The current question concerns Robert Thornbladh. The poor judgement Mr. Thornbladh used in preparing to go into business while still on the local council payroll is accepted. But there is question as to whether he really was involved in the acts of dishonesty that are generally reflected in this report.

The report implies that the three units in question were handled by Robert Weniger who was assigned to Thornbladh's district as an assistant. Thornbladh regigned on May 15. Weniger was dismissed on May 15. Is it possible that Weniger's dishonest acts were committed in the period after Thornbladh left and that this should not be charged against him?

Some men in other regions who know Bob Thornbladh think very highly of him and cannot believe that he would be a party to such procedures.

In fairness to him it seems that we need to clarify his relationships to the several points that Stan Meenach enumerated in his report.



SUBJECT: Cleveland Membership Situation

I had conversations with John Shanks and Robert Untch about the situation that developed, or became known in 1964 concerning phantom units and boys in the Greater Cleveland Council. Here are the facts as I have been able to winnow them out.

Two districts were involved - District 7 which was served by Theobald Weber and District 11 which was served by Robert Thornbladh and later by Robert L. Weiniger. Here are the factors that seemed to contribute to the situation.

- 1. There seemed to have been some cutright dishonesty in charters with no one actually being members of the unit. Men were registered in multiple capacities without their knowledge but the boys were totally fictitious. However, not over three charters have been located where this was a fact. This occurred in District 11.
- 2. Project workers in the inner-city project, to make a record, came in with large numbers of duplications. Two workers particularly were involved, with one project worker actually registered in nine capacities in District 11.
- 3. There was outright padding of membership rolls in the round-up program.
- 4. There was evidence of generally sloppy and irresponsible reregistering in the matter of use of duplicate registrations of adults.
- 5. The civil rights problem seemed to have been a contributing factor, with units started and registered in apparent good faith and then abandoned because of unrest and problems.
- 6. There were normal units that just went out of business.

I feel there is a 7th factor that is very difficult to measure, but I believe the exposure of the above meant that the balance of the staff became ultra-conservative and cautious so that there would be no question as to their units - by that I mean that they would not accept the charters that normally they might have accepted without a thorough check on boys and men. This would not be normal procedure, but after the above exposures, this became a fact and slowed down organization of new units and probably discouraged some. It also made for poor relationships where the district executive re-gheated on people after they had filed an application.

I believe also that the Director of Field Service and the Field Directors were not sufficiently aware of what was going on in their districts to the degree that they should.

Weber and Thornblade resigned, May 15, 1964 to go into a cendy business. Subsequently it was discovered that they had been in process of setting up this business on Boy Scout time for a few months while working for the council. Their operation in general was pretty sloppy and we would not recommend their return to the profession.

Weiniger came on in March 1964 as an Assistant to Thornbladh and was fired on September 15. This man was a real pusher and was out to make a reputation and constantly tried to make an impression. He is the man who had the totally fictitious units and I understand has been placed on the confidential list.

In watching for the above sort of thing, it seems to me that multiple registration of leaders would be a suspicious item to watch for and a large number of additional enrollments brought into a small unit at one time would be suspect. Investigation of three units all with the same sponior, should that while they had registered with five boys, additional enrollments cans in with in excess of 20 boys for each unit, all about the same time.

I do not believe that this could happen agein in Cleveland. There is a new Director of Field Service in the person of Robert Until who knows exactly what is going on and Scout Executive John Shanks is determined that nothing like this will ever happen again in his council. John and I agreed that the Scout executive and the field directors should look at rosters once in a while to make sure that they know what is coming in. One of the things the field directors need to do is keep in close contact with their men and not be naive about what men will or will not do and not let any men think that a record is more important than his own integrity.

All in all, there were probably 300 shadow registrations without foundation and perhaps as many as 600 boys that could have been questioned.

I feel sure that everything is currently sound and will continue to be so.





- 5. You will receive a letter setting forth the findings of the committee.
- 6. If you are dissatisfied with the results of a regional review, you may request a further review by the National Council. The decision of the National Council will be final.


