke with our council attorney on February 8, 1984, and was advised that we would have to have more information before we could do anything.




and Skip became acquainted during the summer of 1982 at the Wente Scout Reservation when worked on the waterfront and 5kip was Program Director. felt Skip was trustworthy and sincere and they nad several long talks. At the end of summer camp, they agreed to get together sometime and go out for pizza or a movie.

On June 12, 1983 they made a date to see a movie and at Skip's suggestion, went to a movie playing in Pacifica. Afterwards, Skip asked if ne wanted to smoke marijuana. Said ne did not. Skip then asked if wanted to drink some beer and said he would. After Skip bought the beer they went to Skip's house to drink it. They went to nis room which is in a small building separate from the rest of the house. After three or four beers each, Skip suggested that spend the night since it was getting late and ne didn't think he should drive in his condition. The conversation turned to swimming and Skip talked about his work as a swim coach and how he used to massage his swimmers' muscles before their events. At this point, he asked if he would like a massage before going to bed. Said yes. Skip suggested that Nick take off his shirt and jeans. After giving a massage, he asked if would give him one, which did. After the massage session, kip tried to put his hand under underwear.

not a homosexual. Skip tried to persude him that it would be all right and refused, got dressed. Skip gave him a sleeping bag and slept upstairs on the couch.

Early the next morning we were concerned because hadn't returned home and called Skip's house and asked him to bring home. On the way, Skip apologized to said he didn't know what came over him to do such a thing and he hoped it didn't hurt their friendship. He has not contacted since that time.

We will ask to read this letter before we send it.
