Cost is \$4.50 per adult, \$2.50 for ages 14 and under and \$12.50 for a family ticket.

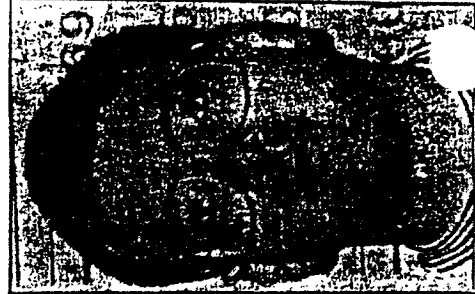

Stockmeier gets 2 life sentences

Earliest parole date in 20 years

conducted by federal agents, police and a team of military psychiatric experts, led to the filing of sexual assault charges.

At Stockmeier's sentencing hearing yesterday, Naval Investigative Service agent Brent

A Navy airman who worked as a Cub Scout leader was sentenced yesterday to a double life term for sexually assaulting two young members of his Scout troop.

Robert L. Stockmeier, 22, an airman from East Point, Ga., stationed at the Fallon Naval Air Station, pleaded guilty Aug. 2 after a psychiatric evaluation at Lake's Crossing Center for the Mentally Disordered Offender in Reno. He will be eligible for parole in 20 years.

He was arrested May 8 and charged with sexual assault on two boys, aged 7 and 9. Police were tipped off to the crimes when a photo developing company in Sacramento, Calif. alerted them to film it received for processing with pictures of naked children on it. Officers traced the film back to Stockmeier, and a search of his house revealed other evidence of sexual acts with children.

Interviews with the victims.

A victim's mother took the witness stand and read from a prepared statement, asking that Stockmeier receive the maximum sentence.

"You will never know my pain," she began. She said that hearing her children describe the acts committed against them, hearing their fears and knowing that they are emotionally scarred "is like living a slow painful death."

She said that instead of receiving psychiatric help, Stockmeier inflicted his sickness on innocent children.

Both victims were placed in treatment after Stockmeier's arrest to aid them with their trauma.

In defense of his client, Lawton said that Stockmeier himself had been sexually abused as a child, a factor that often drives people to commit similar acts.

Stockmeier cooperated with authorities and admitted culpability, Lawton said.

Pasquale said Stockmeier's "predatory tendencies and the substantial harm he has caused his victims and this community" demand the maximum sentence. He said that Stockmeier's 7-year-old victim lives in fear that

Stockmeier will escape and harm him. Pasquale said that the Boy Scouts and the Navy are two other victims of Stockmeier's acts.

Pasquale rejected the argument that Stockmeier's sexual abuse as a child was an excuse for his crimes.

"Mr. Stockmeier is a grown man who made his own decisions," said Pasquale.

Stockmeier, addressing the court, said he wasn't going to try to make excuses for what happened.

"What I did, I cannot explain to you, sir, except that I take full responsibility for it," Stockmeier said. "Now I look back and see the problems I have caused and it horrifies me. By nature, I'm not a cruel person. I did not intend to do those things."

Judge Mario Recanzzone ordered Stockmeier to prison for two life sentences, to be served consecutively. Nevada law requires that a person convicted of sexually assaulting a minor get life in prison, but allows parole after 10 years. In Stockmeier's case, the consecutive sentences move his earliest parole date to 20 years from the time of sentencing.

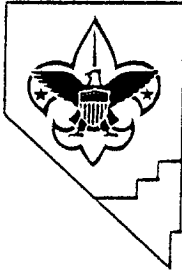



Scout leader charged

Bail set at \$15,000

A local Cub Scout leader was arrested yesterday on felony lewdness charges after investigators found nude photographs of children in the Scout troop in his possession, Fallon Police said yesterday.

Robert L. Stockmeier, 22, a Navy airman from East Point, Georgia, was arrested on three counts of lewdness with children under 14 and booked into the Churchill County Jail on \$15,000 bail.

Stockmeier is with VFA Squadron 106 at the Fallon Naval Air Station.

The two alleged victims, ages 7 and 9, are members of the Scout troop that Stockmeier led, Fallon Police Chief Dale Carr said. The offenses allegedly occurred between the end of February and the end of April, investigators have determined.

The arrest came after a week-long investigation conducted by Fallon police detectives and Naval Investigative Service agents.

Carr said that local authorities were informed by the Sacramento, Calif., police that a film

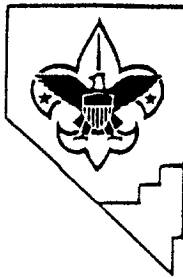

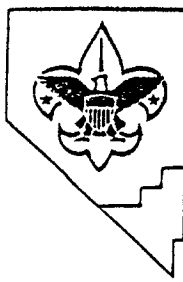

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

In child sex assault case

Gary L. Tyner, 45, was charged with assaulting two girls, one 10 and the other 11. He is being held in lieu of \$500,000 bail.

\$100,000, pending a pre-trial hearing May 22.

Tyner was charged by the Sheriff with two counts each of lewdness with a child. At the same time, he was granted each of the same bail conditions.

Since May 3, he began serving a 90-day term with the possibility of parole.

Scout leader busted in Fallon molest case

FALLON (AP) — A Cub Scout troop leader based at the Fallon Naval Air station was arrested Tuesday on three counts of lewdness with a child under 14 after allegedly pornographic pictures turned up at a Sacramento photo lab.

Fallon police said Robert Stockmeier, 22, was being held under \$15,000 bail on the charges which resulted from a week-long investigation by police and Navy investigators.

The probe began when a film processing service in Sacramento notified authorities that photos on a developed roll

of film showed naked children as well as a naked adult male.

The film was traced back to Stockmeier and police said a search of the man's home and vehicles disclosed additional evidence including photos of the alleged victims, apparently taken in March and April of this year.

Police said all of the youngsters were members of a Fallon Cub Scout pack of which Stockmeier was a troop leader.

Conviction on a charge of lewdness with a child under 14 is punishable by a maximum of 10 years in prison and a \$10,000 fine.

Company failed to meet deadline in toxic cleanup

Washoe County commissioners on Tuesday revoked a Reno manufacturing firm's business license after the company apparently failed to meet a deadline for cleaning potentially hazardous materials in Palomino Valley.

Officials said little headway has been made since the firm began a 90-day clean-up plan last fall of leaky containers filled with oil-based products.

H.B. Chapman Co. manager Barbara Schoefer told commissioners the firm has been working with limited manpower since county health officials ordered the leaking oil drums to be cleaned up last October.
